Weekly Highlights

Renaud fires 300:

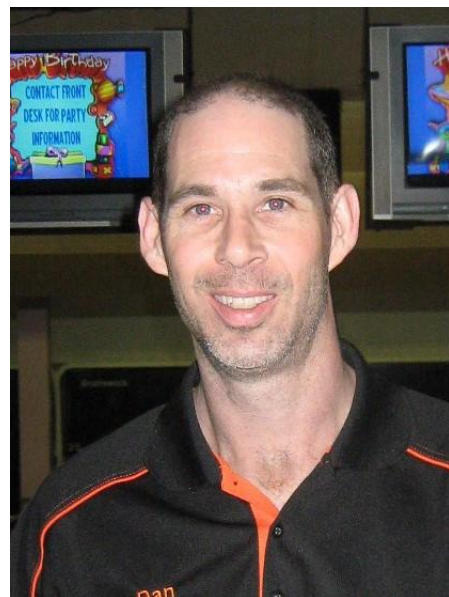


Marc Renaud fired 12 consecutive strikes in his first game of the night in the Thursday Night Mixed League on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl to roll a perfect game and record the high single of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action. It was his career 8th 300 and the 5th posted in the LCTA 2022-2023 bowling season. He finished the night with 721 (300 – 80 pins over average – 195 -

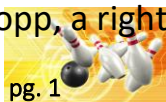
226) which was good for the second high triple of the week. Renaud is averaging 221 in the league after 13 weeks of bowling.

Chopper is almost perfect:

Dan Chopp tossed the first eleven rock solid pocket strikes in game two in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League. On his last delivery he left a solid unapologetic 10 pin to end up with a 299 (79 pins over average) to take the honours for the week's second high single in LCTA bowling action. He was sparing in the league bowling on lanes 27 & 28 finishing the night with a 685 triple.



Chopp, a right handed smooth rolling bowler, has the following sanctioned scores to his



credit: 300's (8) - 299 (1) - 298 (1) and his highest triple is 797. His unsanctioned scores are 824 and 7-300's.

Lucas records first 600 series:



Jason Lucas hurled 602 (222- 61 pins over average - 212-168) in the Border City Men's League (BCML) on lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl to record his career first 600 series. Lucas started bowling at age 18 but not through a youth bowling league. A good friend of his suggested bowling as a winter sport so he joined the BCML in the 2015-2016 bowling season and has been in the league for 7 years counting this year. He

took last season off with Covid creating havoc in bowling centers. His averages for the last 6 years in the BCML were 155-162-166-171-164-157 and this year he is averaging 164 for 39 games. Jason's highest single game is 255 and his previous high triple was 597. His other sporting interests are golf and hockey with cars and "Sim" racing taking up his time as a hobby. "Sim" racing is simulated racing reflecting real racing as accurately as possible taking into account fuel consumption, tire wear and vehicle set up. Lucas bowls on the team "Lambton Metal Services" with Franco Gabriele, Ryan Treulieb, Franco Savo and Vince Savo.

Adamson posts top triple:

Kyle Adamson rolled 738 (289 – 91 pins over average – 266 – 68 pins over average - 183 – 144 pins over average for three games) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl to post the top triple of the week in LCTA bowling competition. Adamson is now averaging 202 for 33 games in the BMNML bowling on the team "Bluewater Ideas" with Louie Willemsen, Ron Paquette and David Paquette.

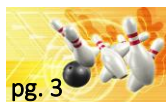


Kielt one pin shy for a watch:

Ryan Kielt wheeled 268 (99 pins over average) missing out on a Canadian Tenpin Federation (CTF) watch by one pin. The CTF awards a bowler a watch for anyone who bowls 100 pins over their average in a single game. Kielt was bowling in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) on lanes 25 & 26 in his second game of the night at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with a 623 triple. Kielt was 8 years old when he started bowling in a 5 pin youth program. Ryan then switched to 10 pin when he was 10 years old joining the Saturday morning Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program. He remained in the program until he was 19 and then left organized bowling for a while. He returned to bowling in an adult mixed league for a few years until he started a family and then left league bowling for about fifteen years. In the years in-between he said he only did some Rock n Bowl with his kids. Nowadays he said he enjoys hanging out with his family and he and his son have recently began playing in a Cornhole league. For people who are not familiar with Cornhole, it is a game in which small bags filled with corn are tossed at a target consisting of an inclined wooden platform with a hole at one end. Kielt's highest sanctioned scores are 290 and 718. He is averaging 173 for 33 games in the BMNML this year bowling on the team "The Incredibowls" with Patrick Mumby, Andre Dion and Jon Bauman.

Watson takes third position:

Brian Watson fired 701 (236-227-238) in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl to take third position in the weekly 700 cub race. It was his second 700 in the SMCL this year as he previously bowled a 706 (256-207-243).
