

Weekly Highlights

Lapointe notches another 800 series:

Ben Lapointe fired 806 (279 - 54 pins over average - 279 - 54 pins over average - 248 - 131 pins over average for three games) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl to record the high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action. He rolled 28 out of a possible 36 strikes to post his 3rd 800 this season and his career 4th 800 (862-811-800-806). He was using his "IQ Tour Ruby" bowling ball which is slaughtering the pins this year. It was his 27th 700 plus series in the LCTA this season and he now has a



career 107-700's (91 in adult leagues and 16 in youth leagues). Lapointe is holding the LCTA high average this year with 228 for 51 games in the MFFL.



Ridealgh is second best in triple department:



Jamie Ridealgh tossed 793 (279 – 71 pins over average – 268 – 60 pins over average -246 – 169 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl to take second place in the high triple department this past week in the LCTA. It was his 2nd 700 in the LCTA this season as he previously posted 707 (190-238-279). Ridealgh's career high scores are 797 and 300. He is averaging 211 for 60 games in the FTBMNML this year.

Bailey Ettinger rolled 537 (235 – 84 pins over average – 125-177) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl in the LCTA this past week to record her career high scores. Bailey started bowling at age 11 in the Phantom Youth League at Hi-Way Bowl under the leadership of Shirley and Mel Matthews and has been enjoying the fun on the lanes for 18 years. She got interested in bowling when some of her friends invited her out one day to go bowling and enjoyed it so much that she is hooked on the sport. Bailey said "I got a new ball last year and really have been working on my

approach this year. My next goal is have a clean game! I've been very close the last couple months, scoring multiple games over 200, some while practicing and others in league bowling". Her other sporting interests are baseball and volleyball which she enjoys playing. She said her hobbies include baking, baseball,



volleyball, bowling and spending time with her family. Ettinger, a right handed bowler, is on the "Pin Queens" team with fellow team members Jo-Anne VanEkeren and Siobhan McAnulty. She is averaging 152 for 66 games in the MFFL this year while last year in the league she averaged 140 for 81 games.

Best wheels personal high single:



Steve Best wheeled 277 (87 pins over average) in his second game of the night to record his personal highest single game beating his previous 268. He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with a 643 triple. His career high triple is 694. Best is averaging 191 for 57 games in the FTBMNML this year.

Smith has solid night:



Lefty Jay Smith rolled 742 (241-266- 66 pins over average – 235 – 142 pins over average for three games) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl to register the third high triple of the week in LCTA competition. It was his first 700 in the LCTA this season. Smith's career high scores are 799 and 300 (4). Smith is averaging 202 for 72 games in the SPBCML this year bowling on the "Ainsworth Technical" team with Dan Cook, Dan Beauvais, Kevin Lyon and Brad Best.

Kirk Ramsay tossed 712 (253-258-201) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl to register the fifth high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was his 3rd 700 in the LCTA this season as he previously rolled 751-756. Ramsay's career high scores are 756 and 299. Raymond posts week's seventh high series:



Jeff Raymond fired 706 (236-248-222) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl to take seventh place in the 700 race this past week in the LCTA. It was his 2nd 700 this season as he previously rolled 776 (227-359-290) in the BWCL to register his career highest triple. Raymond is averaging 204 for 78 games in the BWCL this year. Last year in the league he averaged 207 for 91 games.

English bowls low 700:

Peter English wheeled 700 (222-213-265 - 66

pins over average) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl to record the low 700 of the week in LCTA bowling competition. It was his first 700 in the LCTA this season. His career high scores are 777 and 300 (4). English is averaging 200 for 69 games bowling on the "GJS Contracting" team with fellow bowlers Chad Kitchen, Brian Long and Doug Brooks. Last year in the league he averaged 193 for 96 games.





Friis rolls ladies top triple:



Jill Friis rolled 690 (202-222-266 – 60 pins over average) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl to register the ladies top triple and share the ladies high single of the week with Dara Sinclair in LCTA bowling action this past week. Jill is in a four way race for high average in the BWCL this year. Jim Lapointe at 220 (69 games) and Ben Lapointe at 220 (54) games are in the lead. They are followed by Roy Mezzatesta at 217 (78 games) and Jill Friis at 217 (42

games). Jill has a career 8-300's one of which was bowled in the 1999 35th addition of the AMF (American Machine and Foundry – now known as Bowlero Corporation) World Cup Tournament which was held in Las Vegas, Nevada. That year Jill was 36 years old carrying a 200 average when she represented Canada bowling against 64 other ladies from 64 different world countries. She was eliminated from the tournament after 40 games averaging 203 and ended up in 12th position. She was voted as the sportswoman of the tournament. Jill's 300 game was only the second perfect game rolled by a woman in the AMF tournament at that time. The first came in 1997, in Cairo, by Shalin Zulkifli of Malaysia. Bowling a 300 in league play is exciting but bowling a perfect game in a world tournament this writer believes is etched in Jill's

memory for life.

Scott is top youth bowler:

Braeden Scott fired 630 (202-256 – 83 pins over average – 172) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl to record the youth's high scores in the LCTA this past week. Scott is averaging 173 after 25 weeks of bowling with team members McKenna Scott



and Cole Sitzes. Last year in the PYL he averaged 183 for 81 games. His career high scores 659 and 287.

Sinclair is high over average:



Dara Sinclair wheeled 266 (96 pins over average) in her second game of the night to be high over average for a single game in the LCTA this past week. She was bowling in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with a 609 triple. She also tied Jill Friis for the ladies high single of the week. Sinclair is averaging 175 for 30 games in the MFFL this year. Last year in the MFFL she averaged 185 for 27 games. Her

career high scores are 781 and 300 (2). Dara was a member of the Canadian Women's Senior team in 2015 when the World Tenpin Bowling Association Senior Scratch Championships (WTBASSC) were held in Las Vegas. In qualifying for the team that year, Dara rolled 18 games in the Canadian Team Trials in Oshawa, competing against 50 other women grabbing the fourth and final spot on the final game of the final day of competition. In the WTBASSC she bowled 18 games averaging 175 on extremely difficult lane conditions ending the tournament in 40th position out of 89 bowlers. The top Canadian lady bowler in the tournament averaged 188 for 18 games ending up in 16th position.

Apter fires ladies second high single:

Makayla Apter fired 265 (88 pins over average) in her last game of the night to post the ladies second high single of the week in the LCTA. She was bonding with her friends in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with 647 (164-218-265) which was good for the ladies second high triple of the week. Makayla is averaging





178 for 78 games in the MFFL this year. Last year she finished with a 173 average for 84 games in the MFFL. Her career high scores are 650 and 267.
