## Weekly Highlights

### Black rolls 300:



Doug Black rolled a perfect game in his first game of the day in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition this past week. He was bowling in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl finishing the day with a 694 (300 - 95 pins over average – 192-202) triple. It was his career 3<sup>rd</sup> 300 and the 10<sup>th</sup> 300 in the LCTA this season. His career high triple is 774. Black is averaging 206 for 87 games in the BWCL this year bowling with team members Shawn Cotterill and Jeff Raymond. Last year in the BWCL he averaged 196 for 93 games.

### Mandeville is four pins shy of perfection:

Kris Mandeville rolled the first eleven strikes with solid pocket hits in his third game of the night. With his adrenalin peaking and his body emotions in high gear, he pulled his last shot to the left of the head pin leaving the 1-3-6-10 ending with a 296. He was bowling in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl ending the night with 686 (296- 116 pins over average - 234). His scores were good for new personal high numbers beating his previous 684 and 278. Kris is also



eligible for a Canadian Tenpin Federation watch for being 100 pins over average for a single game if he has not received this award before. Mandeville is averaging 182 for 74 games in the SPBCML this year. Last year in the league he averaged 170 for 78 games.

**Moorey tops his high triple:**



Danny Moorey fired 676 (242- 91 pins over average – 210 – 59 pins over average – 224 – 73 pins over average - 223 pins over average for three games) in the Mulder Financial Fun League on lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl to top his previous high triple of 646. He was also high over average for three games this week. His sanctioned high single game is 245. This is the first year that Moorey is bowling in organized league bowling and he is averaging 154 for 75 games.

**Webb posts new high triple:**



Ryan Webb wheeled 649 (217-246 – 80 pins over average – 186 – 151 pins over average for three games) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling activity to post a career new high triple. His previous high triple was 639 and his high single is 276. Webb is averaging 168 for 78 games in the MFFL this year. Last year in the MFFL he averaged 167 for 87 games and 179 for 81 games in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League. He is also bowling in the Sarnia Produce Border City

Men’s League this year averaging 170 for 76 games this year.

**Gark gets late highlight:**

Chase Gark tossed his career high triple two weeks ago and is getting a late highlight in this week’s bowling report. Gark posted 593 (184-243-166) in the Target Trios Mixed League (TTML) on lanes 7 & 8 at Hi-Way Bowl in LCTA bowling action. Gark said he started bowling at a very young age around 4 or 5 he thought, with his Bugs Bunny balling ball at Hi-Way Bowl. He



bowled one season in the Marcin Bowl Youth League but after that he bowled off and on as a kid. He said he eventually got real interested in bowling from getting out on the lanes with his family especially his dad Jeff and Aunt (Anna Androski). They helped him to improve his bowling skills which made the game more interesting. Chase is a right handed bowler with a personal 289 high single game. He is averaging 166 after 29 weeks of bowling in the TTML this year. Gark's other sport interest is basketball. He played competitive basketball for many years leading up to a major head injury at the end of high school. After his injury he stayed away from contact sports. Chase's hobbies include hunting, fishing, long range precision shooting, camping and video games.

### **Scott tops her high triple:**



McKenna Scott fired 588 (173-179-236 – 73 pins over average) to walk off the lanes with a new personal high triple in LCTA bowling activity this past week. She was bowling in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl topping her previous high triple 574 (268-157-149) which she bowled last week. Her career high single game is 268. McKenna is averaging 163 after 29 weeks in the PYL this year. McKenna returned to bowling this year after she took two years off from the lanes thanks to Covid. Her average for the 2020-2021 bowling season

was 160 for 48 games.

### **Pinel 100 pins over average:**



Adam Pinel fired 729 (214 – 289 – 104 pins over average – 226 – 174 pins over average for three games) in the Bar10 Thursday Night Mixed League (B10TNML) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl to record the 5th high triple of the week in LCTA bowling play. It was his first 700 in the LCTA this season. His 104 pins over average in his second game makes him eligible for a Canadian Tenpin Federation watch if he has not already received this award. Pinel is now averaging 187 after 31 weeks of bowling in the B10TNML. Last year in the league he averaged 195 for 96 games. His career

sanctioned high scores are 769 and 299.





