Croskery perfect with high triple:



Jordan Croskery fired 12 consecutive canonizing strikes in his second game on lanes 19 & 20 in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) at Marcin Bowl to record the high single of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action. It was the smooth right handers career sanctioned 6th 300 and only the 2nd perfect game in the LCTA this season. Croskery finished the night with 774 (238 -300 - 81 pins over average -236) which was also good for the high triple of the week. Jordan started bowling at age 11 coming up through the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program and has been hitting the lanes for 17 years. Jordan is bowling in two leagues this year: the Target Trios Mixed League at Hi-Way Bowl and the BMNML. He also spares in

other leagues as required. He said his biggest accomplishment in bowling was when he won the JAX 60 HAMMER CHAMPIONSHIP in Jackson Michigan on April 20th of this year defeating 82 other competitors to wear the championship crown with a payout of two grand. This tournament was part of the Midwest Scratch Bowling Series which takes



place in Indiana, Illinois, Ohio and Michigan. In the process he rolled 15 games – 167 – 180 – 299 – 199 – 192 – 234 – 183 – 213 - 249 – 265 – 210 -172 -203 -224 – 194 to average 212 for the tournament. Jordan also took part in the 2019 Team Canada Trials in Montreal where 90 bowlers from British Columbia, Alberta, Saskatchewan, Manitoba, Ontario and Quebec were trying to make the top 6 spots on the men’s team. He finished in 8th position just missing the cut line by 58 pins while rolling 24 games over 4 days averaging 210. Jordan has 2-800’s (808- 826 – bowled in 2014) to his credit.

Marciniszyn tops for the ladies:



Pam Marciniszyn rolled 664 (223-236) In the Thursday Night Mixed League (TNML) at Marcin Bowl to record the ladies high triple of the week. Pam, a right handed bowler, is averaging 208 after 39 games. Last year in the TNML she finished the year with a 207 for 96 games.

Reynolds rolls his highest triple:

Allen Reynolds was pretty excited last week at the end of the night in the 1046 Mixed League at Marcin Bowl. He had just finished rolling his career highest triple 552 (178-190-63 pins over average - 184 – 171 pins over average for three games) and also took second place for the men's week high over average for three games. He started the night with a 127 average and finished the night with a 132 average for 33 games. Last year in the league he finished the season with a 140 average.

Pullman tops with high over average:

Vince Pullman fired 515 (191 – 81 pins over average – 186 pins over average for three games) in the Bluewater Monday Night

Men's League (BMNML) at Marcin Bowl to take the honours for the men's week high over average for three games. Vince, a first year bowler in the BMNML sparing for the "ODS" Printing team, is averaging 133 after 9 games.

Little is 100 plus pins over average:

Dave little tossed 279 – 117 pins over average on lanes 3 & 4 in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League at Hi-Way Bowl to register his highest personal game and the high over average for a single game in LCTA bowling this week. Dave started bowling at age 15 at Hi-Way Bowl. After 2 years, he left the lanes and returned 5 years later to bowl in the Airey Lanes Mixed League where he took up the roll as the league secretary. He took time off from bowling a few years later and returned in the 2000-2001 season when he joined the Marcin Bowl Ontario Hydro



Mixed League (MBOHML) where he was league secretary for 9 years. He bowled in the MBOHML until the 2015-2016 season. Then he joined the Marcin Sarnia Aamjiwnaang Mixed League for three years where he was president of the league. Last year he moved to the RCAFA league and this year the once a week bowler is averaging 160 after 13 weeks. He has consistently averaged around 160 with his highest average being 166 in the 2014-2015 season. His personal high triple is 642. Besides bowling, working as the Facilities Manager at the YMCA, baseball, darts and driving his “Harley” occupy his time.
