Weekly Highlights

Watson is tops with strong triple:



Bryce Watson rolled 779 (290 – 81 pins over average - 232 – 257 – 48 pins over average – 152 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl, to record the top triple in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action this past week. His 290 was also good for the high single of the week. It was his 4th 700 of the season as he previously bowled 740 (266-237-237), 703 (268-222-213) and 748 (268-259-221). Watson is now averaging 204 for 21 games in the FTBMNML this season.

Ridealgh is second best:



Bill Ridealgh wheeled 776 (277 – 62 pins over average – 257 – 42 pins over average – 242 – 131 pins over average for three games) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl, to record the second high triple in LCTA bowling competition this past week. It was his 2nd solid triple in a row in the BWCL as last week he bowled 747 (221-258-268) and it was his 3rd 700 of the season is other one being 743 (248-216-279). Ridealgh is averaging 217 for 57 games in the BWCL this season. Last season in the league he averaged 212 for 93 games.

Bryce Watson (290), Mike Shephard (279) and Glenn Crowe (269) fired 838 scratch for an average of 279 per bowler in their first game of the night. They rolled 31 out of a possible 36 strikes in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl. Unfortunately it is not official Canadian Tenpin Federation (CTF) record because it was bowled on a

four man team. The official 3 man single game record is 826. Two weeks ago Bryce Watson (300), Glenn Crowe (287) and Devon Crowe (246) tossed 833 in their first game in the FTBMNML.

Wright ups his high triple:



Daniel Wright rolled 763 (268 – 82 pins over average – 257 – 71 pins over average – 238 – 52 pins over average – 205 pins over average for three games) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl, to record a new personal high triple and the third high triple of the week in LCTA bowling play. It was his 2nd 700 of the season, his other one being 700 (252-216-232) which he bowled in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) and his high single is 276 bowled in the MFFL this season. Daniel is averaging 189 for 57 games in the

MFFL and 217 for 18 games in the FTBMNML this season.

Choptovy posts new high three:

Stewart Choptovy fired 747 (278 – 73 pins over average – 203 – 266 – 61 pins over average – 132 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl, to register a new personal high triple and the 5th high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. His previous high triple was 715 (227-209-279) bowled in the FTBMNML this season. It was his 3rd 700 of the



season and his other 700 this season is 713 (213-236-264). Choptovy's career high single is 299 which he bowled in the Greater Toronto Tenpin Bowling Association. Stewart is now averaging 208 for 51 games in the FTBMNML this season.

His previous high triple was 563 (194-134-235) which he bowled in the FTBMNML this season and his high single is 255 bowled in the FTBMNML last season. Pair record new high triples:

Gavin Yap and Steve Mezzatesta recorded new high triples in LCTA Bowling action this past week.



Yap tossed 611 (187-191-233 – 57 pins over average) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl, to register a career new high triple. His previous high triple was 604 (242-216-146) and his high triple is 242 both bowled in the FTBMNML last season. Yap is averaging 178 for 54 games in the FTBMNML this season. Leaving the 7-9-10 split is probably as hard to do as converting the split. Two bowlers in the Mulder Financial Fun League were successful in converting this unusual split this past week. Tiffany Burr converted the split on lane 26 and Gerry Landon converted the split on lane 19. This writer can honestly say I have never seen this split converted before but I would say the odds are extremely high for the conversion twice in one night in one league.

Shephard gets two back:



Mike Shephard hurled 753 (228-280 – 62 pins over average - 245) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl and 717 (279-221-217) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 19 & 20 also at Marcin Bowl, to record the 4th and 8th high triples of the week in LCTA bowling action.
