Tony Olsen wheeled 743 (267-242-234 – 128 pins over average for three games) in the Sunday Morning Men’s League



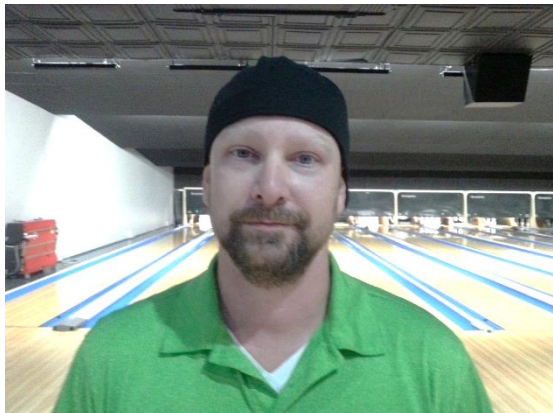
