Sinclair leads the way:

Neil Sinclair tossed 788 (265-258-265 – 188 pins over average for three games) on lanes 7 & 8 at Hi-Way Bowl to lead the way in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action this past week. Neil started bowling 10-pin in the newly opened Hi-Way Bowl in 1962 and also Nico Bowl which later became Lake Huron Lanes. He bowled in the YBC (Youth Bowl Canada) at Hi-Way Bowl from 1963-1967 and has been knocking down the pins for 57 years. He has 11-300's and 1-800 (811) to his credit recorded in league and tournament play in the defunct ABC (American Bowling Congress), the USBC (United States Bowling Congress) and the CTF (Canadian Tenpin Federation). Neil has some very



admirable moments in his bowling life. He was the Canadian Youth Champion in 1967, represented Ontario at the 1980 US Open and the 2010 Senior Championship in Reno, Nevada. One of his proudest moments was when he bowled on Team Canada at the 2004 Tournament of Americas in Miami, Florida. Neil has been a continuous participant in the ABC/USBC Open Championship pretty much most of his life. This is a prestigious 10-pin tournament held every bowling season running for 5 months (February – June) on very



difficult lane conditions. The first tournament was held in 1901 when 6 lanes were installed at the Welsback Building in downtown Chicago. The tournament lasted only 4 days with 41 teams taking part with a total prize fund of \$1592.00. Today's prize fund exceeds 5 million dollars. The tournament has been spread around in the USA to dictate that bowlers' criss-cross from Billings Montana to Tampa Florida to Syracuse New York to Corpus Christi Texas. This year Neil will be bowling in his 49th ABC/USBC Championship in Las Vegas. He is getting excited about the tournament in 2020 at Reno because that will be incredibly his 50th appearance at the tournament. This is quite the achievement because as of 2018, only 239 people have achieved this milestone in a tournament that has on average of 50,000 – 70,000 participants each year. Neil said "I have greatly enjoyed bowling in these tournaments as they have allowed me to see a vast majority of the USA that I might not have a chance to see otherwise".

Adamson takes second place:



Kyle Adamson fired 752 (226-258-268 – 70 pins over average – 158 pins over average for three games) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League at Marcin Bowl to take the week's second high triple in LCTA bowling action. In the last eight years starting in the 2011-2012 season Kyle's final averages in the league were 215-211-214-219-221-218-216-and 211. This year he is struggling a bit due to illness and injuries averaging 201 after 54 games. The right handed bowler has some career impressive scores - 6-800's and 7-300's.

Chipman rolls top single:



Shane Chipman rolled eleven consecutive strikes but on his last delivery he came high on the Brooklyn side leaving the 3-6 pins ending with a 298 – 94 pins over average to post the LCTA high single of the week. He was bowling on lanes 25 & 26 in his second game in the Thursday Night Men's League (TNML) at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with 665. Shane had one year in a youth bowling program at Northgate Bowl but started some serious bowling at age 19. He has been bowling for 23 years in different leagues. He has 1-300 (Marcin Border City

Men's League – Jan. 5th, 2012) and his highest triple is 783. He is bowling in two leagues this year (current average/ games in brackets): TNML (205 – 63 games) and the Marcin Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (193 – 54 games).

Bestard wheels solid series:



Jacob Bestard wheeled 628 (191-199-238 – 65 pins over average – 108 pins over average for three games) in the Youth Intermediate Division at Marcin Bowl to post a solid series in LCTA bowling action this week. Jacob raised his average to 175 after 60 games.
