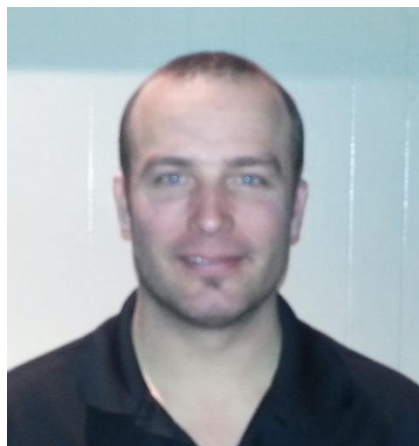

Ridealgh is tops:



Bill Ridealgh rolled 747 (233-269-245) in the Sunday Morning Men's League at Marcin Bowl to register the high triple in Lambton County Tenpin Association bowling (LCTA) action this week. Ridealgh is off to a great start this season as he is averaging 221 after twenty-four games.

Lapointe is perfect:



Jim Lapointe fired twelve consecutive strikes on lanes 35 & 36 in his last game in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League at Marcin Bowl to record a perfect game and walk off the lanes with the high single of the week. It was his career 6th 300 having bowled 4 at Marcin Bowl and 2 at Hi-Way Bowl. He finished the night with a 714 (255-300 – 93 pins over average) triple. It was the 5th 300 in the LCTA this season.

Lapointe leads the way for the youth:

Ben Lapointe rolled 735 (232-256-247) on lanes 7 & 8 in the Phantoms Youth Senior League at Hi-Way Bowl to lead the way on the lanes for the youth bowlers. The right handed bowler rolls a ton of revs and now has 22 sanctioned 700 triples having tossed 10 in youth leagues and 12 in adult leagues. His highest sanctioned scores are 775, 2-298's and 2-299's.

Marciniszyn best bowler for the ladies:

Pam Marciniszyn tossed 685 (227-243) in the Thursday Night Mixed League (TNML) at Marcin Bowl to post the ladies high triple of the week. Pam is a right handed once a week bowler currently averaging 214 after twenty seven games. Her averages for the last seven years in the TNML starting in the 2010/2011 were 224, 223, 222, 216, 214, 218 and 206.
