Adamson ends season with top triple:



Kyle Adamson ended his bowling season with a solid 763 (264-246-253 – 154 pins over average for three games) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) at Marcin Bowl to record the high triple in the final week of bowling in the Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA). Kyle bowled full time in two leagues this year: the Marcin Sunday Morning Men's League (final average 211 – 96 games) and the BMNML (final average 205 - 87 games). He also spared in different leagues where his services were required. The right handed bowler tossed 7 - 700 plus triples this season (719-709-700-713-707-752-763) even after missing several weeks due to illness and recovery. Kyle has a

career sanctioned 7-300's and 6-800's to his credit.



Scott finishes strong:

Paul Scott fired 740 (242-245-253 – 146 pins over average for three games) in the Sunday Morning Men’s League at Marcin Bowl to register the second high triple in the final week of LCTA bowling action. Paul started bowling 5 pin at age 6 at Northgate Bowl but after a couple years he switched to 10 pin in the Marcin Bowl SMAA Youth Bowling Program and has been knocking down the pins for 40 years. The right handed bowler’s personal highest sanctioned scores are 782 and 300. His sanctioned 300 was in the Marcin Sunday Morning Men’s League (MSMML) on January 20, 2008. He also has a non-sanctioned natural 300 which he bowled in his final game in a no tap tournament after registering back to back no tap 300’s giving him a 900 series. This year he only bowled in the MSMML finishing the year with a 199 average for 96 games. Paul has been fairly successful in the Ontario Tenpin

Bowling Association Provincial Handicap Tournaments over the years: in 2009 he finished 3rd in the Singles Handicap Division at Kingston and last year he finished 8th in the Doubles Handicap Division with Stephane Sirois (22 pins out of 3rd place) in Windsor and 3rd in the All Events Handicap Division. His most memorable moment in bowling was of course when he rolled his first perfect game. He also said it was exciting to watch his kids start in the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program over the last couple years and watch them reach their first 200 games. Paul also said “bowling annually with my son in the Provincial Family Twosome Handicap Tournament (PFTHT) helping him raise scholarship funds for future education and this year watching my wife and daughter participate together as a team in the PFTHT for the first time tying for first place in their division was extremely exciting.”



The young kids in the LCTA:

Fred Cole is 88 years young and bowls in the Thursday Night Men's League at Marcin Bowl. He has been knocking down the pins for 58 years and has never missed a season. Fred worked at Dow Chemical for 33 years and next year he will be retired longer than he worked. He has been married to his beautiful wife "Bea" for 64 years. They had two children (Bill and Karen) and have 5 grandkids.

Fred has 2-300's to his credit, the first one bowled on his 71th birthday. In 2013, at age 83, he rolled 299 in the August Tournament of Roses at Rose Bowl in Windsor. He also has an 11 in a row 290 game under his belt. His highest league average was 204 in 2001, the same season he bowled his first perfect game. His career highest triple is 786.



Rigby Callander was born in Sarnia in 1932 which makes him 87 years young and he has been bowling in the Thursday Night Mixed League at Marcin Bowl for 61 years (previously a Dow Chemical League). He married a beautiful Kitchener girl in 1960 named "Marie" and they had identical twin girls and two sons one of which passed away at an early age of 30. All of his children bowled in the Marcin SMAA Youth Bowling Program at some time where he volunteered as a score marker (for you younger people that is a pencil keeping score on paper). He has 5 adult grandchildren.

Rigby's highest sanctioned scores are 663, 277 single game and a 176 average that he finished with in the 2001-2002 bowling season. He said his average is going down these



days but he is still having fun on the lanes with his fellow bowlers. He has been elected to all of the league's executive positions at one time or another over the years.

He was introduced to 5 pin bowling as a teen, bowling at Mitton Street Bowl and the downtown National Club Lanes where he earned spending money as a pin setter. He said "you had to be fast and agile in the lane pits as those pins flew at you fast and furious. Many times I went home with bruised shins and knuckles".

Rigby reminisced about the year (around 1958) when a team consisting of Bob Angove, Ron Kloske, Bob Reeves, Fred King and himself entered the annual Detroit Free Press tournament. They bowled early in the tournament and on the Monday sport page, they received headlines as being the first Canadian team to lead the tournament. On the final weekend he said "all the big guns from Detroit, Windsor and Ohio knocked us down in the standings but we made enough money to get our entry fee back". Rigby's closing info for this report was "I love to bowl and GOD willing, with good health, I will continue to bowl until they carry me off the lanes. HAPPY BOWLING EVERYONE"
