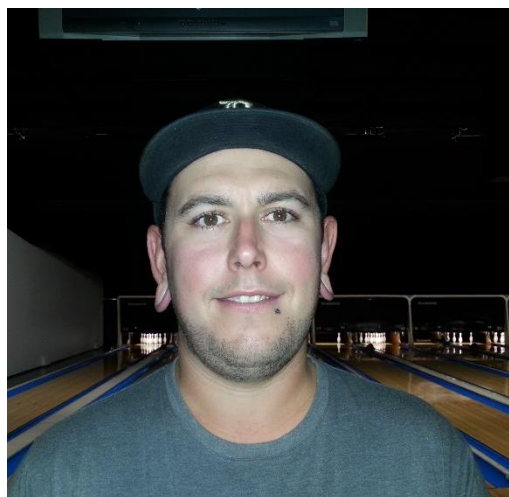
## **Pelkie is tops on the lanes:**
