Weekly Highlights

Lapointe fires 800 triple:



Jim Lapointe had a memorable night on the lanes in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) this past week. He fired 802 (279 - 52 pins over average – 277 - 50 pins over average – 246 - 123 pins over average for three games) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl to record the high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition. It was his career 4th 800 series along with his other three: 835 (259-287-289 – April 23, 2013) - 845 (300-300-245 - February 11, 2016) and 804 (1997- 1998 season). It was the 2nd 800 series posted this bowling season in the LCTA with Brandon Gauthier having the other one (841 – 268-297-276 – October 21, 2022). Lapointe, who is a spare in the BMNML, rolled 29 out of a possible 36 strikes in his achievement. Last week Lapointe had another great week as he bowled his career sanctioned 7th 300.



Brooks tops his career high triple:



Doug Brooks tossed 749 (252–230 - 267 – 69 pins over average - 155 pins over average for three games) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (BMNML) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling play this past week to top his previous high triple of 729. His score was also good for the second high triple of the week. Brooks is averaging 201 for 60 games in the BMNML this year. His career

high single is 288.

Crowe rolls personal high triple:

Devon Crowe rolled 680 (246 – 56 pins over average – 231-203 – 110 pins over average for three games) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (BMNML) on lanes 31 & 32 to record his personal high triple beating his previous 672. His career high single is 289. Crowe is a graduate of the Hi-Way Bowl Youth Phantom Bowling Program. The



twenty two year old started knocking down the pins and sharing the friendship on the lanes at age five. Crowe is averaging 191 for 69 games in the BMNML. He bowls with team members Mike Shephard, Brian Watson and Glenn Crowe.

Legault tops career best scores:



Noah Legault bowled 541 (191 – 59 pins over average – 186 -164 – 145 pins over average for three games) in the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program on lanes 23 & 24 to register his career high scores. His previous high scores were 516 and 190 which he bowled this season. Noah is averaging 132 after 22 weeks of bowling. Noah started bowling in the Hi-Way Bowl Youth Phantom Bowling

Program at age 5 and he has been knocking down the pins for 5 years now.

Ingles fires career high single:

Blake Ingles fired 278 in the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program to post his career high single. He was bowling in his first game of the day on lanes 13 & 14 ending the day with 616 (278 – 113 pins over average - 205). He is



eligible for a Canadian Tenpin Federation watch for being 100 pins over average in a single game. His previous high single was 243 and his high triple is 620. He is averaging 165 after 22 weeks of bowling. Blake started bowling in 2013 at age 9 in the Youth Phantom League at Hi-Way Bowl and is in his 10th year of having fun on the lanes.

Hannah tosses high triple:



Logan Hannah tossed 597 (173-210-214 – 54 pins over average) in the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program on lanes 13 & 14 to register his career high triple. This writer was unable to verify that it was his highest triple but looking back over the last three years of bowling reports, I couldn't find anything higher. Logan's highest single game is 233. Logan started bowling at age 11 in the Hi-Way Bowl Youth Phantom Bowling Program and is in his seventh year on the lanes. He is averaging 160 after 22 weeks of bowling. Hannah loves exercising his mind and eye-hand coordination playing video games and solving the famous Rubik's cube.

Dunn wheels her best triple:

Crystal Dunn wheeled 566 (187 – 45 pins over average – 191 – 49 pins over average – 188 – 46 pins over average – 140 pins over average for three games) in the Thursday Night Mixed League on



lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl to post her career high triple. Her career high single is 206. She is averaging 142 after 24 weeks of bowling.

Roehler rolls personal high single:



Mark Roehler rolled 232 in his second game of the night in the Border City Men's League (BCML) last week on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl to record his career high single. His career high triple is 630. Roehler started bowling 5-pin in a youth league organization in LaSalle at the age of 10. He started bowling 10-pin for fun with friends when he was 18 but did not start league bowling until he was 30. He has been bowling for 55 years thanks to his parents who encouraged him to get involved in the great sport. Mark also plays golf and played baseball but hasn't played baseball in a number of years. Roehler's hobbies are travelling and collecting coins. Mark is a once a week bowler averaging 165 for 66 games in the BCML.

