Weekly Highlights

Lewicki holds down first place:



Lefty Steve Lewicki rolled 719 (234-209-276 – 64 pins over average) as a spare in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl, to register the high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition. It was his 3rd 700 of the season in the LCTA as he previously posted 719 (267-236-216) and 705 (246-254-205). Steve is averaging 213 for 57 games in the BWCL this year. Lewicki has quite the bowling achievements to his credit with 21-300's and 13-800's in the Canadian Tenpin Federation, the defunct American Bowling Congress and the United States Bowling Congress in league and tournament action. His 13-800's have been spread around in different bowling centers. He has 5

at Marcin Bowl, 2 at Hi-Way Bowl and 6 in action in the Port Huron Tenpin Bowling Association (PHTBA) in Michigan. His 7-800's in the LCTA were 836, 801, 809, 814, 806, 836 and 836. His career high triple is 857 which he posted in the PHTBA in the 2010 – 2011 bowling season.

Youth bowler records new high scores:

Tayllum Taylor tossed 395 (180 – 62 pins over average – 95-120) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling fun, to top his previous high scores of 312 and 124. Tayllum is averaging 118 after 31 weeks of bowling in the league this year. Last year in the PYL he averaged 80 for 81 games.



Gabriele takes second place:



Franco Gabriele hurled 717 (226-268 – 73 pins over average – 223) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl to record the second high triple of the week in LCTA bowling combat. It was his second 700 of the season as he previously bowled 769 (290-220-259) back in October in the SPBCML and they turned out to be his career high scores. Gabriele is averaging 197 for 90 games in the SPBCML this season. Last season in the league he averaged 188 for 69 games.

Adamson records number seven:



Kyle Adamson wheeled 710 (253-233-224) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl to take third spot in the high triple department this past week in LCTA bowling action. It was his 7th 700 of the season as he previously bowled 709, 747, 715, 705, 715 and 756. Adamson is averaging 212 for 96 games in the BWCL this season. Kyle has a career 6-800's to his credit in the LCTA (802, 813, 801, 804, 805 and 805) and 8-300's. He bowled his last 300 in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League back in February of this bowling season.

Ridealgh comes in last:



Bill Ridealgh fired 709 (244-221-244) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl, to record the low triple of the week in LCTA bowling warfare. It was his 10th 700 of the season as he previously bowled 759, 721, 705, 716, 759, 722, 715, 743 and 712. Ridealgh is averaging 210 for 90 games in the FTBMNML this season. Bill's career high scores are 789 and 300 (4). A correction on Bill's 300 accomplishments. This writer reported that he had 2-300's when he actually had 4..... another senior moment. Ridealgh fired his 300's in the 2006-2007, 2007-2008, 2014-2015 and 2017-20018 bowling seasons.
