Creasor rolls top triple:



Jim Creasor rolled 756 (278-255-223) on lanes 31 & 32 in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) at Marcin Bowl to record the high triple in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action this past week. Last week Jim registered his 49th and 50th HONOUR scores (807-300). It was brought to this writer's attention these award scores were his first after recently turning 50 years old. He is having a super year in the BMNML averaging 229 after 54 games with his closest rival being Stephane Sirois at 222.

Willemsen takes second place:

Corey Willemsen tossed 750 (290- 79 pins over average - 236-224) on lanes 17 & 18 in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) at Marcin Bowl to take ownership of the second high triple in the LCTA this past week. Corey posted the first 300 in the LCTA this season on September 30th giving him a career 2-300's. He is a graduate of the Hi-Way Bowl Youth Phantoms and Rebels Bowling Program which he



started at age six and has been enjoying the great sport for thirty-seven years. He is averaging 211 after 54 games in the BMNML.

Bennett hangs on to third position:



Bill Bennett fired 737 (264-237-236 – 146 pins over average for three games) in the Sunday Morning Men’s League at Marcin Bowl to take the honours for the third high triple in LCTA bowling this past week. Bill started 5-pin bowling at age 4 in the Youth Bowling Canada (YBC) and remained there for 12 years. He switched to 10-pin at age 16 out of Starlite Lanes in Wallaceburg and has been enjoying the sport for 22 years. His career highest sanctioned scores are 279 and 748. He is currently averaging 200 after 54 games. Two of his

most memorable moments in bowling were winning the 1993 Provincial YBC Family Twosome Tournament with his 66 year old grandfather “Alvin Bennett” and bowling 100 games of 5-pin in a 24 hour period.

Pair share fourth spot:



Ralph MacDuff rolled 736 (267-239-230 – 133 pins over average for three games) on lanes 31 & 32 in the Sunday Morning Men’s League (SMML) at Marcin Bowl to share the week’s fourth high triple in LCTA bowling action. The lefty’s averages in the SMML for the last nine years starting in the 2010-2011 season and working upward were 213, 221, 213, 218, 211, 212, 208, 208 and 215. This year he is averaging 204 after 54 games. MacDuff has 5-300’s (sanctioned) to

his credit.

Glenn Crowe wheeled 736 (226-233-277- 65 pins over average) on lanes 27 & 28 in the Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (BMNML) to share the week’s fourth high triple. His averages in



the BMNML for the last eight years starting in the 2011-2012 season and working upward were 187 – 198 - 203 – 198 – 201 – 195 – 207 and 206. This year he is averaging 212 after 54 games. He has 2-300's (sanctioned) to his credit.

Team “Gutter Gang” members Dylon McKinnon, Kris Mandeville, Connor Smith, Owen Allison, Will Finley and Josh Kelly are having a lot of fun in the Thursday Night Men’s League (TNML) at Marcin Bowl. This is their first year in the league and they won the first half and now are leading the second half. Kris Mandeville and Connor Smith had a super night this past week.

Kris Mandeville tossed 654 (184-237 – 86 pins over average – 233 – 82 pins over average – 201 pins over average for three games) on lanes 25 & 26 in the TNML at Marcin Bowl. Kris took part in the youth bowling program at the defunct Lake Huron Lanes from ages 7-10 then transitioned to travel hockey. He started playing recreational bowling once again at age 18 going out with some friends once a month to hammer the pins. This year he decided to join a league with some close friends to bring some competition to the league.



Kris originally got involved with bowling with his dad “Dan” who was heavily involved in the game at the time and now always takes the time to see how Kris’ game is progressing in the TNML. Mandeville says his most memorable moments in bowling so far are: bowling his highest triple last night (a culmination of several months of practice) and joining the TNML in September because that is the day of the week that he really looks forward to most. He is a once a week bowler. His highest single game is 258 and he is currently averaging 155 after 51 games.



Connor Smith fired 590 (170-213-207 – 161 pins over average) on lanes 25 & 26 in the TNML at Marcin Bowl. Smith did not come up through a youth bowling program and started league bowling this year with his close friends. The twenty-six year old causally bowled with friends once a year through the 19-25 years of his life. This year he was looking into a winter sport and became interested when one of his friends was looking at putting a team together to do some league bowling. He is a once a week bowler presently averaging 146 after 57 games with personal high scores of 590 and single game 268. His most memorable moment in bowling was one night he was fun bowling with friends and he had the first 8 strikes in a row with all the hooping and hollowing from his friends cheering him on. His summer activities include lacrosse (playing and coaching), two pitch softball and following that little white ball on the golf course.



Scott rolls career highest triple:



Braeden Scott rolled 621 (177 - 223 – 64 pins over average – 221 – 62 pins over average – 141 pins over average for three games) in the Youth Junior Division at Marcin Bowl to register his career highest triple and his first 600 series. He has been on fire this bowling season raising his personal best triple three times from 561 to 565 to 621. His personal highest single game is 244.
