### Weekly Highlights

### Shephard leads the race:



Mike Shephard fired 771 (257 – 290 – 64 pins over average – 224) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl, to register the high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association( LCTA) bowling competition. It was his 13<sup>th</sup> 700 this season and he maintains his lead of two over Ben Lapointe in the season’s 700 crown race. His 290 was also good for the highest single of the week. Shephard bowls in three leagues this year but he only bowled in one league this past week. Mike is averaging 229 for 27 games in the FTBMNML this year trailing Kirk Ramsay who is leading the league in the high average department with 232 for 18 games.

### Salmons grabs second spot:

Matt Salmons hurled 753 (227-289 – 77 pins over average – 237 - 117 pins over average for three games) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) as a spare on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl to record the second high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. It was his second 700 this season as he previously recorded 719 (278-238-203) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML). His 289 was good for the second highest single of the week. Salmons is averaging 239 for 6 games in the BWCL and



225 for 9 games also as a spare in the FTBMNML. Matt's career high scores are 803 (Century Bowl Edmonton) and 300 (4).

### *Rogers tops his high triple:*



Mike Rogers rolled 542 (169-193-180) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling action to top his career high triple. His previous high triple was 531 (165- 206-160) which he registered in the SPBCML this season. Mike's career highest single is 207. Mike is averaging 155 for 24 games in the SPBCML this year. Last year in the league he averaged 149 for 84 games.

### *Beveridge posts career first 700:*

Trevor Beveridge tossed 703 (267 - 68 pins over average - 200-236 - 106 pins over average for three games ) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling play to register his career first 700 triple and the 5th high triple of the week. His previous high triple was 680 (235-200-245) which he posted in the MFFL in week four of this season and his career high single is 279. Beveridge is averaging 203 for 30 games in the MFFL this year. Last year in the league he averaged 187 for 90 games.



### *Dean records personal high scores:*

Lennox Dean fired 485 (179 - 71 pins over average - 140 - 32 pins over average - 166 - 58 pins over average - 161 pins over average for three games) in the Marcin Youth League (MYL) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl to establish his personal high scores in LCTA bowling fun this past week. Lennox is averaging 108 after 10 weeks of bowling this year. Last year in the MYL he averaged 100 for 81 games.

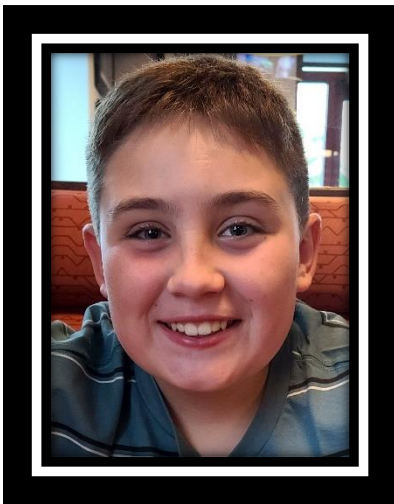


Moorey wheels new high single:

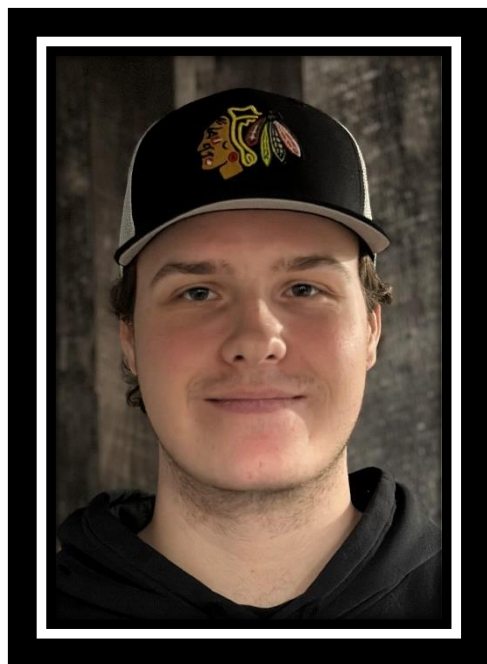
Bacon rolls new high single:

Alexis Bacon rolled 182 in her second game of the day in LCTA bowling play to record her new personal high single topping her previous 178. She was bowling in the Marcin Youth League (MYL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl finishing the day with a 474 triple. Her career high triple is 494 (154-167-173) which she recorded last week in the MYL. Alexis is averaging 143 after 10



weeks of bowling this year. Last year in the MYL she finished with a 115 average for 83 games.

### *Parkkila joins seasons 700 club:*



Kole Parkkila fired 717 (213-245-259) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling action to post his first 700 of the 2024-2025 season. Last season, Parkkila finally bowled his first 700 and ended the season with 5-700's. Kole is a right-handed bowler with a ton of rev's on his ball and is a tough competitor on the lanes. His career high scores are 737 and 300. He is averaging 212 for 27 games in the FTBMNML this year. Last year in the league he averaged 199 for 36 games.

### *Lapointe adds to his career total:*

Ben Lapointe wheeled 717 (245-237-235) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling activity to tie with his cousin Kole Parkkila for the 3<sup>rd</sup> high triple of the week. He also rolled 710 (253-207-250) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl to record the 4<sup>th</sup> highest triple of the week. They were his 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> 700's this season and gives him a career 125-700's in the LCTA. He is two behind Mike Shephard in the race for the season's 700 crown. Ben's most memorable day on the lanes was in the 2022-2023 season when he rolled his career high triple 862 (299-300-263) in the Sunday Morning Men's League at Marcin Bowl. That triple turned out to be the high triple of the year in the Canadian Tenpin Federation. Lapointe also has 7-300's to his credit.



*Slater is tops for the ladies:*



Cori Slater (Landon) tossed 659 (220 - 55 pins over average - 204 – 39 pins over average - 235 – 70 pins over average – 164 pins over average for three games) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl, to be the top lady bowler in LCTA bowling fun this past week. According to this writer’s records and the Sarnia Observer sports section write up in the 2011-2012 bowling season (see Memory Lane), Cori’s career high triple is 717 (257-247-213) posted in the old St. Joe’s Mixed League at Marcin Bowl. Her career high single is 279. Cori is averaging 171 for 27 games in the MFFL this

year. Last year in the league she averaged 170 for 93 games.

*Windover is youth’s top bowler:*
