## **Weekly Highlights**

### **Correction:**

Last week this writer said there were 10 perfect games in the Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) this season. There are actually 11 with Jason Lapointe's 300. His picture has been added to the Honour Scores list.

## **Ridealgh's dream comes true:**



Every competitive bowler dreams of achieving the triple crown in 10 pin bowling (300-700-800) before they hang up their bowling shoes and park their bowling balls. Jamie Ridealgh was close a couple times and finally accomplished his last leg of the crown when he slaughtered the pins in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) this past Sunday. The pins never had a chance as Ridealgh had a super day on the lanes that he will remember for a long time. He hurled 823 (299 – 10 pin – 84 pins over average – 225 – 299 – 10 pin – 84 pins over average – 178 pins over average for three games) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl, to walk off the lanes with that magic number in his pocket. It was the 4<sup>th</sup> 800 in the LCTA this season, with the other three belonging to Ben Lapointe (812), Jim Lapointe (804) and Shane Chipman (803). He rolled 29 out of a possible 36 strikes in his accomplishment. His triple was good for the high triple of the week as he left the other bowlers behind in the dust and his 299's were the high single of the week in the LCTA. It was his 3<sup>rd</sup> 700 of the season as he previously bowled 726 (245-225-256) and 700 (189-256-255). Ridealgh's old high triple was 797 and he also has a 793 (279-268-246) to his credit. His career high single is 300 (2). Jamie is now averaging 219 for 60 games in the BWCL this season. CONGRATULATIONS Jamie!!



**Yap fires first 700 series:**

Gavin Yap fired 704 (217- 37 pins over average – 231 – 51 pins over average – 256 – 76 pins over average – 164 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl, to register his career first 700 triple and tie for the 8<sup>th</sup> high triple of the week. His previous high triple was 643 (176-256-211) which he bowled in the FTBMNML this season. He also tied his high single of 256. Yap, a right handed 2-handed bowler, started bowling 10-pin at age 20 and has been knocking down the pins for 2 years, but this year is his first time in an organized sanctioned league. He is averaging 183 after 57 games bowling on the “Boulevard Grill” team.

**McKinnon rolls new high triple:**

Dylon McKinnon rolled 647 (206-219 – 44 pins over average – 222 – 47 pins over average – 122 pins over average for three games) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men’s League (SPBCML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl, to post a career new high triple in LCTA bowling action this past week. His previous high triple was 616 (229-197-190) which he bowled in the SPBCML last season. His sanctioned high single is 246 which he recorded in the SPBCML in the 2023-2024 season. McKinnon is averaging 177 for 75 games in the SPBCML this season. Last season in the league he averaged 174 for 60 games.

**Klompstra tops his high triple:**

Logan Klompstra wheeled 566 (202-192-172) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl, to record a new personal high triple in LCTA bowling play. His previous high triple was 548 (225-205-118) which he bowled in the MFFL this season. Logan’s career sanctioned high single is 227. Klompstra is averaging 156 for 64 games in the MFFL this season. Last season in the league he averaged 150 for 51 games.



**Best and Kelch fire new high three:**

Liam Best fired 493 (156 – 26 pins over average – 166 – 36 pins over average – 171 – 41 pins over average – 103 pins over average for three games) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl, to post a new personal high triple in LCTA bowling activity this past week. His previous high triple was 477 (147-176-154) which he bowled in the PYL last season and his high single is 177 also bowled in the PYL last season. Liam is averaging 130 after 25 weeks of bowling this season. Last season in the league he averaged 116 for 93 games.

Silas Kelch rolled 427 (137-150 – 52 pins over average – 140) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl, to establish a new personal high triple. His previous high triple was 400 (141-114-145) which he bowled in the PYL this season. He also tied his high single with his 150 game. Silas is averaging 98 after 25 weeks on the lanes this season. Last season he averaged 88 for 63 games.

**Trio post new high singles:**

Dion Maness, Marianne Woolaver and Brynn Nesbitt posted new high singles in LCTA bowling activity this past week.

Maness tossed 231 (+73) in his last game of the night topping his previous 227. He was bowling in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl finishing with a 541 triple. Dion's sanctioned high triple is 595 (220-193-182) which he bowled in the MFFL this season. Dion is averaging 159 for 54 games in the MFFL this season. Last season he averaged 158 for 93 games in the league.

Woolaver rolled 213 (+74) in her second game of the night topping her previous 194. She was bowling in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl, finishing the night with a 533 triple. Marianne is averaging 141 for 75 games in the MFFL this season. Last season in the league she averaged 142 for 93 games.

Nesbitt fired 171 (+51) in her second game of the day topping her previous 162. She was bowling in the Phantom Youth League on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl, finishing the day with a 357 triple. Brynn's career high triple is 423 (161-122-140) which she



bowled in the PYL this season. Brynn is averaging 120 after 25 weeks on the lanes. Last season she averaged 100 for 87 games.

### **Smythe rolls Triplicate:**



Joe Smythe wheeled 504 (168-168-168) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl, to record the second triplicate in the LCTA this season. The first one was recorded by Jim Hipple 462 (154-154-154) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League. Other triplicates the last three seasons in the LCTA included Larry Plumb 639 (213 213-213), Chris Murphy 567 (189-189-189), Eric Phillion 408 (136-136-136), Cooper Leneve 267 (89-89-89), Xander Simmons 234 (78-78-78), Cheryl Karchewski 300 (100-100-100), Mel Kongus 549 (183-183-183), John Armstrong 741 (247-247-247) and Ben Lapointe 684 (228-228-228).

### **Reid enters 700 club:**



George Reid tossed 742 (258 – 38 pins over average – 256 – 36 pins over average – 228) in the Klean and Brite Thursday Night Mixed League on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl, to record the 2<sup>nd</sup> high triple of the week and his first 700 of the season in LCTA bowling play. Reid has been away from bowling for the last seven years and it's really great to see him back on the lanes again. His last LCTA year book averages from the 2017-2018 season showed him participating in three leagues. Those leagues with his averages and number of games in brackets were the following: Border City Men's League 215 (21), Marcin Sunday Morning Men's League 208 (48) and Bluewater Monday Night Men's League 204 (51). Reid's career sanctioned high scores are 819 (4) and 300 (8).

### **Watson takes third spot:**

Bryce Watson fired 731 (232-256-243 – 116 pins over average for three games) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl, to record the 3<sup>rd</sup> high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was his 8<sup>th</sup> 700 of the season and he now has a career 23-700's to his credit. Bryce is averaging 206 for 72 games in the MFFL this season.
