Weekly Highlights

Best is number one:



Brad Best hurled 758 (280 – 77 pins over average - 278 – 75 pins over average – 200 – 149 pins over average for three games) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men’s League (SPBCML) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl, to register the high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition. It was his first 700 of the season. Best had no 700’s last season as he missed half of the season due to a hand injury but he did have 4-700’s in the 2023-2024 season. Best’s career high triple is 768 (279-235-254) which he posted in the 2021-2022 season and his career high single is 299 (4 pin) which he rolled in the 2023-2024 season. Brad is now averaging 213 for 15 games in the SPBCML this season.

Crowe nipped to second:



Devon Crowe fired 757 (256 – 57 pins over average – 279 – 80 pins over average – 222 – 160 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl, to record the second high triple in LCTA bowling action this past week. It was his first 700 of the season. Last season he had 3-700’s. Crowe’s career high triple is 759 (256-267-236) which he bowled in the FTBMNML last season and his career high single is 289 which he posted in the old Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League in the 2019-2020 season. Devon is a graduate of the Hi-Way Bowl Youth Phantom Bowling Program. The twenty-four-year-old started knocking down the pins and sharing the friendship on the lanes at age five. Crowe is averaging 212 for 12 games in the FTBMNML this season.



Scott wheels career high triple:

Braeden Scott wheeled 667 (265 – 66 pins over average – 204-198) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling action to register his career new high triple. His previous high triple was 659 (287-226-146) and his high single is 287 bowling both in the Phantom Youth League at Marcin Bowl in the 2022-2023 season. Braeden started bowling at age 9 in the Marcin Bowl Youth Junior Bowlers Program and is entering his 13th year on the lanes. When Braeden first hit the lanes as a Bantam in the 2013-2014 season he ended the year with a 67 average for 84 games. This year in the FTBMNML he is averaging 207 for 9 games.

Youth bowler posts new high triple:

Karys Nesbitt rolled 500 (152-182 – 54 pins over average – 166 – 116 pins over average for three games) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl, to establish a new personal high triple. Her previous high triple was 457 (130-167 160) which she bowled in the PYL last season. She also tied her career high single with her 182. Karys is averaging 128 after 4 weeks of bowling in the PYL this season. Last season she averaged 131 for 96 games in the league.

Legault fires new high single:

Noah Legault fired 246 (56 pins over average) in his second game of the day to top his previous high single of 245 which he bowled in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) last season. He was bowling at Marcin Bowl on lanes 23 & 24 finishing the day with 604 (171-246-187) triple. Noah’s career high triple is 606 (203-208-195) which he posted last season in the PYL. Noah is averaging 190 after 4 weeks in the league this season. Last year in the PYL he averaged 170 for 75 games.

Hipple records triplicate:

Jim Hipple tossed 462 (154-154-154) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men’s League on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl, to record the first triplicate in the LCTA this season. Other triplicates the last three seasons in the LCTA included Larry Plumb 639 (213 213-213), Chris Murphy 567 (189-189-189), Eric Phillion 408 (136-136-136), Cooper Leneve 267 (89-89-89), Xander Simmons 234 (78-78-78), Cheryl

Karchewski 300 (100-100-100), Mel Kongus 549 (183-183-183), John Armstrong 741 (247-247-247) and Ben Lapointe 684 (228-228-228).

Shephard has solid week:

Mike Shephard hurled 723 (235-232-256) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 21 & 22 and 703 (246-213-244) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 19 & 20 both at Marcin Bowl, to record the 3rd and 6th high triples of the week in the LCTA. It was his 3rd and 4th 700's of the season and Shephard now trails Ben Lapointe by two in the year's 700 race, to see who will be the "King of the Lanes" when the season ends next year.

Mike is averaging 216 for 12 games in the BWCL and 228 for 12 games in the FTBMNML this season.

Lapointe lead decreases:

Ben Lapointe rolled 719 (242-198-279 – 65 pins over average) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl, to post the 4th high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was his 6th 700 this season and his career 149th 700 broken down into 133 in adult leagues and 16 in youth leagues. Lapointe's lead decreased to two in the year's 700 race as Mike Shephard had 2-700's this week. Ben is averaging 221 for 12 games in the BWCL this season.

Mezzatesta joins 700 club:

Paul Mezzatesta fired 711 (219-212- 280 – 76 pins over average) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl to record his first 700 of the season and the 5th high triple of the week in the LCTA. Mezzatesta had 4-700's last season. Paul's career high triple is 799 (266 -267-266) which he rolled in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League last season and his high single is 300 which he registered in the SPBCML last season. Mezzatesta is now averaging 211 for 15

games in the SPBCML this season.
