Shephard takes first place:



Mike Shephard hurled 771 (256-267-248 – 144 pins over average for three games) on lanes 25 & 26 in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League at Marcin Bowl to record the high triple in this week's Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action. As a youth bowler, Mike came up through the SOCMO (Sombra, Courtright and Mooretown) youth bowling program at the defunct Airey Lanes in Courtright. Mike is a strong right handed bowler who has averaged between 219 and 225 the last 8 years before dropping down to 210 and 213 in two leagues last year. He has a career 9-300's to his credit and has enjoyed the excitement of rolling 5-800's (827-804-805-802-

814), a triple that is very difficult to accomplish.

Willemsen is second with high over average scores:

Louie Willemsen tossed 768 (266-287-102 pins over average – 213 pins over average for three games) on lanes 29 & 30 in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League to take the second high triple of the week by posting high over average scores. Louie did not come up through a youth bowling program, starting bowling at age 21 and has been knocking down the pins for 43 years. He has 2-300's under his belt the first one coming in 1989 in the Hi-Way Bowl Sunday Morning Men's Classic League which was sponsored by Titen Real Estate. He

has 1-800 (811) which he accomplished in 2011 in the Sunday Morning Men's League at Marcin Bowl. Louie has served on bowling associations for 23 years including the old Sarnia And District Tenpin Bowling Association (which was replaced by the LCTA) and the Ontario Tenpin Bowling Association. He also helped to promote the great sport of bowling by coaching in the youth bowling program at Hi-Way Bowl for 15 years.

Vandermeer slides into third place:

Dan Vandermeer wheeled 747 (223-255-269) on lanes 19 & 20 in the Border City Men's League (BCML) at Marcin Bowl to register the third high triple of the week. Dan returned to bowling in the 2012-2013 bowling season in the BCML and has had the following averages over the last seven years: 194 – 196 – 200 – 192 - 191 – 200 – 191. The right handed bowler is off to a great start this year averaging 219 after 15 games and is leading the

race for the high average in the BCML. He is being chased by Roy Mezzatesta 217, Rob Vandermeer 217 and Dan Chopp 215. His career personal high scores are 289 and 777.

Olsen is fourth with solid triple:

Tony Olsen rolled 739 (241-257-241 – 163 pins over average for three games) on lanes 29 & 30 in the Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League at Marcin Bowl to record the week’s fourth high triple and the second high over average for three games. Tony started bowling 5-Pin when he was 11 years old. When he was 12, his dad started taking him along to Viking Lanes in Port Huron and that is when Tony got hooked on 10-Pin bowling. He didn’t come up through a youth bowling program but in high school he had Dick Leneve as a teacher who had an open bowling league after school at Echo Lanes which Tony participated in to polish up his game. Besides having a few injuries along the way, Tony has been

knocking pins down for 48 years. He has bowled in the defunct American Bowling Congress tournaments over the years including the ones held in Memphis, Reno, Baltimore, Baton Rouge and Texas. Asked about his bowling highlights he replied “my bowling highlights are all my friends I have met through bowling: it has been my social life for a lot of years”. His personal high scores are 300 and 759.

Legault is tops for the ladies:

Karyne Legault rolled 662 (279 – 76 pins over average) in the Tuesday Night Ladies League at Marcin Bowl to record the ladies high triple of the week. Karyne started 10 pin bowling at the age of four coming up through Hi-Way Bowl and Marcin Bowl youth bowling programs and the YBC (Youth Bowling Canada) program at Northgate Bowl. At age 22, she took four seasons off from bowling when she brought her son into the world and further increased her education at college returning back to the lanes in 2016- 2017 season. Her averages for the last three

years were 197 – 198 – 205 and this year after 18 games she is averaging 206. Her career personal high scores are 300 and 797.

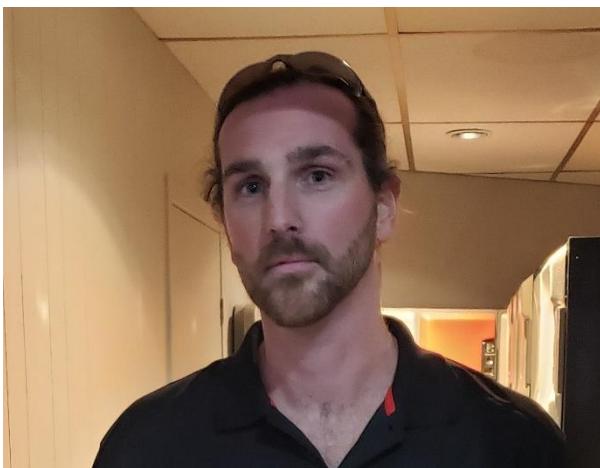
Youth bowler posts personal best scores:



Terrell Walker- Gray fired 630 (214-256 – 81 pins over average – 103 pins over average for three years in the Youth Junior Division at Marcin Bowl to post the youth high triple of the week and his career personal best scores. Terrell started bowling at age 8 and has been enjoying the Saturday morning friendship at the lanes for 5 years. Two of his memorable moments in bowling are: getting seven strikes in a row and placing third (bronze medal) last

year in the Bantam Division in the Ivan Nelson CTF (Canadian Tenpin Federation) Youth Tournament which was held at Classic Bowl in Mississauga. The SCRATCH tournament gave the youth bowlers a chance to try secure a spot on Team Ontario. In the 2015-2016 season he finished with a 77 average in his first year of bowling. In the 2018-2019 season he finished with a 156 average. This year he is carrying a 182 average after 15 games. Besides bowling, Terrell's other interests include baseball, football, basketball and soccer. CONGRATULATIONS Terrell on the SUPER bowling.

White rolls top single:
