

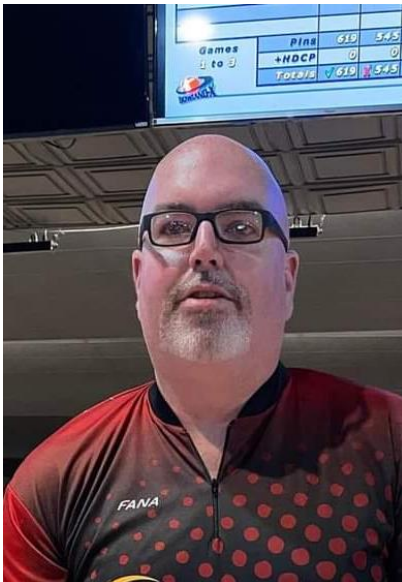

Weekly Highlights



Shephard is tops on the lanes:

Mike Shephard hurled 747 (289 – 88 pins over average – 204 – 254 – 144 pins over average for three games) on lanes 17 & 18 in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) at Marcin Bowl to take the honours for the high triple and high single in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition this past week. Shephard raised his average from 201 to 211 for 15 games in the SMCL with his solid performance. He is bowling on a team with Mike Jones and Brian Watson.

Lapointe adds to his 700 total:

Ben Lapointe tossed 735 (254-235-246) on lanes 17 & 18 in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) at Marcin Bowl to take second place in the high triple department in LCTA bowling action this week . He also recorded 725 (231 – 255 – 239) in the Friday Night Mixed League (FNML) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl. The twenty-four year old right handed bowler adds another two notches to his career 700 total which now stands at 68. This is an outstanding achievement for a bowler at such a young age. Lapointe is averaging 227 for 15 games in the SMCL and 227 for 15 games in the FNML.



Renaud holds down third:

Marc Renaud wheeled 726 (256 – 257 – 213) on lanes 17 & 18 in the Thursday Night Mixed League at Marcin Bowl to hold down third spot in the fight for high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. Marc started bowling at age 8 in the youth bowling program called “Sports Club 444” at Bowlero Bowl in Windsor and he has been hitting the lanes for twenty plus years. He has a career 7-300’s and 2-800’s (800-801) to his credit. The once a week right handed bowler, who throws a ton of revs, has returned to bowling this year after missing two years when Covid hammered our great sport of 10-pin bowling. Renaud last bowled in

the Marcin House Thursday Night Men’s League in the 2019 – 2020 season averaging 223 for 63 games.

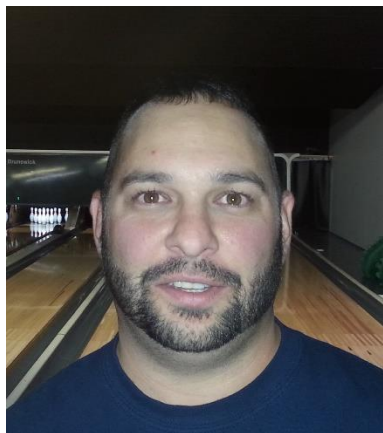
MacDuff drops to fourth:

Ralph MacDuff rolled 716 (279 – 80 pins over average - 181 -256) on lanes 21 & 22 in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) at Marcin Bowl to drop down to fourth spot in LCTA bowling play this week. MacDuff’s career sanctioned high scores are 300 (6) and 835 (1) which he recorded at Port Huron Lanes in 1999. The lefty is now averaging 207 for 15 games in the SMCL and is bowling with team members Mel Matthews and John Armstrong.

**Armstrong slides to fifth position:**

John Armstrong fired 712 (213 – 252 – 245) on lanes 21 & 22 in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) at Marcin Bowl to register the fifth high triple in LCTA bowling activity this week. It was his second 700 plus series in the SMCL this year as he previously bowled a 750 (235-259-256). Armstrong is now averaging 223 for 15 games in the SMCL.

Legault knocked to sixth place:



Pat Legault tossed 704 (236-243-225) on lanes 27 & 28 in the Friday Night Mixed League (FNML) at Marcin Bowl to take sixth place in the week's 700 race. This was his second 700 in the FNML this year as he also posted 715 (242 – 265 – 208) three weeks ago. Legault is averaging 224 for 15 games in the FNML.

Marciniszyn grabs last spot:

Mike Marciniszyn fired 701 (212 – 279 – 210) on lanes 23 & 24 in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling action to grab the last spot in the 700 club this week. Marciniszyn is now averaging 213 after 15 games in the SMCL and is bowling with team members Alex Salmons and Jeff Raymond. Marciniszyn returned to the SMCL this year after taking a two year break when Covid entered our city.
