Weekly Highlights

Lewicki and Lapointe are perfect:

Steve Lewicki and Ben Lapointe hurled perfect games at Marcin Bowl to share the high single of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition.



Lewicki fired his 300 in his second game of the day bowling in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 21 & 22, finishing the day with a 721 (225-300 – 87 pins over average – 186) triple. It was his career 22nd 300 and the 5th 300 in the LCTA this season. It was his 4th 700 of the season as he previously bowled 714 (254-244-216), 744 (265-224-255) and 733 (268-241-224). Lewicki's triple was good for the 5th high triple of the week in the LCTA. Steve is a smooth rolling, high back swing, lefty with an HONOUR score sheet that most competitive bowlers would like to have in their scrap book. He has 4-298's, 4-299's, 22-300's and 14- 800's in the Canadian Tenpin Federation (CTF), the defunct American Bowling Congress (ABC) and the United States Bowling Congress (USBC) in league and tournament action. Steve is now averaging 215 for 36 games in the BWCL this season.

Lapointe rolled his 300 in his first game of the night bowling in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 29 & 30, finishing with a 710 (300-79 pins over average – 191-219) triple. Lapointe got a break on his last ball as he came up high, momentarily leaving the 6 pin but the 10 pin tripped out the 6 pin. It was Lapointe's career 10th 300 and the



LCTA's 6th 300 of the season. Ben also bowled 704 (257-237-210) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl, to record the 6th and 8th high triples of the week in LCTA bowling activity. They were his 12^h and 13th 700's of the season and his career 153rd and 154th. Lapointe now leads Mike Shephard by three in the King of the Lanes race. Ben is averaging 229 for 36 games in the FTBMNML and 223 for 39 games in the SPBCML bowling on the Lambton Metal Services teams.

Lapointe is one pin short:



Jason Lapointe tossed 299 (unapologetic, adamant 10 pin) in his second game of the day to post the second high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. He was bowling in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl finishing the day with a 678 triple. Lapointe has 3-300's to his credit. He bowled his first one in the 2007-2008 season and the other two in the 2011-2012 season. Jason is averaging 209 for 36 games in the BWCL this season. Last season in the league he averaged 206 for 87 games.

Murphy is tops again:



Chris Murphy hurled 762 (245 – 41 pins over average – 259 – 55 pins over average – 258 – 54 pins over average - 150 pins over aver for three games) in the Mike Guzik Realty Re/Max RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl, to post the high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was his 6th 700 of the season as he previously rolled 760,733,760,705 and 709. It was also the 3rd time this season that Murphy took the honours of recording the week's high triple. The other two weeks scores were 760 (244-249-267) and 733 (106-275-262). Chris is now averaging 210 for 27 games as a spare in the RCAFA league.

Farrenkopf records first 700:

Adam Farrenkopf wheeled 700 (220-233 – 53 pins over average – 247 – 67 pins over average – 160 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl, to register his career first 700 and the low 700 of the week in



LCTA bowling action. His previous high triple was 687 (220-235-232) which he bowled in the Mike Guzik Realty Re/Max RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League last season and his high single game is 264. Adam is now averaging 185 for 36 games in the FTBMNML this season.

Simard tops his scores:

Bobby Simard bowled 521 (201 – 65 pins over average – 145-175) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl, to record new personal high scores. Hi previous high scores were 486 and 190. This is Simard's first year in the SPBCML and he is averaging 141 after 27 games bowling on the Insultek team with team members Luke Janson, Chris Theoret, Blair Wallace, Darcy Paradis, Mike Nimmo, Trevor Fortin and Jahn Budziewiez.

Capes records new high scores:



Eric Capes rolled 510 (164-93- 253 – 135 pins over average – 156 pins over average for three games) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl, to record new personal high scores in the LCTA. His previous high scores were 468 (169-145-154) and 187 which he bowled in the MFFL this season. Capes, a two-handed bowler, is also eligible to receive a 100 pins over average for a single game award for his super 253 single game. Eric is bowling in an organized adult league for the first time and is averaging 122 for 36 games this season.

