The smooth, high back swing lefty rolled 801 (299 – first game - stubborn 7 pin – 73 pins over average – 245-257 – 132 pins over average for three games). He accomplished the feat in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League at Hi-Way Bowl on lanes 5 & 6. He recorded 30 out of a possible 36 strikes in posting this season's first 800 triple. He has a career 12 – 800's in ABC (American Bowling Congress), USBC (United States Bowling Congress) and CTF (Canadian Tenpin Federation) in tournament and league play.
