Weekly Highlights

Ramsay rolls top triple:



Dennis Ramsay rolled 734 (224-254 – 47 pins over average - 256 – 49 pins over average – 111 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl, to record the high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition. It was his first 700 of the year. Ramsay did not have any 700’s last season but had 2-700’s in the 2023-2024 season. Dennis is now averaging 215 for 18 games in the league bowling on the “Talkkirk Financial” team with Mel Matthews, George Newman and Ralph MacDuff. Last year, Ramsay averaged 200 for 84 games in the FTBMNML. Dennis has 2-800’s (827-822) and 3-300’s to his credit.

Wright tops his high scores:



Daniel Wright fired 639 (269 – 96 pins over average – 187-183) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl, to record new personal high scores in LCTA bowling action this past week. His previous high scores were 630 (225-211-194) and 259, both posted in the MFFL last season. Daniel is averaging 178 for 21 games in the league this season bowling with team mates Jose Guerrero/Ramirez, Greg Wright and Dave Grasser. Last year in the league he averaged 176 for 45 games.



Yap records first 600 series:



Gavin Yap bowled 604 (242 – 82 pins over average – 216 – 56 pins over average – 146 – 124 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl, to record his first 600 series and also his highest sanctioned single game. He said his highest game before was 258 but it happened in practice. Gavin started bowling at age 4 in a 5-pin youth league and he continued 5-pin bowling for 12 years. He started bowling 10-pin at age 20 and has been knocking down the pins for 2 years, but this year is his first time in an organized sanctioned league. Gavin, a right handed bowler, said “my right arm is my dominant arm but I actually bowl 2-handed”. His main hobby is video games and his other sporting interest is badminton. Gavin said “I love playing badminton as much as I love bowling”. Yap is now averaging 167 for 18 games in the league on the “Boulevard Grill” team with team members Doug Wiles, Tom Pearson and Brad Huggett.

Youth bowler posts new high scores:

Evan Peters fired 333 (96-82-155 – 74 pins over average) to record new personal high scores. He was bowling in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl beating his previous high scores 321 and 127. Evan is averaging 81 after 7 weeks on the lanes bowling with team mates Silas Kelch and Zachary Ingles. Last season in the PYL he averaged 69 for 84 games.

Little is 100 pins over average:



Dave Little tossed 287 in his first game of the night to be 118 pins over average for a single game. He was bowling in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with a 633 triple. His game was also a personal high, topping his previous high game of 279 which he bowled in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League at Hi-Way Bowl in the 2019-2020 season. He is eligible for a 100 pins over average for a single game award. Dave’s career high triple is 692. Little is averaging 177 for 15 games this year bowling with team mates Jenny Kearns, Mary Heynsbergen and Martin Heynsbergen. Last year in the MFFL he averaged 179 for 81 games.



Ingles bowls new high single:

Zachary Ingles rolled 253 (84 pins over average) in his first game of the day to register a new personal high single. He was bowling in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl. His previous high single was 247 and his high triple is 676 (239-218-219) both bowled in the PYL last season. Zachary is averaging 169 after 7 weeks this year bowling with team mates Silas Kelch and Evan Peters. Last season he averaged 171 for 90 games in the PYL.

Hoadley enters 700 club:

Tyler Hoadley wheeled 711 (211-290 – 109 pins over average) – 210) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl, to post the 2nd high triple of the week in LCTA bowling competition. It was his first 700 of the season. Last season Hoadley had 3-700's to his credit. His 290 made him eligible for a 100 pins over average for a single game award and it was the high single of the week. Tyler is now averaging 190 for 18 games in the league bowling with team mates David Paquette and Kyle Adamson. Last season in the BWCL he averaged 188 for 93 games.

Shephard has solid week:

Mike Shephard had 2-700's this past week to tighten the 700 "King of the Lanes" race as he now trails Ben Lapointe by two. They were his 5th and 6th 700's of the season. Shephard hurled 709 (247-213-249) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 23 & 24 and 700 (231-248-221) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 17 & 18 both at Marcin Bowl, to record the 3rd high triple of the week in the LCTA and shared the low triple of the week with Shane Chipman. Mike is averaging 217 for 21 games in the BWCL this year while last season he averaged 211 for 96 games in the league. He is also averaging 229 for 18 games in the FTBMNML this year. Last year in the league he averaged 224 for 96 games.



Lapointe's lead shrinks:

Ben Lapointe fired 705 (256-215-234) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl to record the 4th high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. It was his 8th 700 of the season and he now has a career 151-700's to his credit. His lead in the "King of the Lanes" race is down to two over Mike Shephard. Lapointe is averaging 225 for 24 games in the SPBCML this season.

Chipman ties for low 700:

Shane Chipman rolled 700 (192-275 – 69 pins over average – 233) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl, to tie with Mike Shephard for the low 700 in the LCTA this past week. It was his first 700 of the season while last season Chipman had 11-700's to his credit. Shane is averaging 210 for 21 games in the MFFL this season. Last season in the league he averaged 216 for 84 games. Chipman's career high scores are 792 (300-235-257) which he bowled in the MFFL last season and 300 (4).

Sinclair is top lady Kegler:

Dara Sinclair wheeled 629 (221-182-226) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl, to record the ladies high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. Dara is averaging 184 for 21 games in the league this year. Last year she averaged 189 for 60 games in the MFFL. Her career high scores are 781 which she rolled in the JoAnne Lapish Mixed Doubles Tournament at Port Huron Lanes in 2006 with her husband Neil, and 300 (3) 2 bowled in Port Huron, Michigan and the other in Richmond, Michigan.

Sitter fires ladies high single:

Kelly Sitter fired the first nine strikes in her last game of the night, only to come up high on her first ball in the tenth frame to leave an 8 count. She converted the spare and then struck for a 278 which was good for the ladies high single of the week in LCTA bowling play. She was bowling in the Mike Guzik Realty Re/Max RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl finishing the night



with a 618 triple. Kelly's career high single is 279. Sitter is averaging 184 for 15 games in the league bowling on the "Organized Chaos" team with Chantelle Steele, Lisa Pownall and Sarah Meere. Last season in the RCAFA league she averaged 185 for 93 games.
