Weekly Highlights

Renaud is week's top kegler:



Marc Renaud fired 782 (247-257-278 – 56 pins over average – 116 pins over average for 3 games) in the Thursday Night Mixed League on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl to take the honours as the week's top kegler in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition. It was his 4th 700 series in the league this year as he previously bowled 719 (248-224-247), 726 (256-257-213) and 721 (300-195-226). Renaud is now averaging 224 for 42 games in the

league.

Simmons rolls career first 700:

Joe Simmons bowled 708 (258 – 92 pins over average – 203 – 247 – 210 pins over average for three games) in the Border City Men's League (BCML) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl to record his career first 700 triple and tie for sixth spot in the 700 division this week. Simmons started bowling at age 8 coming up through the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program and he has been knocking down the pins for 30 years. He got interested in bowling after watching his parents bowl in a Sunday mixed league. His other sporting interest is baseball which he played for many years. His personal



career sanctioned high scores are 300 (youth bowler) and 708. Simmons raised his average from 166 to 171 after 39 games in the BCML.

Mezzatesta a close second:



Roy Mezzatesta tossed 766 (225-263 – 59 pins over average – 278 – 74 pins over average – 154 pins over average for three games) in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl to post the second high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. Mezzatesta is bowling full time in four leagues this year with his averages and games in brackets: Target Trios League 199 (42), Border City Men's League 209 (39), Bluewater Monday Night Men's League 200 (30) and SMCL 208 (33).

Meredith qualifies for a watch:

Chris Meredith wheeled 234 (101 pins over average) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's (BMNML) League on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl to take the honours as the high over average for a single game this week and he qualified for a Canadian Tenpin Federation watch. This is Meredith's first year in the BMNML and he is averaging 137 for 33 games. He is bowling with team members Jamie Barron, Joe Smythe and Jason Fox.

Adamson has two solid triples:

Kyle Adamson rolled 736 (231- 259 – 66 pins over average – 246 – 157 pins over average for three games) in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl to have a solid day on the lanes hurling the third high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. It was his 2nd 700 series in the SMCL this year as he previously bowled 706 (246-



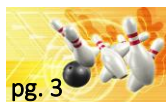
209-251). He also had 720 (258-217-245) in the Border City Men's League (BCML) this week for the fourth high triple of the week. Adamson is bowling in three leagues this year with his averages and games in brackets: SMCL 198 (33), Bluewater Monday Night Men's League 202 (36) and BCML 203 (42).

Harris breaks 700:



Fred Harris tossed 718 (235 – 248 – 65 pins over average – 235 – 169 pins over average for three games) in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl to register his first 700 of the year and take fifth place in the high triple department this week in LCTA bowling activity. Harris started bowling 10-pin at age 15 when his uncle Joe got him interested in the game and he has been knocking down the pins for 60 years. Fred has 8-300's (sanctioned) to his credit and his highest sanctioned triple is 794. He is averaging 187 for 39 games in the SMCL this year. Harris has bowled in 45 American Bowling Congress (ABC) / United States Bowling Congress tournaments which are held in different locations throughout the United States each year. This scratch

tournament usually runs over a 3-4 month period and has on average 50,000-70,000 participants each year. Fred said his most memorable moment in bowling was in 1984 when he and his doubles partner Dan Russo took the lead in the ABC tournament in Baltimore with 2 months to go and eventually ended up in 22nd position (an admirable feat). He also said he remembers bowling against this writer (Honker) in the finals also in 1984 in a Southern Ontario Majors Tournament at Southland Bowl in London where he edged out victory in a 2 game roll off. Harris took home \$ 500.00 and Honker \$250.00. Not too bad then in 1984 dollars.



Skinner ties for sixth spot:

Kyle Skinner wheeled 708 (279 – 69 pins over average - 223 – 206) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (BMNML) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl to tie for sixth place in the 700 race this week. It was his 2nd 700 series in the BMNML this year as he previously tossed a 717 (258-236-223). This is Skinner’s 5th year in the BMNML. His previous averages starting from the 2020 – 2021 season and descending downward were 211 – 207 – 173 (injury) and 204. Skinner is averaging 212 for 30 games in the league this year.

Plumb grabs last place:

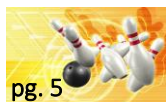

Plumb, a strong right handed bowler who usually plays between the 5 and 10 board with a lot of speed, is averaging 214 for 39 games in the SMCL and 217 for 12 games in the BMNML.

Pam Marciniszyn rolled 628 (236-203) in the Thursday Night Mixed League on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl to record the ladies high triple of the week. Pam is averaging 203 for 42 games in the league. She is bowling with team members Ryan Chambers, Rick Kloczko, Jayme LeNeve and Marsha Pinel.