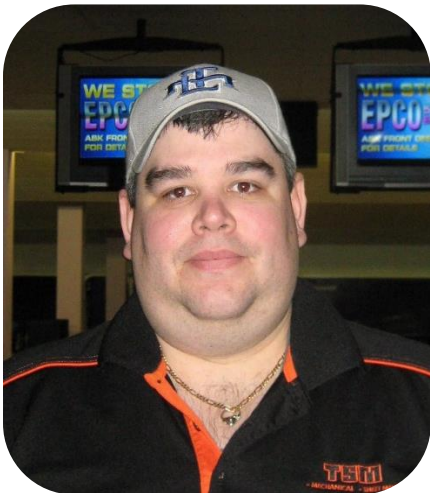
McKinnon bowls her top single:

Ryan MacKinnon bowled 180 (45 pins over average) in her second game of the day to record her highest single game. She was bowling in the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program on lanes 13 & 14 finishing the day with 455. Ryan is a very active, determined 14



year old left handed bowler in her sixth year of bowling. She thrives on determination, perfection and competition resulting in her already winning scholarship money for future education. Ryan got hooked on bowling when her family often went out to have some fun at the alleys. When this writer highlighted her 3 years ago her other activities included ballet/jazz, gymnastics and baseball. This writer hopes she is still engaged in these great activities. Ryan is averaging 135 after 22 weeks of bowling.

Chipman edged to third spot:

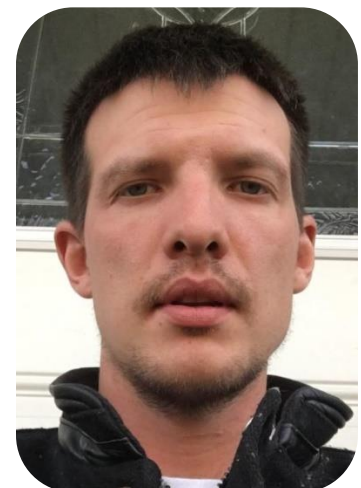


Shane Chipman fired 743 (214-249-280 – 76 pins over average – 131 pins over average for three games) in the Friday Night Fun Mixed League (FNFML) on lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl to record the third high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. It was his 3rd 700 of the bowling season. Chipman is averaging 206 after 23 weeks in the FNFML.

He also bowls in the Sunday Morning Classic League and is averaging 203 for 54 games. His career sanctioned high scores are 757 and 300 (2).

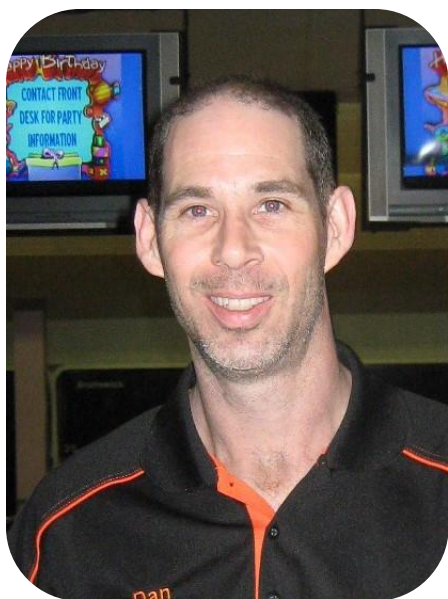
Atchison takes fourth place:

Nathan Atchison tossed 736 (235-245-256) in the Friday Night Fun Mixed League (FNFML) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl to post the fourth high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. It was



his 5th 700 this season. He previously bowled 709 (193-254-162) – 702 (254-235-213) – 711 (254-213-244) and 702 (225-243-234). Atchison is averaging 211 after 23 weeks in the FNFML. He also spares in the Sunday Morning Classic League and is averaging 212 for 27 games.

Chopper good for fifth spot:



Dan Chopp rolled 730 (249-258-223) in the Border City Men's League (BCML) on lanes 25 & 26 to post the fifth high triple of the week in LCTA bowling competition. It was his 7th 700 this season. Chopp bowls once a week and is averaging 218 for 72 games in the BCML fighting it out with Brad Best for high average who is averaging 216 for 57 games in the league. Chopper also spares as required in other leagues. Dan recently purchased a new bowling ball and it appears that it wasn't made on a Monday or Friday because it looks like the manufacturer has loaded it with a lot of 700's.

Legault having a super year:

Pat Legault wheeled 716 (289 – 74 pins over average – 214-213) in the Friday Night Fun Mixed League (FNFML) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl to register the week's sixth high triple in the LCTA. It was his second consecutive



700 in the FNFML as last week he fired 714 (225-279-210). Legault is having a super year with 7-700's and just 3 behind Mike Shephard, Ben Lapointe and John Armstrong who lead the pack with 10 each. Legault bowls once a week and is averaging 215 after 23 weeks in the league.

Plumb breaks 700 again:



Larry Plumb hurled 710 (197-268-245) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl to record his 6th 700 this season and the seventh high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. It was his second consecutive 700 in the BMNML as last week he rolled 708 (259-234-215). He is averaging 222 after

36 games in the BMNML.

Gark drops to eighth position:



Jeff Gark tossed 704 (258 – 60 pins over average – 220-226 – 108 pins over average for three games) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl to take eighth position in the 700 race this week. The lefty is averaging 203 after 21 games in the

BMNML this year. Gark also spares in the Sunday Morning Classic League and is averaging 208 for 15 games.

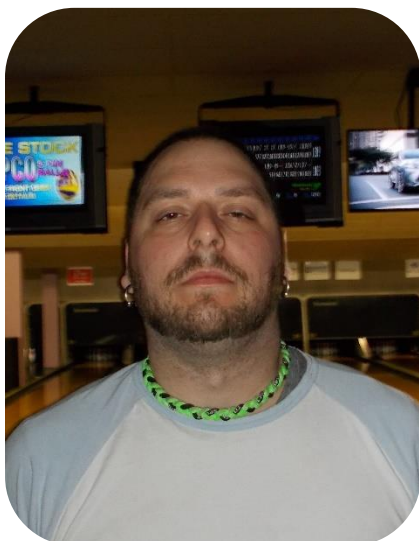
Lapointe ties for season 700 total:

It was also his 10th 700 this season and ties Mike Shephard and

John Armstrong in the season 700 race. His career sanctioned high scores are 787 and 300 (2).

Gauthier takes last 700 spot:



Brandon Gauthier hurled 700 (237-226-237) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl to take the last spot in the high triple department this week in LCTA bowling competition. It was his 5th 700 this year. Gauthier is averaging 211 after 54 games in the BMNML this year.

Thomas is ladies high over average:



Denise Thomas rolled 224 (80 pins over average) in her second game of the night to take the honours for the ladies high over average for a single game in LCTA bowling play this week. She was bowling in the Friday Night Fun Mixed League (FNFML) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl. Denise started bowling in the

Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program at age 16 influenced by her parents who were both bowlers. Her hobbies are baseball and volleyball. 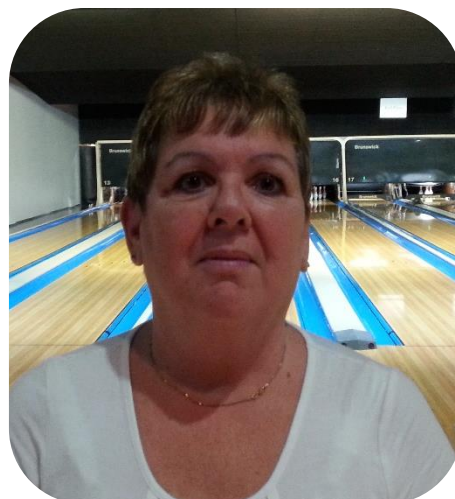
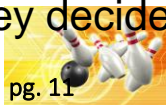
Bruder ties personal high single:

for 17 years minus two Covid years. Like many bowlers, his interest in bowling started with Rock N Roll with friends which led him to a sanctioned bowling league. Besides bowling, his sporting interests are hockey and golf. His hobbies are computers, music and video games. Bruder, a right handed bowler, has a career high triple of 721 and is averaging 205 for 63 games in the SMCL. He bowls with team members Kerry Friis and Steve Lewicki.

Although Denise did not come up through a youth bowling organization, her daughters “Marsha” and “Tina” and grandson “Ryan” did the youth bowling program. When Marsha finished the youth bowling she joined her mother in the Thursday Night Mixed League (TNML) and they have been bowling in the league for the last 30 years. Tina joined the league for one year than found other interests. Her son in law “Adam” joined the league at one point and now her husband has joined the league after his retirement and 35 years away from bowling. Her brother Dan Hartman also bowls in the league while Ryan spares when he is home from the University of Western University. Denise is very active in selling 50/50 tickets for the TNML and also sells to the Border City Men’s League. She said” both leagues have a great bunch of people and each league makes my night when they can laugh and joke with me”. She has gone to several bowling tournaments with friends and family over the years: Battle Creek in 1985, Monroe in 1986, Lansing in 1987 and Wichita Kansas in 1999. Denise and Marsha have been successful in the LCTA doubles tournament. In the 2016-2017 tournament they took first place by 126 pins and in the 2018-2019 they placed second losing by 15 pins. Denise’s career sanctioned high scores are 600 and 230 with many 500 triples. One of her other enjoyments for many years was breeding Shetland sheepdogs (shelties) and taking part in professional dog shows. She retired from this activity in 2020 with many champions under her belt.
