## **Weekly Highlights**

### **Wilson rolls perfect game:**



Cody Wilson rolled his career first perfect game in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League at Hi-Way Bowl to record the high single of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action. It was the third 300 in the LCTA this season. He finished the night with 709 (228-300 – 86 pins over average - 181) which is also his career highest triple. His previous high triple was 700 which he bowled on March 20th in the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program (MBYBP) as a senior in the 2009-2010 bowling season. Cody started participating in the MBYBP in 1996 at the ripe old age of 4 and continued the program until 2010. Wilson was a very eager youth bowler and helped coach in the MBYBP during his last three years in the

league. He recalled that one year he won a \$300.00 scholarship in the Provincial Youth Coca Cola Tournament. In his last year of the MBYBP, he finished the season with a fine 205 average. At age 18 he had to take time off from sports due to a shoulder problem which he suffered from the various sports he was involved in at the time. He took the next ten years off from organized bowling while his rotator cuff injury was getting back to normal. Finally the itch to get back into organized bowling lead him to the RCAFA league this season. He started the night with a 214 average and raised his average to 217 after his fine performance on the lanes.



**Plumb hurls week's high triple:**

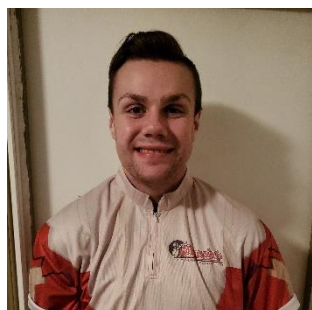
Larry Plumb hurled 732 (216-257-259) in the Sunday Morning Men's League (SMML) at Marcin Bowl to take the honours for the high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. Plumb, a strong right handed bowler who usually plays between the 5-10 boards with a ton of speed, is averaging 223 after seven weeks on the lanes in the SMML.

**Mezzatesta a close second:**

Paul Mezzatesta fired 728 (223-236-269) in the Border City Men's League (BCML) at Marcin Bowl to take second place in the week's high triple race. Paul started bowling at age 10 coming up through the defunct Echo Lanes youth bowling program. His sanctioned personal high scores are 738 and 290. Paul started bowling in the BCML seven years ago and has been carrying a consistent average. His averages in the BCML from the 2013-2014 season and following years were 199, 201, 200, 205, 203, 206 and 205. This year he is averaging 215 after 24 games.

**Marciniszyn leads the ladies:**

Pam Marciniszyn tossed 694 (245-258) in the Thursday Night Mixed League at Marcin Bowl to lead the way for the ladies in LCTA action. Pam is a strong, consistent, right handed once a week bowler with a smooth follow through delivery who has averaged between 216 and 224 the last nine years before dropping off to 204 last year. This year she is averaging 214 after 12 games.

**Bestard is tops for the youth:**

Jacob Bestard bowled 687 (236-249-202) in the Senior Division in the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program (MBYBP) to post the weeks high triple and single for the youth bowlers. He is presently averaging 207 after seven weeks of action in this COVID – 19 bowling season. Last year he finished the season with a 199



average for 78 games. His career high scores are 700 and 279. He is following the footsteps of his grandfather (Dan) and his father (Drew) who went all the way through the MBYBP to become strong competitive bowlers until injuries knocked them off the lanes. His father has since returned to bowl in the Border City Men's League this year. Drew said he is having a tough time keeping up to Jacob on the lanes.

### **Mandeville fires personal high scores:**



Kris Mandeville fired 684 (278) last week in the Thursday Night Men's League (TNML) at Marcin Bowl to record his career personal highest scores. This writer was unaware of his achievement last week and only gave him an Honourable mention in last week's bowling report. Mandeville is a new bowler in the LCTA starting last year in the TNML finishing the year with a 164 average for 75 games. This year he is bowling in the Border City Men's League and is averaging 171 after 24 games but also spares in the TNML when required.
