Weekly Highlights

Lapointe Senior smashes 800 barrier:



Jim Lapointe hurled 804 (277 – 60 pins over average – 258 – 41 pins over average – 269 – 52 pins over average – 153 pins over average for three games) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men’s League (SPBCML) as a spare on lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl, to record the high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action. Jim had 28 out of a possible 36 strikes, 10 in his first game, and 9 in each of his last two games, in his accomplishment. It was the 3rd 800 in the LCTA this season the other two belonging to Ben Lapointe (812) and Shane

Chipman (803). It was Lapointe’s career 6th 800, his other ones being 800, 812, 802, 845 (300-300-245) and 835. It was also Lapointe’s 5th 700 plus this season as he previously rolled 711, 725, 720 and 742. Super bowling Jim !!

Lapointe and Shephard are perfect:

Jason Lapointe and Mike Shephard tossed perfect games this past week in Sarnia league and Port Huron tournament action.



Lapointe rolled his 300 in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl, in LCTA bowling competition, finishing the day with 757 (300-211-246) which was good for the 3rd high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was Lapointe’s career 4th 300 and the 8th in the LCTA this season. It was also his 3rd 700 of the season as he previously bowled 702 and 718. It’s been a long time since Lapointe enjoyed this moment of glory as his previous 300’s came in the 2008-2009 season and 2011-2012 season when he notched two of them.



Jason is averaging 212 for 72 games in the BWCL this season. Last season in the league he averaged 206 for 87 games and 223 for 54 games in the Klean and Brite Thursday Night Mixed League. Jason's career high triple is 792.



Shephard hurled his 300 in his third game of the day in the Port Huron Bowling Association Team Tournament held at Port Huron Lanes (PHL) this past weekend. Mike now has a career 14-300's to his credit in the Canadian Tenpin Federation (CTF) and the United States Bowling Congress (USBC). It was Mike's first 300 in the USBC so he is eligible to get a 300 ring from the USBC. Shephard participates in the Cowboys and Indians League at PHL and is averaging 222 for 66 games this season. Shephard was also solid on the lanes in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl, hurling 754 (268 – 48 pins over average – 255-231) which was good for the 4th high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was his 18th 700 of the season and he is averaging 222 for 72 games in the league.

Ingles registers first 700 series:



Zachary Ingles experienced the excitement of bowling his career first 700 in LCTA bowling action this past week. He wheeled 701 (210-247 – 74 pins over average – 244 – 71 pins over average – 182 pins over average for three games) in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl, to register the 10th high triple of the week in the LCTA. Zachary's highest previous triple was 676 (239-218-219) which he bowled in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) at Marcin Bowl last season. His sanctioned high single is 253 which he bowled in the PYL this season. Zachary is now averaging 185 for 15 games as a spare in the RCAFA league this season.

Ridealgh is second best:



Bill Ridealgh fired 759 (279 – 62 pins over average – 257 – 40 pins over average – 223) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl, to register the 2nd high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was his 5th 700 of the season as he previously bowled 743, 747, 776 (277-257-242) and 734. Ridealgh is averaging 219 for 69 games in the BWCL this season. Last season in the league he averaged 212 for 93 games.

Paquette records new high triple:

David Paquette tossed 730 (269 – 70 pins over average – 236-225 – 133 pins over average for three games) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl, to establish a new personal high triple and register the 6th high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was his first 700 of the season. Paquette had 1-700 in the LCTA last season. Paquette's previous high triple was 717 (231-264-222) which he bowled in the Sunday Morning Classic League at Marcin Bowl in the 2022-20232 season. His sanctioned high triple is 290. Paquette is averaging 202 for 60 games in the BWCL this season. David started bowling at age 12 in the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program and remained in the league for 5 years under the watchful eyes of coaches Gil and Carol Jean. The 32-year-old right hander has been knocking down the pins ever since, with a break for a few years when he attended college. He got interested in bowling because he comes from a bowling family with his grandfather and father being avid bowlers over the years.

Cook bowls first 600 series:

Chad Cook wheeled 622 (197-169-256 – 85 pins over average) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on Lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl, to record his career first 600 series in LCTA bowling activity this past week. Cook's previous high triple was 598 (221-169-208) posted in the MFFL this season. His 256 was also a new personal high single topping his previous 231 which he bowled in the MFFL this season. Cook is averaging 173 for 51 games in the MFFL this season bowling in a sanctioned league for the first time.

Lapointe extends his lead:

Ben Lapointe rolled 738 (236-247-255) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl, to post the 5^h high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was his 23rd 700 of the season in the LCTA and his career 164th. He now leads the King of the Lanes race by 5-700's. Lapointe is averaging 222 for 66 games in the SPBCML this season.



Koundakjian is 100 pins over average:

Werner Koundakjian rolled 266 (107 pins over average) in his first game of the night, to be eligible for 100 pins over average for a single game award (if he hasn't already received this award) which is a watch for his effort. He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl, finishing with a 572 triple. Koundakjian's previous high single was 243 and his career high triple is 617 (215-202-200) which he posted in the 2023-2024 season. Werner, a right-handed bowler, started bowling at age 39 and has been bowling for 16 years. He started sanctioned league bowling in the 2018-2019 bowling season in the FTBMNML. His other interests are hockey, basketball and football. As a hobby he loves playing pool and wood working.