**Lapointe leads the way:**

Jason Lapointe fired 778 (254-299 – stubborn 10 pin - 84 pins over average -- 225 – 133 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl to take the honours for the high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. It was his 10<sup>th</sup> 700 in the LCTA this season. He also took second place in the high single department one pin behind Doug Black’s 300. Jason’s career high scores are 792 and 300 (3). He is averaging 217 for 66 games in the FTBMNML, 214 for 78 games in the Best Wiring Classic League and 213 after 31 weeks in the Bar10 Thursday Night Mixed League.

**Murphy is second best:**

Chris Murphy wheeled 753 (235-228-290 – 94 pins over average – 165 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl to take ownership of the second high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. He also tossed 727 (237-237-253) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men’s League (SPBCML) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl to record the 6th high triple of the week. It was his 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> 700 in the LCTA this season as he previously rolled 721 (261-203-257). Murphy’s career high scores are 790 and 299. Murphy started bowling at age 12 in the Hi-Way Bowl youth bowling program and has been bowling for 26 years. Chris loves single sport competition and bowling was right up his lane. Chris said “I like all sports, both playing and betting, anything competitive and I am a sports capper”. Chris has bowled in all local tournaments over the years and attends the Ontario Tenpin Bowling Association year end closing tournament every year. He is a right handed bowler who doesn’t use his thumb in his ball delivery and is bowling in four leagues this year. The leagues with his averages and games in brackets are as the following: FTBMNML 199 (76), Best Wiring Classic League 193 (84), Mulder Financial Fun League 197 (66) and SPBCML 202 (87).



**The “Mezz” slides into third spot:**

Roy Mezzatesta fired 749 (266-246-237) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl to post the third high triple in LCTA bowling action this past week. It was his 11<sup>th</sup> 700 in the LCTA this season. Mezzatesta’s career high scores are 859 (279-290-290) which he posted on October 13, 2019 at Hi-Way Bowl and 300 (9). He also has 8-299’s (7 in the Canadian Tenpin Federation-CTF), 5-298’s (4 in the CTF) and 2-297’s (1 in the CTF). Roy is averaging 218 for 90 games in the BWCL this year. Last year in the BWCL he averaged 207 for 93 games. He also bowls in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League averaging 205 for 84 games and the Sarnia Produce Border City Men’s League averaging 216 for 93 games.

**Lapointe Junior having phenomenal year:**

Ben Lapointe tossed 747 (245-279 - 62 pins over average - 223) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl to record the fourth high triple in LCTA bowling play this past week. Lapointe is having a phenomenal year in the LCTA as it was his 34<sup>th</sup> 700 together with 3-800’s and 3-300’s. He has a career 113-700’s. Lapointe is bowling full time or sparing in five leagues this year. His career high scores are or 862 and 300 (7).

**Parkkila good for seventh position:**

Kole Parkkila fired 722 (267 – 75 pins over average – 243 – 212) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl to register the seventh high triple of the week in LCTA bowling competition. It was his career 4<sup>th</sup> 700 in the LCTA this season as he previously rolled 720 (236-259-225), 701 (199-257-245) and 737 (233-259-245). Kole is sparing in the FTBMNML this year averaging 197 for 30 games. He also spares in the Best Wiring Classic League and is averaging 190 for 57 games

Jim Lapointe hurled 716 (275 – 59 pins over average – 213-228) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl to post the ninth high triple of the week in LCTA bowling ado. Lapointe is having a super year as it was his 16<sup>th</sup> 700 in the LCTA this season. He also has 812 (279-298-235) and 2-300's to his credit this year. **Chopp slides into bottom position:**

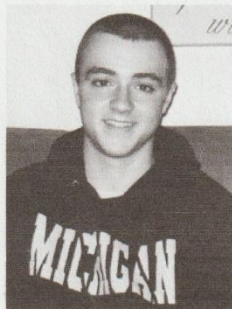
