Weekly Highlights

Shephard leads the race for the crown:

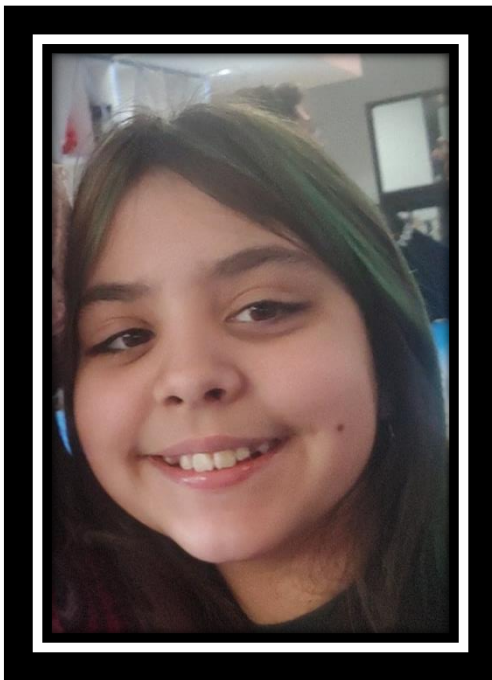
Mike Shephard fired 779 (252-269-258 – 125 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl to record the high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition. He also hurled 740 (202-279 – 48 pins over average – 259) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl to register the 5th highest triple of the week. It was his 9th & 10th 700 of the season and stays ahead of Ben Lapointe in the race for the season’s 700 crown. Shephard’s career high triple is 827 and he has 7-800’s to his credit having posted one of them (804-268-258-278) this season in September. Mike is having a super year on



the lanes averaging 224 for 21 games in the FTBMNML and 233 for 24 game in the BWCL. Last year in the FTBMNML he averaged 214 for 96 games and 203 for 90 games in the BWCL. It’s looking more and more like a two-way race between Shephard and Lapointe Junior for the LCTA high average and the 700 crown but the season is still very young.



Beveridge bowls career high scores:



Lily Beveridge wheeled 513 (158-179 – 56 pins over average - 176 – 53 pins over average – 144 pins over average for three games) in the Marcin Youth League on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl to register her career high scores. Lily is averaging 123 after 8 weeks this year. Last year in the league she averaged 101 for 87 games.

Steadman rolls career high scores:

highest scores in LCTA bowling fun. His previous high scores were 434 and 170. Brayden is averaging 140 after 8 weeks this year. Last year in the MYL he averaged 141 for 63 games.

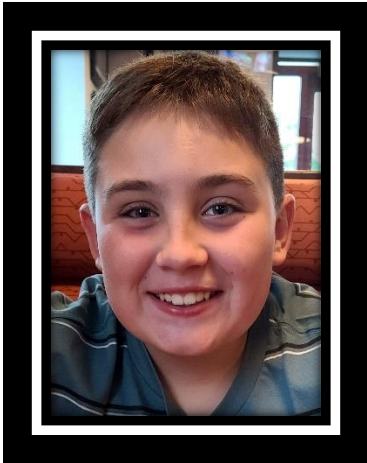
Laframboise is 100 pins over average:

He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with a 619 triple. He also established a career new personal high single beating his previous 259. This is William’s first year bowling in the FTBMNML and he is now averaging 175 for 15 games.



Legault posts new high triple:



Noah Legault fired 555 (190-170-195) in the Marcin Youth League on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling action this past week to post his career high triple. His previous high triple was 547 and his highest single is 212. Noah is averaging 164 for 24 games on the lanes this season. Last year he averaged 149 for 87 games. Noah started bowling in the Hi-Way Bowl Youth Phantom Bowling Program at age 5 and he has been knocking down the pins for 6 years now.

Hannah registers new high single:

Logan Hannah tossed 269 (94 pins over average) in LCTA bowling action this past week to record a new personal high single beating his previous high game of 258. He was bowling in the Marcin Youth League on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl in his first game of the day. Logan is averaging 175 after 8 weeks in the league this year. Last year in the league he averaged 163 for 72 games. His career high triple is 639.

