Weekly Highlights

Lapointe senior is perfect:



Jim Lapointe hurled eleven solid explosive strikes in his first game of the night. As he set himself on the approach for his final shot I'm sure he was thinking to himself just one more to go. When he delivered his final ball he was off a shade from his spot on the lanes causing his ball to come up slightly light in the pocket. However, with the good pin action the pins all fell over giving

Lapointe a perfect game and the high single of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action. He was participating in the Friday Night Fun Mixed League (FNFML) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with 708 (300 – 85 pins over average – 218 – 190). It was his career 7th 300 (5-Marcin Bowl and 2-Hi-Way Bowl) and the 8th in the LCTA this bowling season. It



was also Lapointe's 5th 700 this season. Lapointe is averaging 215 after 22 weeks in the FNFML.

Shephard catches Armstrong:



Mike Shephard fired 781 (289 – 75 pins over average – 277 – 63 pins over average – 215 – 139 pins over average for three games) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl to register the high triple of the week in LCTA bowling competition. It was his 10th 700 this bowling season and ties him with

John Armstrong for the total 700 race. Shephard is now averaging 217 for 63 games in the BMNML.

Windover wheels higher triple:

Joe Windover wheeled 651 (203 – 236 – 69 pins over average – 212 – 150 pins over average for three games) in the Friday Night Fun Mixed League (FNFML) on lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl to record his career highest triple. His previous high triple was 644 and his high single is 297 both scores tossed in the RCAFA



403 Wing Mixed League last season at Hi-Way Bowl. Windover enjoys playing baseball but didn't play last year. He is looking to get on the junior men's Corunna travel team this year as a pitcher/first baseman. He also has been umpiring for several years and will be trying for his level 4 evaluation this summer so he can do national tournaments. Windover started bowling at age 6 in the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program in the 2010-2011 bowling season finishing the year with a 87 average for 51 games. This year he is averaging 167 after 22 weeks in the FNFML.

Ingles rolls career high triple:



Sarah Ingles rolled 567 (147-210-210) in the Friday Night Fun Mixed League (FNFML) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl to record her career highest triple. Her previous high triple was 561 which she bowled at the start of this season and her high single is 247. Sarah is averaging 167 after 22 weeks on the lanes.

Fox posts career high scores:

Jason Fox fired 469 (130-185 – 68 pins over average – 154) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl to post both his career high triple and single in LCTA bowling action. Fox did not come up through a youth bowling



organization but started bowling two years ago at age 47. He said he started bowling because he was looking for something to do with his buddies in the winter. His other sporting interests are baseball, hockey and paintball. Jason is averaging 119 for 60 games this year.

Mayea tops previous high single:



Bill Mayea rolled 189 in his second game of the night in the Border City Men's League (BCML) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling play to top his previous high single of 184. His career high triple is 501 which he bowled three weeks ago in the league. Mayea started bowling in his mid-30's for 5 years. He returned to the lanes last year when a friend in the BCML got him onto a team that needed a spare. He bowled almost every week

as a spare and this year he is bowling full time. Bill's other sporting interests are baseball and pickle ball. He said he used to play baseball until he needed two hips replacements about 15 years ago. He enjoys watching sports on TV. Last year Mayea averaged 135 for 54 games in the BCML and this year he is presently averaging 146 for 63 games.

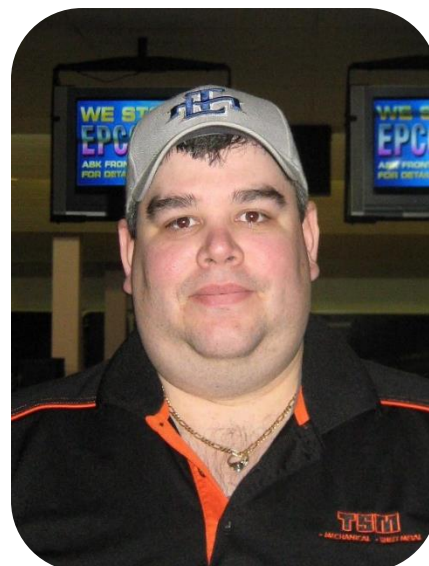


Bernard tosses personal high single:

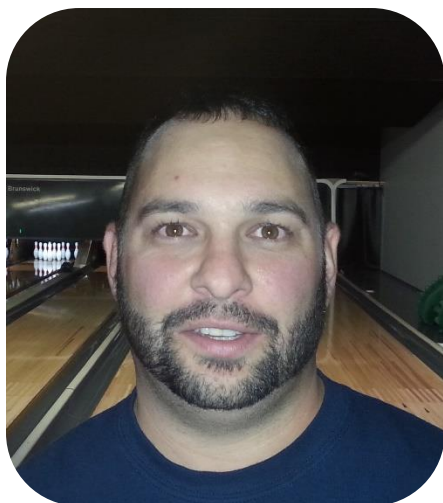
Chipman is tops in Sunday Classic league:

Legault is high in Friday Night Mixed League:

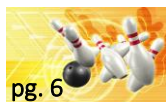

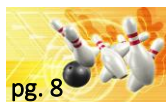


Legault is ladies top kegger:

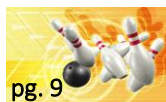
Hoadley is featured bowler:
