## Weekly Highlights

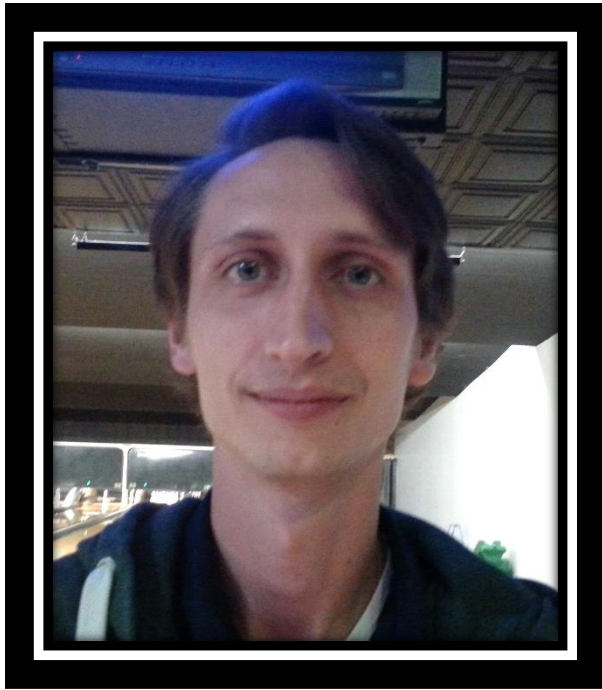
### Senior Lapointe is perfect:



Jim Lapointe hurled a perfect game in his first game of the night in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) to record the high single of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition. Lapointe was bowling on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with 725 (300 – 90 pins over average – 212-213) which tied him with Roy Mezzatesta for the second high triple of the week. It was the third 300 in the LCTA this season with Bryce Watson and Brandon Gauthier owning the other two.

Lapointe's gem was his career 8<sup>th</sup> 300 having bowled 6 at Marcin Bowl and 2 at Hi-Way Bowl. It was also his 6<sup>th</sup> 700 series in the LCTA this year. Lapointe is averaging 212 for 45 games in the FTBMNML this year.



**Ramsay rolls career high triple:**

Kirk Ramsay rolled 751 (247-268 – 65 pins over average – 236 – 142 pins over average for three games) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl to record the high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. It was his career highest 700 series and his first 700 of the season in the LCTA. Ramsay is averaging 206 for 48 games in the BWCL bowling on a team with George Newman and Steve Lewicki. He also is a fifth man spare on the “Mike’s Hair Styling” team in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML)

bowling with Mel Matthews, Mike Jones, George Newman and Dennis Ramsay. He is averaging 214 for 6 games in the FTBMNML. His career high single is 299 which he posted in the Bluewater Monday Night Men’s at Marcin Bowl on November 12, 2018 when he bowled 729 (299 – 82 pins over average – unyielding 10 pin – first game) on lanes 33 & 34).

**Willemsen is 100 pins over average:**

Louie Willemsen rolled 290 in his last game of the night in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling activity to be 103 pins over average for a single game. Willemsen has 1-700 this season – 705 (222-257-226) which he bowled in the FTBMNML. He also had 1-700 last season. Willemsen is averaging 187 for 45 games in the FTBMNML



bowling on the “Bluewater Ideas” team with David Paquette, Tony Olsen and Kyle Adamson. Louie’s career high scores are 811 and 300 (2).

### **The “Mezz” has a solid week:**



Roy Mezzatesta tossed 725 (232-266-227) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl to tie for second spot with Jim Lapointe in the high triple department in LCTA bowling action this past week. He also bowled 710 (190-279 – 71 pins over average – 241) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men’s League (SPBCML) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl to grab the fourth high triple of the week. It was his 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> 700 in the LCTA this season.

Mezzatesta is averaging 211 for 51 games in the BWCL this year. He also bowls in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Men’s League and is averaging 196 for 48 game. He is averaging 210 for 54 games in the SPBCML. One of Mezzatesta’s many memorable bowling moments happened on January 23, 2014 when he fired 300-299 in his first two games in the Border City Men’s League at Marcin Bowl.

### **Friis slips into third position:**

Jill Friis fired 721 (204-268 – 62 pins over average – 249) in the Best Wiring Classic League on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl to take 3<sup>rd</sup> position in the 700 race in the LCTA this past week. It was her first 700 series in the LCTA this season. Jill is averaging 210 for 24 games in the league bowling on a team with Fred Harris and Ralph MacDuff. One of Jill’s many career accomplishments is that she holds the



Canadian Tenpin Federation women's 9 game record (team, doubles, singles- all events) of 2145 for an average of 238 per game which she set in London, Ontario in 2011.

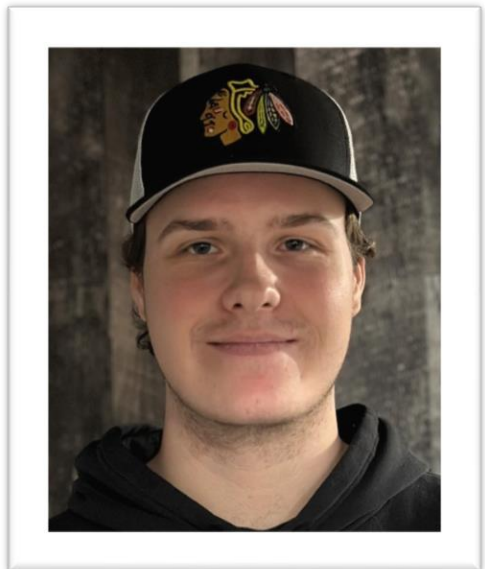
### **Lapointe holds down fifth place:**



Jason Lapointe wheeled 704 (235-224-245) on lanes 17 & 18 in the Bar 10 Thursday Night Mixed League at Marcin Bowl to register the fifth high triple of the week in LCTA bowling play. It was his third 700 this season as he previously bowled 725 (277-226-222) and 750 (235-267-248). Lapointe is averaging 210 after 18 weeks in the league. His career high scores are 760 and 300 (3).

### **Parkkila rolls another 700:**

Kole Parkkila broke through the 700 barrier in his last night of bowling before the Christmas break when he rolled 720 (236-259-225) in the Best Wiring Classic League at Marcin Bowl to post his career first 700 series. This past Friday night in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) he tossed 701 (199-257 – 69 pins over average – 245) to record his second 700 of the season and the low 700 of the week.