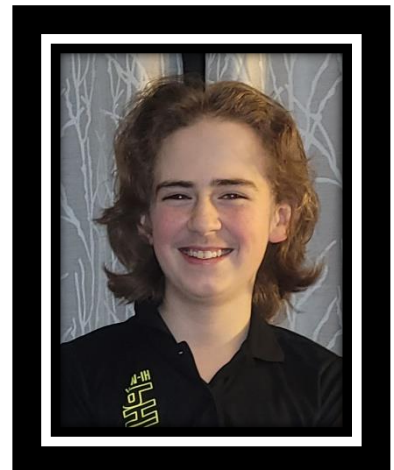


Nickles tops his high single:

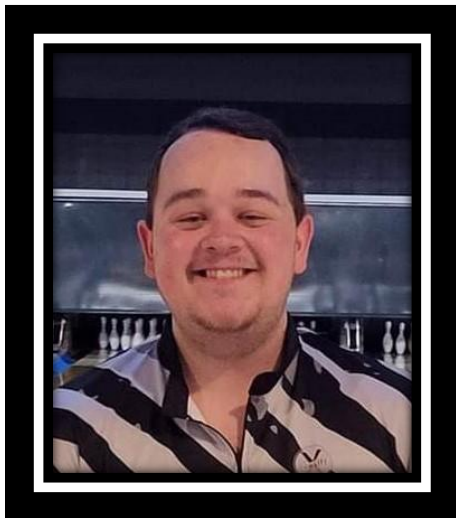
triple is 407. Collin is averaging 126 after 8 weeks this year. Last year in the league he averaged 117 for 45 games.

Larry Plumb hurled 773 (259 – 58 pins over average – 236-278 – 77 pins over average – 170 pins over average for three games) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl to end a long slump by posting the second high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. Plumb has been a strong bowler over the years but struggled to get over the 700-bar last season when he only had 1-700. In the 2022-2023 season Larry had 10-700's. So, after a long drought, he recorded his first 700 of this season. Larry's career high triple is 815 and he has 6-800's to his credit. Plumb is averaging 201 for 21 games in the BWCL this year. Last year he averaged 215 for 96 games in the league.

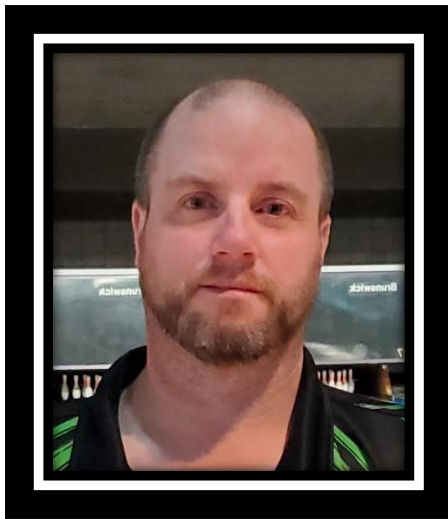
Lapointe bumped to third spot:



Ben Lapointe fired 771 (256-289 – 56 pins over average – 226) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl to record the third high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. He also rolled 719 (214-266-239) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl to record the 8th high triple of the week. They were his 8th and 9th 700's this year and he now has a career 123-700's. He is one 700 behind Mike Shephard this season in the race for the 700 crown. Lapointe is having a super year so far in the BWCL averaging 236 for 24 games and 221 for 21 games in the FTBMNML. Last season in the BWCL he averaged 222 for 69 games and 218 for 93 games in the FTBMNML.



Armstrong has solid day:



John Armstrong tossed 744 (267 - 62 pins over average – 279 – 74 pins over average – 198 – 129 pins over average for three games) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl to post the 4th high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. It was his third 700 this season as he previously rolled 752 (269-257-226) and 753 (280-216-257). Armstrong is averaging 210 for 24 games in the BWCL this year. Last season he averaged 208 for 90 games in the league.

