Weekly Highlights

Friis leads the pack:



Kerry Friis tossed 737 (262 – 53 pins over average ,187 , 288 – 79 pins over average) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl, to register the high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition. It was his 3rd 700 of the season as he previously bowled 712 (236-233-243) and 707 (256-215-236). Kerry's 288 was also good for the high single of the week in the LCTA. Friis is averaging 211 for 60 games in the BWCL this season.

Langille enters 700 club:



Ron Langille wheeled 704 (199-245 – 71 pins over average – 260 – 86 pins over average – 182 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl, to record his first 700 of the season in the LCTA. Langille had no 700's the last three seasons after being off the lanes for a couple years. Ron started bowling 10 pin in his late teens with friends for a night of fun and then joined a sanctioned league in his early twenties. Langille, a right-handed bowler, did not know his high triple but remembered his high single of 298 recorded in the 1999-2000 season. He said he learned a lot from 10 pin bowlers Jim Bourgeois and Jack Smith over the years to improve his game. Ron said he played baseball, hockey and golf in his younger years and continues to play golf for a summer activity. He enjoys watching hockey, football and baseball especially the Wings, Lions and Tigers.



Langille is averaging 177 for 57 games this season bowling on the “Marcin Maulers” team. Last season in the league he averaged 178 for 90 games.

Yap ups his high scores:



Gavin Yap fired 643 (176-256 – 78 pins over average – 211) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl, to register career new high scores in LCTA bowling action this past week. His previous high scores were 611 (187-191-233) and 242 both bowled in the FTBMNML this season. Gavin is averaging 180 for 57 games bowling on the “Boulevard Grill” team in his first year of sanctioned

league bowling.

Bacon registers new high triple:



Alexis Bacon wheeled 500 (182 – 54 pins over average – 155-163) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl, to register a new career high triple. Her previous high triple was 494 (154-167-173) which she bowled in the PYL last season. She also tied her high single with her 182. Alexis is averaging 128 after 20 weeks of bowling this season. Last season in the PYL she averaged 131 for 59 games.

Nesbitt bowls new high scores:

Brynn Nesbitt tossed 423 (161 – 43 pins over average – 122-140) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl, to register new personal high scores in the LCTA. Her previous high triple was 393 (124-156-113) and her old high single was 156 both bowled last week in the PYL. Brynn is averaging 118 after 20 weeks of bowling this season. Last season she averaged 100 for 87 games.

Paquette posts higher single:

Nick Paquette rolled 252 (90 pins over average) in his first game of the night to record a new personal high single topping his previous 215. He was bowling in the Klean and Brite Thursday Night Mixed League on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl, finishing the night with a 563 triple. Nick is averaging 162 after 20 weeks on the lanes this year in his first year of sanctioned league bowling..



Wicks rolls new high single:

Jeff Wicks tossed 242 (71 pins over average) in his last game of the night to register a new personal high single topping his previous 236. He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl, finishing the night with a 611 triple. Jeff's career high triple is 690 (236-235-219) which he bowled in the FTBMNML this season. Wicks is averaging 173 for 57 games in the FTBMNML this season.

Capes is high over average:

Eric Capes rolled 225 (97 pins over average) in his first game of the night to be the high over average for a single game this week in the LCTA. He was bowling in the Target Trios Mixed League (TTML) on lanes 7 & 8 at Hi-Way Bowl, finishing the night with a 504 triple. Capes career high scores are 510 (164-93- 253) and 253 recorded in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) at Marcin Bowl this season. Eric, a two-handed bowler participating in an organized adult league for the first time, is averaging 131 for 54 games in the MFFL and 128 after 21 weeks in the TTML this season.

Murphy adds to his total:

Chris Murphy wheeled 731 (279 – 69 pins over average – 239-213) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 27 & 28 and 705 (235-246-224) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 29 & 30 both at Marcin Bowl, to record the 2nd and 7th high triples of the week in LCTA bowling competition. They were his 10th and 11th 700's of the season, as he previously bowled 760, 733, 760, 705, 709, 762, 775, 705 and 781. Chris is averaging 213 for 33 games as a spare in the FTBMNML and 202 for 39 games also as a spare in the MFFL this season.



Lapointe notches two more:

Ben Lapointe fired 720 (222-276 – 56 pins over th high– 222) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men’s League (SPBCML) on lanes 29 & 30 and 709 (258-204-247) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 13 & 14 both at Marcin Bowl, to post the 3rd high triple of the week and share the 5th high triple of the week with Mike Shephard in the LCTA .They were his 18th and 19th 700’s of the season and his career total goes to 160. Lapointe is averaging 221 for 63 games in the BWCL and 222 for 57 games in the SPBCML this season.

**Lapointe hangs on to fourth place:**

Jason Lapointe wheeled 718 (246-237-235) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl, to record the 4th high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. It was his 2nd 700 of the season as he previously bowled 702 (223-246-233). Lapointe is averaging 210 for 63 games in the BWCL this season. Jason also spares in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League and is averaging 214 for 21 games.

**Shephard good for fifth spot:**

Mike Shephard hurled 709 (225-233-251) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl, to tie for the 5th high triple of the week with Ben Lapointe in the LCTA. It was his 15th 700 of the season and he continues to trail Ben Lapointe by 4 in the seasons King of the Lanes race. Shephard is averaging 220 for 63 games in the BWCL this season.



