## Weekly Highlights

### Adamson fires 300:



Kyle Adamson fired a perfect game in his first game of the night, to record the high single of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action. It was Adamson's career sanctioned 8<sup>th</sup> 300 and the 13<sup>th</sup> 300 in the LCTA this season. He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl, finishing the night with a 684 (300 – 95 pins over average – 196-188) triple. Kyle is bowling in three leagues this year with his averages and games in brackets are the following: FTBMNML 206 (78), Best Wiring Classic League 196 (84) and Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League 204 (69). His career sanctioned high triple is 813 (6).

### Lapointe records top triple:



Ben Lapointe wheeled 748 (275 – 53 pins over average – 227-246) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 13 & 14 and 739 (213-259-267) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 29 & 30 both at Marcin Bowl, to record the high triple and the 3<sup>rd</sup> high triple of the week in LCTA bowling competition. They were his 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> 700's of the season and he now has a career 168-700's to his credit.. Lapointe is now averaging 223 for 81 games in the BWCL and 226 for 78 games in the FTBMNML this season. Lapointe is holding the high averages in both leagues.



**Mumby rolls new high three:**

Patrick Mumby rolled 740 (226-269 – 59 pins over average – 245 – 35 pins over average - 110 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl, to record his career new high triple and the 2<sup>nd</sup> high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. It was his 2<sup>nd</sup> 700 of the season as he previously bowled 710 (232-278-200) in the FTBMNML this season. Patrick's career high single is 279. Mumby is averaging 212 for 78 games in the FTBMNML this season.

**Phillion tops his high triple:**

Eric Phillion bowled 593 (225 – 69 pins over average – 174-194 – 125 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl, to record a new personal high triple in LCTA bowling action. His previous high triple was 589 (195-180-214) which he bowled in the FTBMNML this season and his high single is 235. Phillion is averaging 158 for 54 games in the FTBMNML this season. Last year in the league he averaged 129 for 69 games.

**Sheppard ups his high triple:**

Zach Sheppard tossed 552 (172 – 40 pins over average – 210 – 78 pins over average – 170 – 38 pins over average – 156 pins over average for three games) in the Klean and Brite Thursday Night Mixed (KBTNML) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl, to register a new personal high triple. His previous high triple was 520 and his high single is 220. Sheppard is averaging 132 after 27 weeks of bowling in the KBTNML this season..

**VanGrimberghe fires new high triple:**

Amanda VanGrimberghe fired 527 (161 – 43 pins over average -164 – 46 pins over average – 202 – 84 pins over average – 173 pins over average for three games) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl, to post a new personal high triple. Her previous high triple was 480 (130-135-205) and her high single is 205 both bowled in the MFFL this season. Amanda has returned to the lanes



after a ten-year hiatus and this writer does not know what her high scores were when she bowled in the 2014 2015 and 2015-2016 seasons. This writer did some checking in old LCTA year books and found that Amanda last bowled in the 2015 – 2016 season in the old Ontario Hydro Mixed League at Marcin Bowl finishing the year with a 140 average for 93 games. Amanda is averaging 121 for 63 games in the MFFL this season.

### **Farrenkopf is 100 pins over average:**



Adam Farrenkopf wheeled 289 in his last game of the night to be 104 pins over average for a single game. He qualified to receive an award (100 pins over average for a single game) which is a watch from the Canadian Tenpin Federation for his achievement. He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl, finishing the night with a 643 triple. Adam's career sanctioned high scores are 705 (226-247-232) and 264. He is averaging 186 for 78 games in the FTBMNML this season. Last season in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League he averaged 194 for 96 games.

### **Youth bowler rolls triplicate:**

Evan Peters rolled 369 (123-123-123) in the Phantom Youth League on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl, to record the 3<sup>rd</sup> triplicate in the LCTA this season. The other two were recorded by Joe Smythe 504 (168-168-168) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League and Jim Hipple 462 (154-154-154) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League.

### **Youth bowlers top their scores:**

Leah Stewardson, Bronwyn Litchfield, Carter Nilsson and Aubrey Wright rolled new high scores in the Phantom Youth League at Marcin Bowl this past week in LCTA bowling action.

Leah bowled 349 (110 – 33 pins over average – 124 – 47 pins over average – 115 – 38 pins over average – 118 pins over average for three games) on lanes 15 & 16, to record a new high triple and single game. Her previous high scores were 325 and 118. Leah is in her first year of sanctioned league bowling averaging 77 after 27 weeks of bowling.



Bronwyn tossed 303 (89 – 29 pins over average – 117 – 57 pins over average – 97 – 37 pins over average – 123 pins over average for three games) on lanes 15 & 16, topping her previous high 286 triple. Her high single is 121. Bronwyn is in her first year of sanctioned league bowling averaging 60 after 27 weeks on the lanes.

Carter wheeled 272 (75-59-138 – 71 pins over average) on lanes 21 & 22 to register a new high single and tie his old high triple. His previous high single was 105. Carter is in his 2<sup>nd</sup> year of sanctioned league bowling averaging 67 after 27 weeks on the lanes having fun with his friends. Last year in the league he averaged 52 for 84 games.

Aubrey fired 265 (78-97 – 37 pins over average – 90 – 30 pins over average) on lanes 19 & 20 to post a new personal high triple. Her previous high triple was 257. Her career high single is 109. Aubrey's is in her 2<sup>nd</sup> year of sanctioned league bowling averaging 60 after 27 weeks. Last year in the league she averaged 48 for 69 games.

