Willemssen rolls perfection:



Corey Willemssen rolled twelve strikes in a row in his 2nd game of the night to register the first 300 in the 2019-2020 Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling season. He was performing in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) on lanes 13 & 14 battling it out with Jim Lapointe for the high triple of the night in the BMNML. He finished the night with an admirable 759 (228-300- 120 pins over average - 231 - 219 pins over average for three games pins over average for

three games) which was good for the third high triple of the week. It was his career second perfect game, his first one coming in the Marcin Sunday Morning Men's League on February 17, 2014. Corey started bowling at age 6 in the Hi-Way Bowl Youth Phantoms and Rebels League and he has been enjoying the bonding with his fellow bowlers for 37 years.



Marciniszyn is tops on the lanes:

Mike Marciniszyn fired 775 (237-259-279 – 109 pins over average for three games) on lanes 25 & 26 in the Sunday Morning Men’s League (SMML) at Marcin Bowl to take the honours for the high triple in LCTA bowling action this past week. The smooth right hander is off to a great start in the league averaging 231 after 12 games breathing down the back of team mate Larry Plumb who is leading the SMML with a 233 average (12 games). Mike finished the SMML last year with a super 229 average which was good for the league’s high average and the top average in the LCTA. His closest

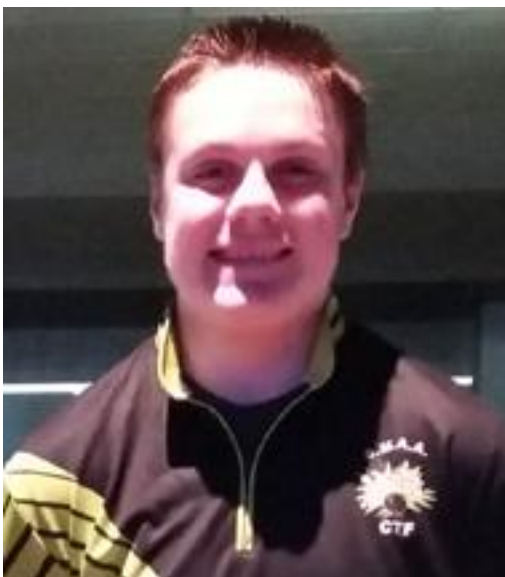
competitor was Steve Lewicki with 224.

Lapointe takes second place:

Jim Lapointe hurled 765 (258-259 – 248 – 126 pins over average for three games) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (BMNML) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl to record the second high triple of the week. Jim bowled in three leagues last year with his final averages and number of games in brackets: Marcin Thursday Night Men’s League (MTNML) 218 (96), Hi-Way RCAFA 403 Mixed League 213 (90) and the BMNML 213 (27). I’m sure Jim remembers his special night of February 11, 2016 in the MTNML – 845 (300-300-245) as do the bowlers who watched him perform that night.

Legault is best for the ladies:

Melissa Legault wheeled 709 (227-246-236) in the Tuesday Night Ladies League (TNLL) at Marcin Bowl to post the ladies' high triple last week. Melissa returned to the TNLL three years ago with her final league average in the 2016-2017 season being 210. In the 2017-2018 season, her final league average was 213. Last year she shared the LCTA ladies high final average with Pam Marciszyn. Both keglers were solid on the lanes with a 207 average.

Bestard is youth high bowler:

Jacob Bestard fired 630 (207-235 – 65 pins over average – 120 pins over average for three games) in the Intermediate Division of the Marcin Bowl Youth League to post the youth high triple of the week. Jacob took up the great sport of 10-pin bowling at age five in the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program (MBYBP) and has been knocking down the pins for thirteen years. He is following the steps of his grandfather (Dan) and his father (Drew) who both went all the way through the MBYBP. As a senior bantam, Jacob finished with a 98 average in the 2010-2011 season. He finished last year with a 178



average and this year he is carrying a 180 average after four weeks of bowling. His career personal high scores are 674 and 279.

Newman is 100 pins over average:



George Newman tossed 289 – 115 pins over average in the Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League to take the honours for the week’s second high over average for a single game. He finished the night with a 695 (246 – 173 pins over average for three games). George started bowling in a 5-Pin youth bowling program at Northgate Bowl when he was 6 years old. He worked at the bowling alley at the back with the machines later in his youth years and at age 16

he started bowling 10-Pin. He started participating in adult 10-Pin leagues at age 18. Two of his memorable moments in bowling were when he bowled his first 300 and when he had the first 10 strikes in the very difficult American Bowling Congress tournament in Reno Nevada finishing with a 289. His career high triple is 796.
