Weekly Highlights

Shephard and Lapointe remain tied:

Mike Shephard and Ben Lapointe are fighting it out to the last week of the bowling season to see who will be the Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) "King of the Lanes" for the 2024-2025 bowling season. Both bowlers rolled a 700 this past week to remain tied at 27-700's for the season and both have one week left in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML).



Shephard hurled 728 (236-203-289 – 66 pins over average) in the FTBMNML on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl, to post the high triple of the week in the LCTA. Mike is averaging 224 for 93 games in the FTBMNML league this season. Last season in the league he averaged 214 for 96 games.

Lapointe fired 710 (264 – 44 pins over average – 232-214) in the FTBMNML on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl, to register the 3rd high triple of the week in LCTA bowling competition. Ben is averaging 221 for 90 games in the FTBMNML this year. Last year in the league he averaged 218 for 93 games.



Cook 100 pins over average with top single:

Lefty Dan Cook rolled the first eleven strikes in his first game of the night. On his last delivery, he set himself on the approach, took a deep breath and set the ball free from his hand, only to come light on the head pin leaving the 3-5-6 pins. He finished with a 297 which was 107 pins over his average



and the high single of the week in the LCTA. He was bowling in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl finishing with 708 (297-181-230) which was good for the 4th high triple of the week. It was his second 700 of the season as he previously bowled 728 (225-268-235) in the SPBCML back in February. Cook bowled in two leagues this year. He finished with a 193 average for 96 games in the Best Wiring Classic League and 194 for 96 games in the SPBCML. His career sanctioned high scores are 300-2 and 802 which he bowled in Windsor in 2009.

Grasser beats his high triple:



Rio Grasser wheeled 494 (146 - 168 – 46 pins over average -180 – 58 pins over average – 128 pins over average for three games) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl, to beat his previous high triple of 459 (163-168-128) which he rolled this year in the PYL back in February. His career high single is 214. Rio is averaging 122 after 32 weeks in the PYL this year. Last year in the league he averaged 108 for 90

games.

Wright records new high single:



Greg Wright rolled 203 (58 pins over average) to record a personal new high single topping his previous 201. He was bowling as a spare in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League at Marcin Bowl. Wright's high triple is 528 (201-150-177) which he bowled in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) this season. Greg is averaging 130 for 69 games in the MFFL this year. Last year in the league he averaged 116 for 66 games.

Plumb finishes strong in classic league:



Larry Plumb hurled 723 (276 – 61 pins over average – 170 – 277 – 62 pins over average) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl, to finish his season with the 2nd high triple of the week in LCTA bowling competition. It was his 5th 700 of the season as he previously bowled 773, 708, 714 and 764. Plumb finished the year in the BWCL with a 215 average for 99 games. Last year in the league he averaged 215 for 96 games.



Armstrong good for fifth position:



John Armstrong tossed 707 (226-228-253) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl to register the 5th high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. It was his 13th 700 in the LCTA this season as he previously bowled 752, 753, 744, 728, 701, 743, 717, 724, 748, 728, 715 and 784. Armstrong finished with a 221 average for 33 games in the SPBCML this year. He also finished the year with a 216 average for 90 games in the Best Wiring Classic League and 233 for 12 games in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League.

Chipman has solid year:



Shane Chipman fired 704 (234-234-236) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl, to record the 6th high triple of the week and his 11th 700 in the LCTA this season. Shane finished with a 214 average for 93 games in the BWCL this year. Last year in the league he averaged 207 for 93 games. He also participated in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) and the Mulder Financial Fun League this year. Chipman had 2-300's in the LCTA this

season.

Parkkila comes in last:



Kole Parkkila hurled 703 (213-244-246) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl to come in last place in the high triple department this past week in the LCTA. Parkkila had a strong season finishing with 11- 700's. He previously bowled 717, 750, 751, 720, 767, 819, 788, 711, 717 and 706. It was also his career 16th 700 in the LCTA. Kole finished with a 204 average for 69 games in the SPBCML this season.



Friis good for the ladies top triple:



Jill Friis rolled 683 (258 – 61 pins over average – 226-199) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) as a spare on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling action, to register the ladies high triple of the week. Jill finished with a 198 average for 57 games in the BWCL this season. Last season in the league she averaged 216 for 54 games which was good for the ladies high average in the Canadian Tenpin Federation all across Canada.

Baldwin ties her high single:



Catherine Baldwin tossed 206 (66 pins over average) in her first game of the night to tie her career high single. She was bowling in the Bar10 Thursday Night Mixed League on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with a 504 (206-143-155) triple. Her career high triple is 507 (192-149-166) which she bowled in the league this season. Catharine finished the year with 140 average. Last year in the league she averaged 140 for 87 games.
