Lapointe streak continues:

Ben Lapointe has been ripping the lanes apart these past few weeks at Hi-Way Bowl. This past week was no different. On Sunday morning, after rolling eleven consecutive canonizing strikes, his heart rate was in overdrive. The house was filled with dead silence with 26 pairs of eyes focused on him. Lapointe got on the approach, swung his right arm a couple times, picked up his bowling ball, gave it a quick wipe and positioned himself on the lane for his final delivery. After releasing the ball with good follow through, the high revs ball gained momentum as it rolled down the alley and hit the pocket with explosive force. With great disappointment on his face



he turned around and fell momentarily on his knees thinking “oh no.... not a solid 8 pin”. Unfortunately the unrepentant 8 pin held its ground robbing Lapointe of another perfect game. It was his career 3rd 299. He has 2-300’ to his credit. Lapointe was bowling in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) on lanes 3 & 4 finishing the day with a 778 (210-299- 83 pins over average – 269 – 130 pins over average for three games). His scores were good for the high triple and high single of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition. He also tossed 719 (279-268-172) on lanes 11 & 12 in the SMCL as the league bowled twice Sunday morning. He also rolled 704 (258-226-220) on lanes 3 & 4 in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League and 745 (236-220-289) in the Target Trios League (TTL) to record 4-700’s this week. This young 24 year old kegler now has 58-700’s to his credit. A lot of bowlers have trouble getting one 700 in their life time. His highest triple is 787 (243-265-279) which he posted in the Marcin Bowl Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League in the 2018-2019 bowling season. Lapointe is having a solid year so far in league action with averages and games in brackets: SMCL (220 for 48 games) - RCAFA (220 for 33 games) - TTL (232 for 15 games).

Lewicki takes second place:

Steve Lewicki fired 757 (254-269-234) on lanes 9 & 10 in the Sunday Morning Classic league (SMCL) to take second place in the high triple department in LCTA bowling



action this week. The lefty is now averaging 220 for 51 games in the SMCL this year.

Croskery has solid week:



Jordan Croskery wheeled 711 (223-245-243) on lanes 9 & 10 in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League as a spare and 710 (220-245-245) in the Sunday Morning Classis League (SMCL) on lanes 7 & 8 to have a solid week on the lanes in LCTA bowling activity. Croskery is now averaging 212 for 45 games in the SMCL this year and 208 in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League.

Lapointe Senior also records 700:



Jim Lapointe hurled 706 (268-218-220) in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) on lanes 7 & 8 in LCTA bowling action this week. Lapointe is now averaging 221 for 51 games in the SMCL this year. He also partakes in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League and is also averaging 221 for 42 games.

Burgess high over average:



Jim Burgess tossed 681 (257- 79 pins over average -221-203 – 147 pins over average for three games) in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) to take the honours as the high over average for three games this week.
