Watson leads the way:



Brian Watson fired 759 (235-278-246 – 177 pins over average for three games) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) at Marcin Bowl to lead the way on the lanes recording the top triple in Lambton County Tenpin Association bowling action this past week. Brian is a steady right handed bowler who has carried notable averages in the BMNML over the last nine years. Starting in the 2010-2011 season and going to the 2018-2019 season his final averages in the BMNML were 218, 212, 214, 212, 208, 215, 210, 203 and 212.

Marciniszyn is a close second:

Mike Marciniszyn rolled 757 (277-256-224) in the Sunday Morning Men's League (SMML) at Marcin Bowl to record the second high triple in LCTA bowling action this past week. Mike is a smooth right handed bowler who has had solid averages for the last nine years in the SMML. Starting in the 2010-2011 season and going to the 2018-2019 season his final averages in the league were 218, 217, 217, 217, 216, 218, 223, 224 and 229.

Spence takes third:

Bob Spence tossed 751 (268-226-257 – 265 pins over this year's average) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) at Marcin Bowl to register the week's third high triple. Bob is a right handed bowler who has been carrying a consistent average over the last nine years in the BMNML but dropping slightly the last two years. Starting in the 2010-2011 season and going to the 2018-2019 season his final averages in the BMNML were 207, 202, 205, 208, 199, 201, 205, 195 and 196.

Plumb slides into fourth:



Larry Plumb hurled 742 (243-236-263) in the Sunday Morning Men's League (SMML) at Marcin Bowl to post the fourth high triple of the week.
