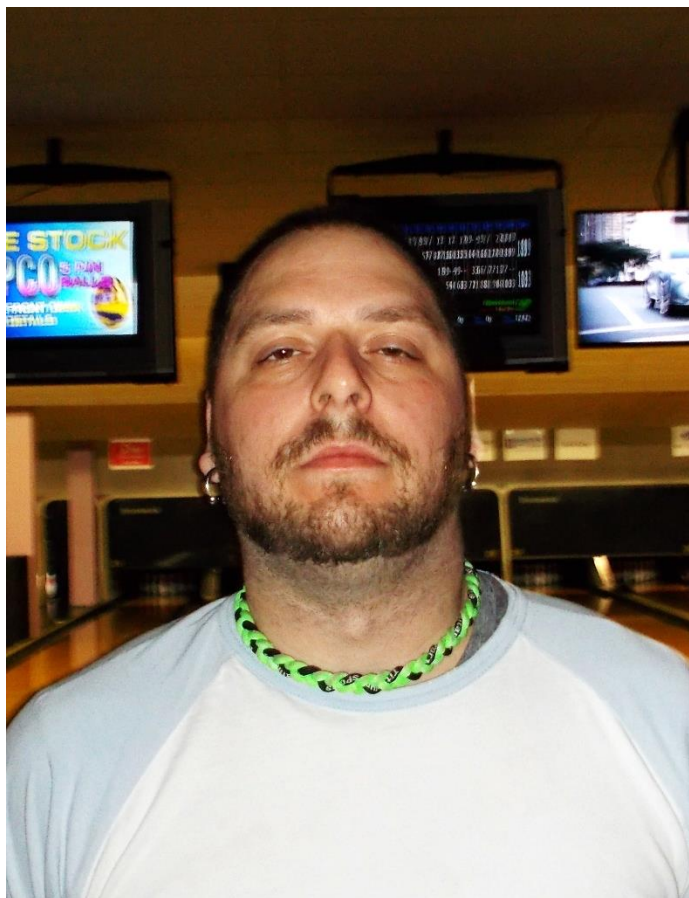

Gauthier is perfect:

Brandon Gauthier rolled 12 solid strikes on lanes 31 & 32 in the Thursday Night Men's League (TNML) at Marcin Bowl to record a perfect game claiming the high single of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action this past week. He finished the night with 667 (300 – 86 pins over average). Last year Brandon told this writer that he was watching bowling videos to improve his game. It appears he might be watching another bowling video “how to bowl a perfect game” as this is his 2nd 300 this season and he now has a career 7-300's. He bowled his previous one on January 6, 2020. Brandon is only bowling full time in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) at Marcin Bowl and spares in other leagues as required. He is averaging 214 after 54 games in the BMNML. In the TNML he is carrying a 215 average for 18 games.



Lapointe is bowler of the week:

Jim Lapointe hurled 789 (289-257-243 – 120 pins over average for three games) on lanes 31 & 32 in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League to take the honours for the high triple bowler of the week in LCTA bowling activity. Lapointe is sparing in the league this year averaging 227 for 27 games. Jim also bowls full time in the RCAFA 403 Mixed League at Hi-Way Bowl carrying a 211 average for 72 games.

Plain takes second position:

Wilson Plain tossed 758 (278 - 72 pins over average – 244 - 236 – 140 pins over average for three games) on lanes 29 & 30 in the Sunday Morning Men's League (SMML) at Marcin Bowl to take second place in the high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. His averages in the SMML starting in the 2010-2011 season and going upward to the 2018-2029 season except the 2014-2015 season which he took off were 183 – 182 – 193 – 195 – 196 – 196 – 193 and 192. This year Plain is averaging 206 after 72 games.

Croskery rolls into third place:

Jordan Croskery rolled 743 (258-227-258) in the Target Trios Mixed League (TTML) at Hi-Way Bowl to take possession of the third high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. Jordan is bowling in two leagues this year: the TTML and the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) at Marcin Bowl. He also spares in other leagues as required. In the TTML he is carrying an average of 206



for 75 games while in In the BMNML he is averaging 219 for 33 games.

