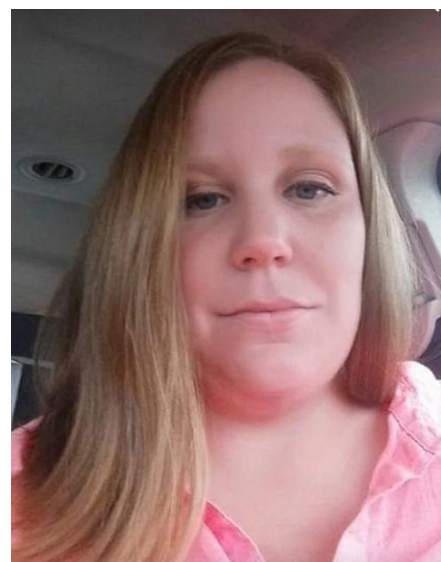
Lewicki is week's high bowler:



Steve Lewicki rolled 740 (225-247-268) on lanes 35 & 36 in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League at Marcin Bowl to post the high triple in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action this past week. The smooth lefty is averaging 222 after thirteen weeks of bowling in the league.

Ladies high over average:

Jocelyn VanEkeren tossed 646 (194-220-232 – 69 pins over average – 157 pins over average for three game) in the Tuesday Night Ladies League at Marcin Bowl to register the ladies high over average for three games in LCTA play this week. She also rolled the week's ladies high triple. Jocelyn started bowling 5 pin at a young age but quit after a few years. She left the lanes for nine years then at age sixteen she started bowling 10 pin in a Friday night mixed league at Lake Huron Lanes. Since then she has been bonding on the lanes with friends for 18 years. She is a right handed bowler with a career high single of 278 and high triple of 693. Her most memorable moment in bowling was when she strung seven strikes in a row. One of her biggest accomplishments in bowling is when she won the Ladies Singles Division at the Ontario Tenpin Provincial Tournament in 2006. One of her great enjoyments is watching



her children bowl on Saturday mornings where she also works with the bumper bowlers. Jocelyn used to bowl four nights a week but when life got real busy for her she became a once a week bowler with a great group of ladies on Tuesday night.

Men's high over average:

Mel Matthews fired 664 (225-225 – 145 pins over average for three games) in the LCTA Sunday Morning Men's League at Marcin Bowl to record the men's high over average for three games for this week. Mel started bowling 5 pin at Northgate Bowl at age 10



and at age 14 he took a hiatus from organized bowling for 4 years. During that time he enjoyed recreational bowling (5 pin and 10 pin) with friends and to make some extra money he took up pin setting (5 and 10 pin). His 10 pin career took off in 1967 when at age 18, he returned to bowling and joined organized men's leagues at Northgate Bowl, Marcin Bowl, Hi-Way Bowl, Echo Bowl and Lakeside/Lake Huron lanes. Fifty-one years later, he is still knocking down the pins. Mel has one CTF sanctioned 300 game which he shot on December 28, 1997 on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl in the Sunday Morning Men's League. He also has one CTF sanctioned 800 series (813) which he posted on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl on April 2, 2006 in the Sunday

Morning Men's League. Mel's other bowling accomplishments include holding the City High Average (209) and the City High Triple (745) in the 1979-1980 bowling season. In the 1997-1998 bowling season he shared the City High Single (300) with Brian Clarke, Sean Davidson, Pat Lacasse and Chris Luke. His most memorable bowling moments were participating in the old American Bowling Congress and the new United States Bowling Congress National Tournaments for nineteen years (1994-2012). Mel also has been heavily involved in the local 10 pin administration of bowling. He served as a director in the old Sarnia and District Bowling Association; he was on the Interim LCTA Board when they established the new Canadian Tenpin Federation local association (LCTA); he was elected as a director on the LCTA Board in 2006 and was voted in as the LCTA President in the 2008 -2009 bowling season, the position which he holds to this day. Mel and his wife Shirley have been dedicated instructors to the youth bowlers at Hi-Way Bowl for



35 years. Many have become solid competitive bowlers while others are simply enjoying the great sport.
