Weekly Highlights

Peters records personal high three:

Steve Peters fired 787 (251 – 59 pins over average – 278 – 86 pins over average – 258 – 66 pins over average – 211 pins over average for three games) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl, to record the high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition. It was his career sanctioned high triple topping his previous 740. It was also his 3rd 700 of the season as he previously bowled 700 (235-206-259) and 706 (246-235-225). Steve was also high over average for three games in the LCTA this week. Peters is averaging 194 for 99 games in the BWCL this season. Last season in the League he averaged 202 for 60 games. Peter's career high single is 296 which he rolled in the BWCL this season.



Lapointe nipped to second place:

Jim Lapointe hurled 782 (279 – 62 pins over average – 255 – 248 – 131 pins over average for three games) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 17 & 18 and 714 (247-227-240) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 19 & 20 both at Marcin Bowl, to register the 2nd and 7th high triples of the week in the LCTA. They were his 15th and 16th 700's of the season in the LCTA. Jim is averaging 218 for 90 games in the BWCL and 219 for 90 games in the FTBMNML this season. Lapointe has had a solid year on the lanes this season with an 804 (277-258-269) bowled in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League and 1-300 bowled in the BWCL two weeks ago.



Youth bowler is 100 pins over average:

Kian O'Keefe bowled 243 (114 pins over average) in his third game of the day, to qualify for the Canadian Tenpin Federation 100 pins over average for a single game award which is a watch. It was also Kian's career new high single game topping his previous 219 bowled in the PYL last season. He was bowling in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl, finishing the day with a 448 triple. Kian's career sanctioned high triple is 506 (267-166-173) recorded in the PYL this season. Kian is averaging 129 after 32 weeks on the lanes this season. Last season he averaged 125 for 90 games in the league.

Trio record new high triples:

Danny Moorey, Owen Allison and Rudi Mulder recorded new high triples in their respective leagues this past week in LCTA bowling action.

Moorey rolled 657 (207- 38 pins over average – 220 – 51 pins over average – 230 - 61 pins over average – 150 pins over average for three games) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl. His previous high triple was 646 (245-210-191) which he bowled in the MFFL in the 2023-2024 bowling season. His career sanctioned high single is 255 which he bowled in the MFFL last season. Moorey is averaging 171 after 93 games in the MFFL this season. Last season in the league he averaged 173 for 96 games.



Allison wheeled 619 (156-227 – 71 pins over average – 236 – 80 pins over average – 151 pins over average for three games) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bow. His previous high triple was 601 and his high single is 238. Owen finished the year with a 156 average for 87 games. Last year in the league he averaged 155 for 60 games.



Mulder tossed 550 (162-194-194 – 118 pins over average for three games) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl. His previous high triple was 536 (170-172-194) which he bowled in the MFFL this season and his sanctioned high single is 203. Mulder is averaging 145 for 84

games in the MFFL this season. Last season in the league he averaged 134 for 93 games. Rudi did not come up through a sanctioned youth league but started bowling 4 years ago at age 68.

Leneve fires new high scores:

Youth bowler Cooper Leneve fired 454 (148 – 37 pins over average – 166 – 55 pins over average – 140 – 121 pins over average for three games) in the Phantom Youth (PYL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl, to establish new personal high scores. His previous high triple was 375 (114-146-115) bowled in the PYL this season and his high single was 146. Cooper is in his second year of organized league bowling averaging 111 after 32 weeks of play. Last season in the league he averaged 85 for 78 games.

Pair share same triple:

Roy Mezzatesta and Ben Lapointe posted the same triple in their respective leagues in LCTA bowling action this past week.

Mezzatesta hurled 761 (290 – 79 pins over average – 234-237 – 128 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl, to record the 3rd high triple of the week in the LCTA. His 290 game was also the high single of the week in the LCTA. It was his 10th 700 of the season and his highest 700 this season. Mezzatesta has been struggling in the 700 department as his last 700 triple was two months ago when he bowled 705 (246-222-237) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML). Roy is averaging 212 for 93 games in the FTBMNML

this season bowling on the "S&S ProShop" team and finished with a 211 average for 87 games in the SPBCML this season bonding with the boys on the "Sarnia Produce" team.

