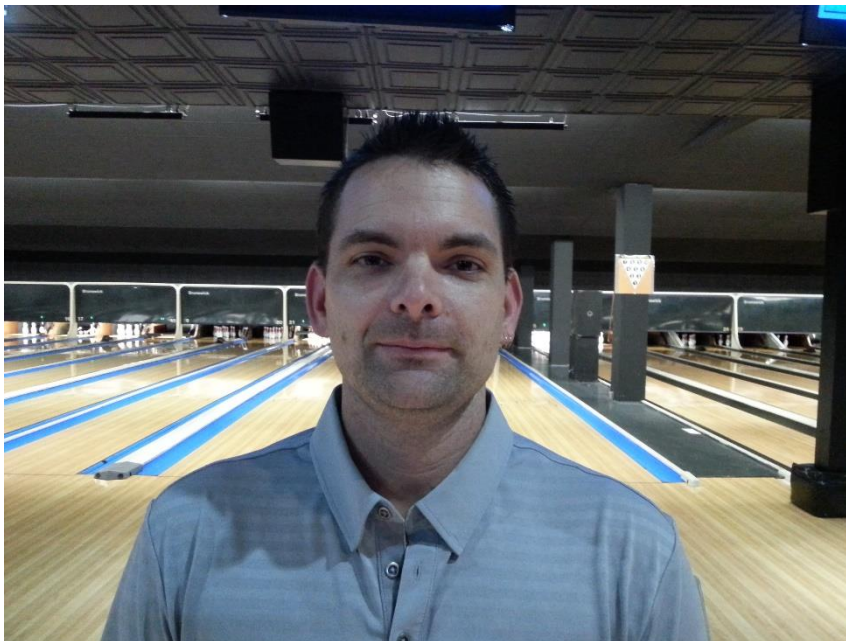

Dunn owns high single:

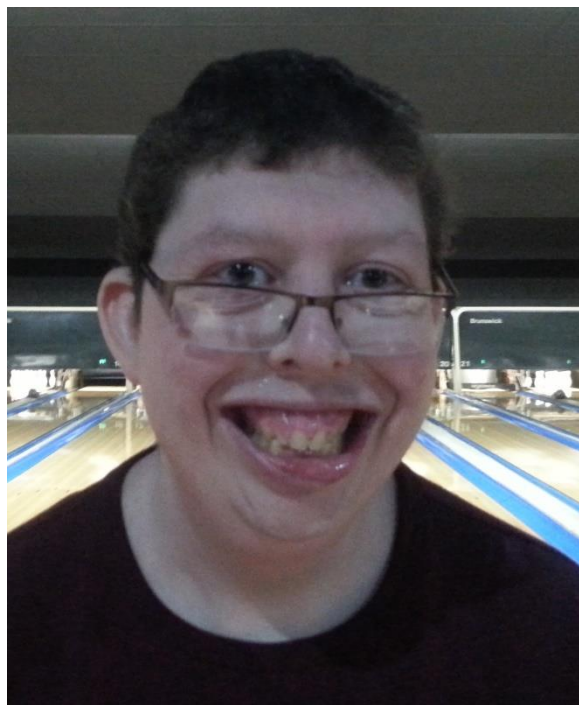