Salmons edged to sixth position:

Alex Salmons wheeled 739 (256-193-290 – 82 pins over average) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl to register the 6th high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. His 290 was also good for the highest single of the week. It was his second 700 of the season as he previously bowled 701 (268-218-215). Alex is averaging 214 for 18 games in the BWCL this year. Last year he averaged 212 for 75 games in the league.



Murphy joins 700 club:



Chris Murphy hurled 725 (235-245-245) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men’s League (SPBCML) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl to record his first 700 of this season and the 7th high triple of the week in LCTA bowling competition. Murphy tossed 3-700’s last season in the LCTA. His career high triple is 790. Chris is averaging 202 for 21 games in the SPBCML this year. Last year in the SPBCML he averaged 202 for 87 games.



Lewicki enters 700 club:



Left-handed kegger Steve Lewicki fired 719 (267 – 51 pins over average – 236-216) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl to record his first 700 of the season in LCTA bowling play and the 8th high triple of the week. In the 2022-2023 season, Lewicki had 7-700's and last season he also had 7-700's. Steve is averaging 219 for 12 games in the BWCL this season as a spare. Last year in the league he averaged 213 for 96 games as a full-time participant.

Gark notches number two:

Lefty Jeff Gark tossed 715 (197-230-288 – 92 pins over average) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling action this past week to record his second 700 of the year and the 9th high triple of the week. Lyon sneaks into 700 club:



Kevin Lyon bowled 703 (245-213-245) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men’s League (SPBCML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl to enter the LCTA 700 club this year and record the lowest 700 of the week. In the 2022-2023 season he had 2-700’s. Last year, he was blanked in the 700 club. Lyon’s career high triple is 797. He is averaging 212 for 24 games in the SPBCML this year. Last year he averaged 194 for 96 games in the league.

Sitter is high for the women:

Kelly Sitter rolled 629 (193-212-224) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling fun to post the women’s high triple of the week. Braeden’s career high scores are 659 and 287. He is averaging 191 after 8 weeks this year. Last year in the MYL he averaged 181 for 87 games.



Lewicki's single is tops for the ladies:



Sharon Lewicki wheeled 230 (67 pins over average) in her second game of the day to post the ladies' high single of the week in LCTA bowling fun. She was bowling in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) as a spare on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl. Sharon's career high single is 235 which tossed five weeks ago in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL). Her career high triple is 579. Sharon is averaging 165 for 12 games in the BWCL and 166 for 24 games as a full-time bowler in the MFFL.

Jack Erb Seniors Tournament:

The Jack Erb Memorial Handicap Ontario Seniors Tournament (JEMHOST) was held at Burlington Bowl on the weekend of October 26 & 27 with 143 participants taking part in the competition in 6 different men's and women's divisions depending on age. The tournament is held on the fourth weekend of October every year with bowlers from the Ontario Tenpin Bowling Associations taking part in the action on the lanes. The divisions are Super Senior (75+), "A" Division (70-74), "B" Division (65-69), "C" Division (60-64), "D" Division (55-59) and "E" Division (50-54). Winners of each division can represent Ontario in the United States Bowling Congress (USBC) championships in August of the following year. Some of the USBC championships have been held in Las Vegas and Reno, Nevada, Cincinnati, Ohio and Fort Worth, Texas. LCTA bowlers who won their divisions in the JEMHOST in the past have been Jackie McLellan (Jackie won in Las Vegas), Jill Friis, Bill Cole, Zyg Mazgaj, Roy Elliott, George Rogers and Al Scott.

Congratulations goes to NEIL SINCLAIR who bowled in the Super Senior Division and is in first place with unofficial results at the moment but highly unlikely to change. Neil had scratch series of 660 (258-168-234) and 638 (243-170-225) for 1298 and 264 pins handicap gives him a total of 1562.

Roy Mezzatesta also had a good tournament bowling in the 65-69 division. He tossed scratch series of 648 (187-244-217) and 638 (207-233-198) for 1286 but with only 132 pins handicap he ended up in 9th place with a total score of 1418.