Trio roll new high triples:

Kyle Bogaert, Dion Maness and Logan Klompstra established new personal high triples in LCTA bowling play this past week.

Bogaert wheeled 635 (182 – 230 – 70 pins over average – 223 – 63 pins over average – 131 pins over average for three games) in the Klean and Brite Thursday Night Mixed League (KBTNML) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl, to post a new personal high triple topping his previous 614. His career high single is 256 which he bowled in the KBTNML last season. Kyle is averaging 162 after 23 weeks in the KBTNML this season. Last season in the league he averaged 174 for 96 games.

Maness rolled 595 (220 – 61 pins over average – 193-182 – 124 pins over average for three games) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl, topping his previous high triple 589 which he bowled in the MFFL last season. His career high single is 227. Maness is averaging 159 for 48 games in the MFFL this season. Last season in the league he averaged 158 for 93 games,

Klompstra tossed 548 (225 – 73 pins over average – 205-118) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl, topping his previous high triple 526 which he bowled in the MFFL last season. His 225 also topped his previous 224 high single. Klompstra is averaging 153 for 58 games in the MFFL this season. Last season in the league he averaged 150 for 51 games.



MacDuff enters 700 club:

Lefty Ralph MacDuff tossed 726 (269 – 78 pins over average – 237-220 – 153 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl, to post his first 700 of the season and the 7th high triple of the week in LCTA bowling competition. MacDuff had no 700’s last season but had 2-700’s in the 2023-2024 season. MacDuff is averaging 193 for 63 games in the FTBMNML this season. Ralph’s career sanctioned high scores are 835 which he bowled on March 1, 1999 at Port Huron Lanes and 300 -11 (8 in Sarnia and 3 in Port Huron).

Parkkila ties his high triple:

Cameron Parkkila rolled 690 (246-226-218) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling action, to tie his 690 (209-260-221) which he bowled in the MFFL last season. Parkkila’s sanctioned high single is 276 which he bowled in the MFFL this season. Cameron is averaging 201 for 69 games in the MFFL this season. Cameron started bowling 10 pin when he was six years old but the following two years he wanted to give 5 pin bowling a chance. However he returned to the 10 pin lanes and has been enjoying the fun and friendship with his twin brother “Kole” and fellow

bowlers ever since.

Murphy reaches fourteen:

Chris Murphy hurled 720 (196 – 266 – 50 pins over average – 258 – 42 pins over average) in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League on lanes 23 & 24 and 707 (254 – 43 pins over average – 257 - 46 pins over average – 196) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men’s League (SPBCML) on lanes 25 & 26 both at Marcin Bowl, to post the 8th and 9th high triples of the week in the LCTA. The “Murph” is bowling/sparing in 4 leagues this year. His averages with the number of games in brackets are the following: RCAFA 216 (48), Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League 210 (36), Best Wiring Classic League 213 (51) and Sarnia Produce Border City Men’s League 212

(59).



Choptovy holds down the basement:



Stewart Choptovy wheeled 700 (235-240-225) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl, to register the low triple of the week in the LCTA and his 4th 700 of the season. His previous 700's were 713, 715 and 747. Stewart is averaging 207 for 63 games in the FTBMNML this season. Last season in the league he averaged 184 for 96 games. His career sanctioned high scores are 747 (278-203-266) which he bowled in the FTBMNML this season and 299 bowled in the Greater Toronto Bowling Association.

Rudi Mulder tossed 203 (59 pins over average) in his first game of the night to tie his previous high single. He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl, finishing with 526 (203-167-156). Mulder's career high triple is 531 (198-144-189) which he bowled in the FTBMNML this season. Rudi is averaging 146 for 48 games in the FTBMNML this season bowling on the "Mulder Financial" team. He is also bowling in the Mulder Financial Fun League this year averaging 143 for 60 games.

The Callanders - A seven decade bond:

At 93 years old, Rigby Callander is still rolling strong — and making history — as Sarnia's oldest sanctioned bowler. Born and raised in Sarnia, Callander first stepped onto the lanes at Marcin Bowl in 1957, when a group of co-workers from Dow Chemical formed a Thursday night men's league. Just four years later, in 1959, the league evolved into a mixed league — and remarkably, it's the very same league that continues to roll on today. Bowling has been a lifelong passion for Callander. After marrying his late wife, Marie, in 1960, she joined him in the league the following year. Over the decades, he has served in numerous executive roles, helping guide and grow the league he helped start. He was inducted into the LCTA Life Member group in 2018-2019 season. A right-handed bowler, Callander has posted impressive numbers over the years, including a career-high sanctioned triple of 663 and a single-game high of 277. During the 2001–2002 season, he achieved his best season average of 176. This year, through 22 weeks of play, he's maintaining a solid 141 average. Beyond the lanes, Callander is a proud father of four, grandfather of five, and great-grandfather of two. In 2021, bowling became even more meaningful when his eldest son, Mark, moved from Windsor to Sarnia for work and joined the league while living with his father. Although Mark returned to Windsor three years later, he still makes the weekly trip back to Sarnia every Thursday — not just to compete, but to spend time with his dad. Today, father and son share the same team, turning Thursday nights into a cherished family tradition — proof that for the Callander's, bowling isn't just a game, it's a bond that's lasted more than seven decades.