### **English slides into fourth:**



Peter English rolled 736 (257 – 55 pins over average – 236 – 34 pins over average – 243 – 41 pins over average – 130 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl, to post the 4<sup>th</sup> high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was his 2<sup>nd</sup> 700 of the season as he previously bowled 762 (211-276-275) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL). English is averaging 203 for 75 games in the FTBMNML and 205 for 78 games in the BWCL this season. His career sanctioned high scores are 777 and 300 (4).

### **Shephard registers number twenty:**



Mike Shephard hurled 727 (257- 38 pins over average – 217- 253 – 34 pins over average) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 23 & 24 and 729 (264 – 45 pins over average - 234 231) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) both at Marcin Bowl, to record the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> high triples of the week in the LCTA. They were his 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> 700's of the season. Shephard is now averaging 220 for 81 games in the BWCL and 220 for 78 games in the FTBMNML this season.



**Lewicki takes seventh position:**

Steve Lewicki wheeled 723 (198-257- 40 pins over average – 268 – 51 pins over average) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl, to register the 7<sup>th</sup> high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was his 10<sup>th</sup> 700 of the season in the LCTA all bowled in the BWCL. Lewicki is now averaging 218 for 78 games in the league this season.

**Crowe joins 700 club:**

Melissa Crowe tossed 718 (264 – 70 pins over average – 200-254 – 60 pins over average – 136 pins over average for three games) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) at Marcin Bowl, to post the ladies high triple of the week in the LCTA. Her triple was also good for the 8<sup>th</sup> high triple of the week. It was her first 700 of the season. Melissa is averaging 199 for 30 games as a spare in the BWCL this season. Her career sanctioned high scores are 740 and 297 (2).

**Vandermeer good for ninth place:**

Dan Vandermeer hurled 709 (228-234- 44 pins over average – 247- 57 pins over average – 139 pins over average for three games) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl, to post his 2<sup>nd</sup> 700 of the season as he previously bowled 712 (217-247- 248). His triple was good for the 9<sup>th</sup> high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. Vandermeer is averaging 195 for 51 games this season. Last season in the SPBCML he averaged 189 for 60 games. His career sanctioned high scores are 777 and 289.

**Watson and Reid share same triple:**

Bryce Watson and George Reid rolled the same triple in their respective leagues in LCTA bowling competition this past week.



Watson tossed 706 (261 – 51 pins over average – 253 – 43 pins over average – 192) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl, to share the 10<sup>th</sup> high triple of the week. It was his 10<sup>th</sup> 700 of the season and he now has a career 25-700's to his credit. Watson is averaging 211 for 72 games in the FTBMNML this season. Last season in the FTBMNML he averaged 205 for 90 games.



Reid rolled 706 (243-216-247) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl, to register the 10<sup>th</sup> high triple of the week in LCTA bowling play. It was his 4<sup>th</sup> 700 of the season since he returned to the lanes four weeks ago. His other 3-700's were 716, 742 and 767 (236-267-264). News is spreading quickly that Reid is bowling again and this writer is sure that teams looking for another bowler will be scrambling for his services. George is averaging 219 for 12 games as a spare in the MFFL this season.



### **Ridealgh posts number four:**

Jamie Ridealgh fired 705 (210-247-248) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl, to record the 11<sup>th</sup> high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. It was his 4<sup>th</sup> 700 of the season with his top one being 823 (299-225-299) which he bowled two weeks ago. Ridealgh is now averaging 219 for 63 games in the BWCL this season.



### **Lapointe is in the cellar:**

Jason Lapointe wheeled 704 (222-257 – 43 pins over average – 225) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl, to register the low 700 of the week in the LCTA. It was his 4<sup>th</sup> 700 of the season as he previously bowled 702, 718 and 757 (300-211-246). Jason is averaging 215 for 39 games as a spare in the FTBMNML this season, Lapointe bowls full time in the Best Wiring Classic



League and is averaging 211 for 81 games. Jason's career sanctioned high scores are 792 and 300 (4).

Jill Friis, Jo Ellen Beveridge, Kelly Sitter and Michelle Fraser had a solid week of bowling as they all rolled 600 plus triples in their respective leagues this past week in LCTA bowling action.



Jill rolled 687 (227-202-258 – 58 pins over average) in the Best Wiring Classic League as a spare at Marcin Bowl, to record the ladies second high triple of the week. Jill is averaging 202 for 39 games in the league this season. Jill (Clendenning), a Sarnia born right-handed 10 pin bowler, was inducted into the Sarnia Lambton Sports Hall of Fame. She was a member of the 2024 class, being recognized in the Amateur Athlete Category not only for her tremendous success on the lanes but also for her continued hard work for the betterment of the sport. Friis first picked up her bowling skills in the late sixties coming up through the youth bowling programs at Echo Lanes, Lake Huron Lanes and Marcin Bowl, to become one of Canada's premier lady bowlers. Her performance on the lanes, her coaching and her volunteer services have been a huge addition to the great sport of 10-pin bowling.



Jo Ellen tossed 633 (231 – 63 pins over average – 190-212 – 129 pins over average for three games) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl, to register the ladies third high triple of the week. Jo Ellen is averaging 170 for 81 games in the MFFL this season. Last season in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League she averaged 166 for 73 games. Her career sanctioned high scores are 687 and 268.

Kelly's last four weeks on the lanes have shown her strength in scoring nice triples as once again she posted another 600 triple. Kelly fired 623 (182-223-218) in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl, to post the ladies 4<sup>th</sup> high triple of the week.
