Skinner one pin shy of perfection:



Lefty Kyle Skinner fired eleven strikes in a row in his third game on lanes 31 & 32 only to be stopped by an unyielding 3 pin stopping him at 299 (132 pins over average) and one pin shy of his first perfect game in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) action this past week. He was bowling in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League at Marcin Bowl ending the night with a 685 triple – 184 pins over average for three games. This year Kyle has been forced to bowl the two handed delivery rather than the single arm swing due to an injury. He is carrying a 179 average after 72 games in the league. Kyle and his brother Ryan are competitive rivals on the lanes with Ryan beating his

brother for his first perfect which he recorded this season on November 8, 2018. However Kyle is one up on Ryan in the 800 department as he achieved every competitive bowler's dream when he tossed his first 800 series (807) on January 4, 2015.

Plain and Croskery share high triple:

Wilson Plain rolled 738 (256-226-256 – 174 pins over average for three games) in the Sunday Morning Men's League at Marcin Bowl to share the week's high triple and post the second high over average for three games in LCTA bowling action this past week.
