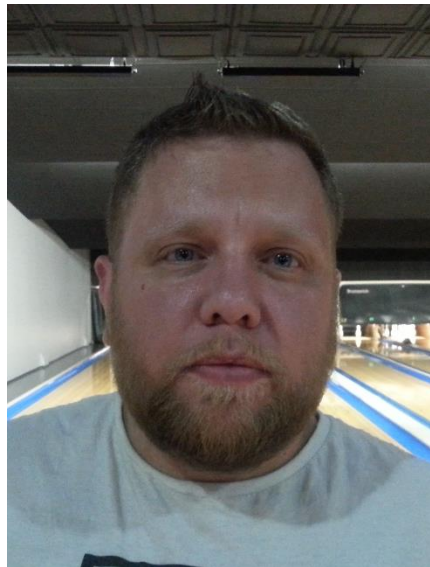


over average – games) in the Marcin Bowl once a week in the BCML.
