Weekly Highlights

Watson leads the way with super night:



Bryce Watson tossed 795 (242 – 51 pins over average - 290 – 99 pins over average - 263 – 72 pins over average – 222 pins over average for three games), in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men’s League (SPBCML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl, to record the high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition. His super achievement resulted in a career new high triple topping his previous 730 (248-261-221) which he posted last season in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League. It was his 4th 700 of the season and he now has a career 9-700 ‘s to his credit. Watson is averaging 199 for 30 games in the SPBCML this year.

Ramsay is second best topping his high triple:

Kirk Ramsay wheeled 764 (259-246-259) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML), on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling action this past week, to record the second high triple of the week. His previous high triple was 673 (173-265-235) which he bowled in the 2022-2023 season in the Friday Night Fun Mixed League and his highest game is 268 which he recorded in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) two weeks ago. Cameron is averaging 200 for 6 games in the MFFL and 184 for 33 games in the FTBMNML this year.

Hoadley tops his high triple:

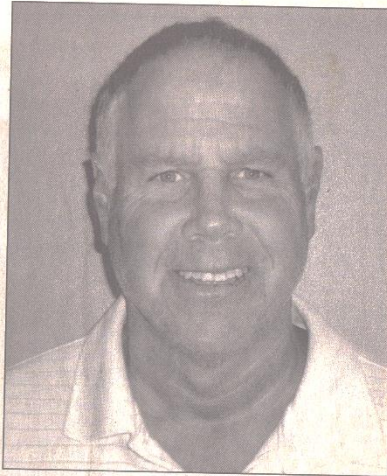
