Weekly Highlights

Watson walks off the lane with 300:



Bryce Watson takes the honours for registering the first perfect game in the Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) 2023-2024 bowling season. Watson performed the feat in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl in his third game of the day finishing with a 667 triple. It was Watson's career sanctioned 2nd perfect game as he bowled his first one last season on February 10,

2023 on lanes 31 & 32 in the Friday Night Fun Mixed League at Marcin Bowl. The 20 year old youngster was also 111 pins over average for his game going into the days bowling with a 189 average. He is now averaging 194 for 21 games in the league. His career high series is 698. In closing Watson had some comments about his achievement. "It was such another great feeling to bowl another 300 game. I was just as nervous as my first one. I used the "Storm Fate" for this 300 and most of the strikes were solid but I did get some lucky



breaks in the last couple frames". The LCTA congratulates Bryce for his achievement and this writer anticipates there are probably a few more perfect games hiding in the "Storm Fate" ball for this fine young bowler.

Two more bowlers 100 pins over average:

Two more bowlers qualified for the 100 pins over average award for a single game this week.

Butch Wilson tossed 287 in his last game of the night to be 133 pins over average for a single game. He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl ending the night with a 643 triple. He was 181 pins over average for three games which was tops in the LCTA this week. Wilson is averaging 166 for 15 games in the league this year. His career sanctioned high scores are 762 and 300 (3).



Justin Armstrong wheeled 245 in his second game of the night to be 100 pins over average for a single game. He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with a 613 (166-245-204) triple. He was 180 pins over average for three games which was second best in that department this week. This writer believes that this is his highest triple and his highest single game is 268. Armstrong is now averaging 157 for 15 games in the league this year.



Lapointe rolls top triple:

Ben Lapointe rolled 727 (252-276 -72 pins over average – 199) on lanes 33 & 34 in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) at Marcin Bowl to record the top triple in LCTA bowling competition this past week. It was his career 87th - 700 plus triple in the LCTA. He is averaging 211 for 18 games in the FTBMNML this year. Lapointe’s career sanctioned high scores are 862 (299-300-263) and 300 (4).

Salmons good for second place:

Matt Salmons hurled 713 (225-221-267- 65 pins over average) on lanes 27 & 28 in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League at Marcin Bowl to hold down second place in the high triple department this week in LCTA bowling action. It was his 2nd 700 in the league this season as he previously posted a 748 (258-224-266). Salmons is averaging 208 for 18 games in the league this year. His career sanctioned high scores are 803 and 300 (4).

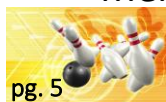

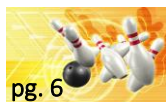

LCTA Featured Bowler of the Week:



The LCTA featured bowler of the week is Scott David. Scott started enjoying the great sport of 10 pin bowling in organized leagues in his late 50's and currently is in his eighth year of bonding with friends on the lanes. He would have been in his tenth year, however thanks to the nasty Covid virus, he like many other people took off two years from bowling. He got interested in bowling through their adult children as well as his wife who came up through the Sarnia Minor Athletic Association 5 pin youth organization

and is a long time 10 pin bowler. David has bowled at Marcin Bowl in the Thursday Night Mixed League (TNML) for 6 years and 2 years in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League. This writer checked the LCTA average year books and his averages starting from the 2013-2014 season and cascading upwards (minus the two years he was away from bowling) were 141-157-167-171-170-163-158. This year he is averaging 162 after 24 games in the TNML. The right handed bowler's sanctioned career high scores are 638 and 247. Scott said "bowling, like golf, is fun, challenging and difficult to master. However, it is a great recreational pastime and everyone is encouraged to participate regardless of age or ability". His other sporting interests (and he plays them) are hockey, slo-pitch baseball, two pitch baseball and golf. He said "I like to get a liberal dose of golf spring through fall". His hobbies are fishing and reading novels. In closing David said "one thing I've learned over the years of playing other sports is that you meet a lot of great people and bowling is no exception".