Lapointe leads the youth:



Ben Lapointe fired 730 (257-280) in the Senior Division in the Youth Phantom League at Hi-Way Bowl to take the honours for the youth high triple in LCTA bowling action this past week. Lapointe is a twenty year old right handed bowler with a ton of revs and a strong competitor on the lanes. As stated before, this writer is keeping track of his career 700 plus triples and he now has 37 (25 in adult leagues and 12 in youth leagues) in his

young bowling career. This is an exceptional accomplishment since most bowlers struggle to get one or two in their lifetime.

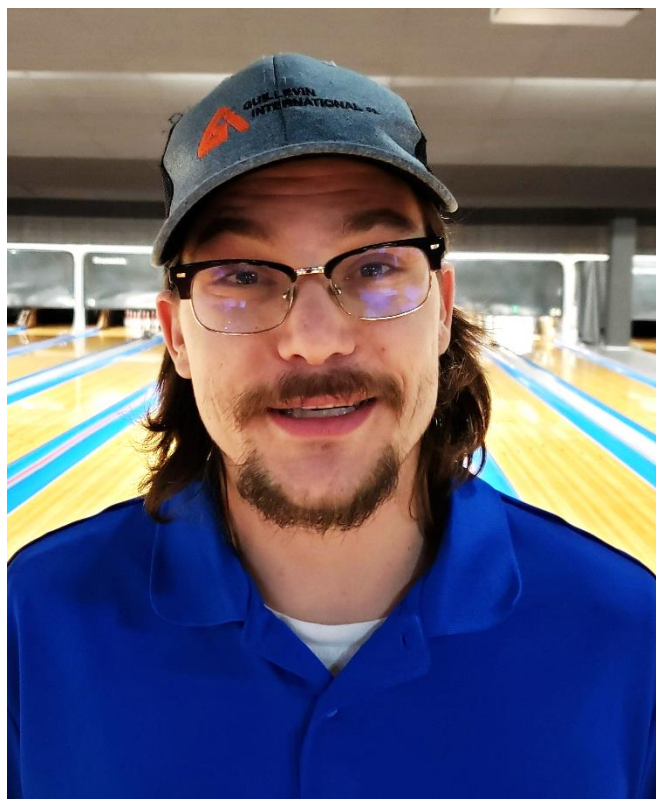
Legault is tops for the ladies:

Karyne Legault wheeled 696 (224-214-258) in the Tuesday Night Ladies League at Marcin Bowl to lead the way for the ladies in LCTA bowling play this week. The right handed bowler is having a solid year as she is averaging 211 after 57 games. She is bowling only once a week and last year she finished with a 205 average for 93 games in the same league.



Kris Knowles has a super night:

Kris Knowles had a superb night last Monday at Marcin Bowl but this writer did not have his picture or info to go with the highlight so he is being recognized this week for his great effort on the lanes. Knowles rolled 696 (266 – 102 pins over average – 222 – 208 – 204 pins over average for three games) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) - a night he will always remember. His triple was his personal highest achievement and his personal high single game is 286 which he bowled last year. Kris started bowling at age 10 in the Youth Phantom League at Hi-Way



Bowl but only bowled for a few years because of health reasons. His real sports love is hockey but he was not allowed to play the game because of an ongoing liver problem. He requires a liver transplant and has been waiting for 30 years but at age 15 he was taken off the transplant list because he was deemed healthy enough to avoid the surgery. But when he gets really sick, he will need the transplant. He is truly a miracle as the doctors told his parents he would not survive past the age of 2 without a transplant. Kris said he had to find a sport that would not adversely affect his health so at age 28 he decided to get back into bowling again. He joined the BMNML in the 2017-2018 season finishing the year with a 159 average for 90 games. Last year he averaged 157 for 90 games in the BMNML and 152 for 58 games in the Border City Men's League. This year he is carrying a 167 average after 66 games in the BMNML. He is bowling on the team "Team Blue" consisting of other members Mike Maxwell, Chad Pretty and Kirk Pretty. Knowles said "I love bowling, I live life to the fullest so nothing can bring me down and one day I hope to roll the "300".