Youth bowlers post career high numbers:

Reid Riedel fired 413 (129-109-175 – 49 pins over average) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl, to top his previous high scores of 399 (112-170-117) and 170. This is Reid's fourth year in the PYL. In the 2022-2023 season he averaged 78 for 81 games. In the 2023-2024 season he averaged he averaged 99 for 69 games and last season he averaged 115 for 81 games. This season Reid is averaging 126 after 13 weeks on the lanes bowling with team member Laila Dean.



Thomas Wright tossed 355 (95-109-151 – 78 pins over average – 136 pins over average for three games) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl, to post new personal high scores. This is Thomas' fourth year in the PYL. In the 2022-2023 season he averaged 47 for 81 games, In the 2023-2024 season he

averaged 64 for 78 games and last season he averaged 77 for 72 games. Thomas is averaging 73 after 13 weeks on the lanes this year, bowling with team mates Ryder Kelly, Peyton Fraser and Brayden Moore,

McMahon posts new high single:



Dan McMahon bowled 220 (68 pins over average) in his second game of the night to record a new personal high single topping his previous 213. He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl finishing with a 558 triple. McMahon's high triple is 589. Dan is now averaging 155 for 36 games in the league bowling with team mates Jason Armitage, Dave Little and Jeff Gark.

Trio joins 700 club:

Bryce Watson, Jamie Ridealgh and Glenn Crowe were the latest bowlers to record their first 700 of the season in the LCTA.



Watson wheeled 740 (266-73 pins over average – 237-237 – 161 pins over average for three games) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) at Marcin Bowl, to record the 2nd high triple of the week in LCTA bowling play. It was his career 17th 700 in the LCTA. In the 2023-2024 season Bryce tossed 5-700's and last season he posted 8-700's. He is now averaging 197 for 30 games in the MFFL bowling with team mates Logan Klompstra, Kole Parkkila and Cameron Parkkila. Watson's career high triple is 795 (242-290-263) which he rolled in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League last season and 300 (3).



Ridealgh rolled 726 (245-225-256 – 54 pins over average – 120 pins over average for three games) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl, to register the 3rd high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. It was his first 700 of the season. In the 2023-2024 season Jamie had 3-700's and last season he had 7-700's to his credit. Ridealgh is averaging 206 for 27 games in the BWCL this season. Last season in the league he averaged 218 for 57



games. Ridealgh's career high scores are 797 and 300 (2). Jamie also rolled 793 ((279-268-246) last season.



Crowe tossed 707 (235-195 – 277 – 66 pins over average) as a spare in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl, to record the 7th high triple of the week in the LCTA. Crowe had 1-700 in the 2023-2024 season and 1-700 last season. Glenn is averaging 215 for 15 games in the BWCL this year. He is also bowling full time in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's this year and is averaging 191 for 30 games. Crowe's career high scores are 776 and 300 (2).

Mezzatesta notches number four:



Roy Mezzatesta fired 725 (210-236-279 – 74 pins over average) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl, to register the 4th high triple of the week in LCTA bowling competition. It was his 4th 700 of the season as he previously bowled 745 (278-232-235), 703 (265-214-224) and 753 (220-244-289). Melissa is averaging 177 after 14 weeks in the TTML and 194 for 9 games as a spare in the Best Wiring Classic League this season.

Ingles leads the youth:

Zachary Ingles hurled 605 (171-191-243 – 68 pins over average) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl, to lead the way for the youth bowlers in LCTA bowling action this past week. Zachary's career high triple is 676 (239-218-219) which he bowled in the PYL this season back in October and his



high single is 253 which he rolled in the PYL last season. Ingles is averaging 175 after 13 weeks this season. Last season he averaged 171 for 90 games.