Watson takes sixth position:

Bryce Watson tossed 706 (246-224-236) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl, to post the 6th high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. It was his 5th 700 of the season as he previously bowled 740, 703, 748 and 779 and his career 20th 700. Bryce is participating in four leagues this season. His averages with the number of games in brackets are the following: MFFL 205 (60), Best Wiring Classic League 207 (66), Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League 211 (51) and Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League 204 (15).

**Lewicki records number seven:**

Steve Lewicki fired 703 (237-229-237) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl, to record the 9th high triple of the week in LCTA bowling competition. It was his 7th 700 of the season as he previously bowled 744, 733, 714, 721, 704 and 743, Steve is averaging 217 for 60 games in the BWCL this season. Last season in the league he averaged 213 for 60 games.

**Gauthier is in the basement:**

Brandon Gauthier hurled 700 (211-232-257) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl, to register the low 700 of the week in the LCTA. It was his 5th 700 of the season as he previously bowled 726, 701, 771 (289-257-225) and 731. Gauthier is now averaging 214 for 54 games in the league bowling on the "AST Group" team.



Crowe leads the ladies:

Melissa Crowe rolled 615 (215-201-199) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) at Marcin Bowl, to take the honours in the ladies high triple department this past week in the LCTA. It was her 5th 600 of the season as she previously bowled 607, 626, 669 and 632. Melissa is averaging 195 for 21 games as a spare in the BWCL this season. She also participates full time in the Target Trios Mixed League at Hi-Way Bowl, where it is string pin bowling. This past week she bowled 597 (169-214-214) in the league and is now averaging 180 for 57 games.

Sinclair is second best:

Dara Sinclair tossed 606 (194-185-227) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl, to record the ladies second high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was her 7th 600 of the season as she previously bowled 640, 616, 629, 627, 605 and 622. She also bowled 599 (168-223-208) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl this past week. Dara is averaging 182 for 57 games in the BWCL this season and 182 for 57 games in the MFFL. Dara started bowling 10-pin at age 5 coming up through the SoCoMo (Sombra, Courtright, Mooretown) Youth League at the defunct Airey Lanes under the watchful eyes of Bud Sparling, Jackie McLellan (her mother) and Inez LaForge. She bowled in the youth league until age 16, then she joined an adult league. She has been enjoying the friendship on the lanes for 46 years (11 years as a youth and 35 years as an adult). How did Dara get into bowling? The answer is simple. Dara's mother, Jackie, took her to the lanes from the time she was a baby. Since both of her parents bowled, it was natural for her and her brother to get hooked on bowling. Dara's career high scores are 781 and 300 (3), 2 bowled in Port Huron, Michigan and the other in Richmond, Michigan.

***Shephard posts ladies top single:***

Roni Shepard wheeled 268 (89 pins over average) in her last game of the day to take the honours for the ladies high single of the week in LCTA action this past week. She was bowling in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl, finishing the day with a 591 triple. Roni is averaging 180 for 60 games in the BWCL this season. Last season in the league she averaged 185 for



96 games. Her career high triple is 682 (256-204-222) which she bowled in the BWCL this season and her high single is 279 which she posted in the BWCL last season.

Apter is second:

Makayla Apter bowled 243 (73 pins over average) in her last game of the night to register the ladies second high single of the week in the LCTA. She was participating in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl, finishing the night with a 557 triple. Makayla is averaging 171 for 48 games in the MFFL this season. Last season in the league she averaged 180 for 87 games. Makayla started bowling at age 8 in the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program and participated in the program until age 13. Eleven years later, Makayla returned to the lanes in the MFFL to enjoy the friendship of fellow bowlers. Makayla's career high triple is 705 (241-231-233) which she rolled in the MFFL in the 2023-2024 season and her high single is 267 bowled in the Friday Night Fun Mixed League in the 2022-2023 season.



Ingles is tops for the youth:

Zachary Ingles fired 607 (187-204-216 – 43 pins over average) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl, to post the youth high triple of the week in LCTA bowling play. It was his 2nd 600 this season as he previously bowled 605 (171-191-243). Zachary's career high triple is 676 (239-218-219) and his high single is 253 both bowled in the PYL last season. Zachary is averaging 173 after 20 weeks of bowling this season. Last season he averaged 171 for 90 games. Zachary started bowling at age five in the 2013 – 2014 season in the Hi-Way Bowl Phantom Youth Bowling Program in the Bumpers Division (BD). He was in the BD for part of the season then quickly moved up to the Bantam Division the same year finishing the year with a 50 average for 75 games.



Legault takes second place:

Noah Legault tossed 600 (244 – 65 pins over average – 178-178) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl, to register the youth's second high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. It was his 3rd 600 of the season as he previously bowled 604 (171-246-187) and 635 (200-211-224) which is his career highest triple. His high single is 246. Noah is



averaging 179 after 20 weeks of bowling this year. Last year in the league he averaged 170 for 75 games. Noah started bowling in the Hi-Way Bowl Youth Phantom Bowling Program in the 2018-2019 season at age 5 and he has been knocking down the pins for 8 years now. His final average that year was 83 for 44 games.

A ton of strikes:

Three bowlers on a four man team recorded a super first game last week in the LCTA. Last week's highlight insert was the TV screen of their actual games showing the 31 out of a possible 36 strikes that they recorded. Glen Crowe (269), Bryce Watson (290), Mike Shephard (279) fired 838 scratch for an average of 279 per bowler.