Lapointe hurled 761 (258-225-278 – 53 pins over average) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl, to share the 3rd high triple of the week with Mezzatesta. It was his 31st 700 of the season and his career 172nd 700. Lapointe is the "King of the Lanes" this season as his closest competitors in the 700 department were Mike Shephard with 21-700's and Chris Murphy with 19-700's. Ben finished with a 225



average for 90 games in the SPBCML this season. Last season he averaged 215 for 93 games in the league

Armstrong posts number three:

John Armstrong wheeled 727 (238-222-267 – 67 pins over average) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl, to post the 4th high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. It was his 3rd 700 of the season as he previously bowled 721 (220-258-243) and 714 (231-195-288). Armstrong is averaging 201 for 93 games in the BWCL this season. Last season in the league he averaged 216 for 90 games. John's career sanctioned high scores are 792 and 300 (3) one bowled in the Cowboys and Indians League in Port Huron this season.



Croskery holds on to fifth position:

Jordan Croskery fired 721 (232-234-255) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl, to record the 5th high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity this past week. It was his 3rd 700 of the season as he previously bowled 770 (268-255-247) and 700 (229-265-206). Croskery is averaging 215 for 63 in the BWCL this season. Last season in the league he averaged 209 for 68 games, Jordan's career sanctioned high scores are 826 (279-269-278) which he bowled in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League at Hi-Way Bowl in the 2013-2014 season and 300 (9).



Marciniszyn grabs sixth spot:

Mike Marciniszyn rolled 717 (212-216-289 – 75 pins over average) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl, to grab 6th spot in the high triple department this past week in LCTA bowling action. It was his 4th 700 of the season as he previously bowled 713 (255-235-223), 719 (217-236-266) and 706 (231-234-241). Marciniszyn is averaging 216 for 96 games in the BWCL this season. Last season in the league he averaged 219 for 84 games. Mike's career sanctioned high triple is 812 (268-258-286) which he bowled in the Sunday Morning Men's League at Marcin Bowl



in the 2020-2021 season and his sanctioned high single is 300 (10) three of which have been recorded in the Port Huron.

Booth enters 700 club:

Doug Booth tossed 712 (235-231-246) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl, to record his first 700 of the season and the 8th high triple of the week in the LCTA. Booth did not have any 700's last season. Doug's career sanctioned high triple is 748 (215-264-269) which he bowled in the SPBCML in the 2022-2023 season and his high single is 279. Booth finished with a 193 average for 69 games in the SPBCML this season. Last season in the league he averaged 190 for 66 games.



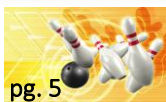
Chipman notches two more:

Shane Chipman bowled 710 (237-217-256 – 48 pins over average) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 19 & 20 and 704 (254-225-225) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 17 & 18 both at Marcin Bowl, to record the 9th and 10th high triples of the week in LCTA bowling competition. They were his 11th and 12th 700's of the season in the LCTA. Shane is averaging 215 for 96 games in the BWCL and 209 for 84 games in the FTBMNML this season.



Sitter leads the ladies:

Kelly Sitter wheeled 612 (202-223-187) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 15 & 16 and 602 (246-168-188) in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League both at Marcin Bowl, to post the ladies top triple and single of the week in LCTA bowling activity. They were her 12th and 13th 600's this season. Kelly is averaging 183 for 69 games in the BWCL and 190 for 72 games in the RCAFA league this season.



Fraser is second best:

Michelle Fraser fired 609 (268 – 88 pins over average – 173-168) in the Klean and Brite Thursday Night Mixed League (KBTNML) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl, to register the ladies second high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was her 4th 600 of the season as she previously bowled 621, 628 and 619. Michelle is bowling only once a week and finished with an 180 average for 96 games. Last year in the league she averaged 179 for 96 games. Michelle's career sanctioned high triple is 637 (233-179-225) recorded in the KBTNML last season and her sanctioned high single is 245 posted in the KBTNML this season.
