Weekly Highlights

Sinclair perfect in Michigan Tournament:



Congratulations to Dara Sinclair, Association Manager of the Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA), for bowling a perfect game in the Jo-Anne Lapish Memorial Mixed Doubles Tournament (JLMMDT) held at the Strikers Entertainment Center in Richmond, Michigan. It was her career 3rd 300, the other two coming in Port Huron league action. Dara also rolled a 299 this season at the Michigan State Women's Tournament in Muskegon when the stubborn 10 pin refused to fall. Dara said she had a rough start in JLMMDT rolling 142 in her first game as she couldn't get lined up properly on the

lanes. But once she found her line, she came back strong with the 300 and 202 for a 644 triple. Dara bowled with partner Kerry Friis. In the past, Dara and her husband Neil Sinclair have won this tournament twice and came in second once. Other Canadians participating in the tournament were Roni Shephard, Annette Thompson, Jill Friis, Mike Shephard and Neil Sinclair. Joanne Lapish Downs was one of the premier bowlers in the Port Huron local area history. She died in the 1987 crash of flight 255 at Detroit Metropolitan Airport. The tournament is dedicated to her memory for her contribution to bowling both as a participant and a youth coach. She was inducted into the Port Huron Hall of Fame on November 16, 1991.

Tony Spano Memorial Tournament:

The LCTA Tony Spano Memorial Youth Scholarship Tournament was held over a two-week period (Jan.12-25). The tournament is dedicated to Tony who ran the tournament for many



years, and for his past success on the lanes with his scores and smiling face, and his past continued hard work off the lanes that he did for the betterment of the sport. Bowlers that entered the tournament competed against each other in different leagues. The competition was a handicap tournament with a \$5 entry fee (3.00 to prize fund, \$2.00 to youth scholarship fund) and the bowlers used their scores for that night. Bowlers could enter every league they participated in every week for a two-week period. There was a men’s division and a ladies division.

The Men’s Division had 241 entries. The following bowlers had 700 scratch triples: Mike Marciniszyn 765, Mike Shephard 762, Shane Chipman 748, Chris Murphy 718, Kyle Adamson 715, Paul Mezzatesta 711, Roy Mezzatesta 711, Jim Lapointe 710, Ben Lapointe 708 and John Armstrong 701. The men’s division winner was Dan McMahon.



The Ladies Division had 59 entries. The following bowlers had 550 and over scratch triples:

Dara Sinclair 647, Kelly Sitter 618-557, Roni Shephard 578-563-563, Michelle Fraser 571, Taelor Koundakjian 560, Lisa Lapointe 555 and Sharon Lewicki 550. The ladies division winner was Taelor Koundakjian.

Marciniszyn grabs top spot:



Mike Marciniszyn rolled 744 (231-257-256) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl to record the high triple of the week in LCTA bowling competition. It was his 5th 700 of the season as he previously bowled 709, 788, 714 and 765. Mike is averaging 224 for 63 games in the BWCL this season. Last year in the league he averaged 213 for 99 games.

Ingles fires new high three:

Zachary Ingles fired 676 (239 – 71 pins over average – 218 – 50 pins over average – 219 – 51 pins over average – 172 pins over average for three games) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl, to register a new personal high triple. His previous high triple was 608 (215-209-184) and his high single is 245 which he bowled in the Mulder Financial Fun League this season. Zachary is averaging 168 after 21 weeks in the PYL this season bowling with teammates Logan Hannah and Joe Windover. Last year in the league he averaged 155 for 88 games.



Grasser bowls new high triple:



Rio Grasser bowled 459 (163 – 47 pins over average – 168 – 52 pins over average – 128 – 111 pins over average for three games) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl, to record a new personal high triple beating his previous 395. His career high single is 214 which he rolled in the youth singles tournament at Classic Bowl in Mississauga. Rio, a right-handed bowler, started sanctioned league bowling in the 2022-2023 season at age 9 in the PYL and finished with an 80 average for 39 games. He got interested in 10 pin bowling because his cousin Daniel Wright was bowling, and he wanted to give it a try. This is his third year on the lanes, and he is bowling with teammates Daniel Wright and Kiam O’Keefe. Rio’s other sporting interests are baseball (he plays for the Camlachie Cougars), biking and kayaking. His hobbies include making pinatas for his family



birthday parties, video games and fishing. He is averaging 116 after 21 weeks in the PYL this year. Last year in the league he averaged 108 for 90 games.

Gray records new high scores:



Collin Gray wheeled 450 (98-166 – 44 pins over average – 186 – 64 pins over average) to record new personal high scores, topping his previous high scores of 407 and 180. Collin was bowling in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl. He is averaging 122 after 21 weeks in the PYL this year bowling with teammates Maxx Langford and Jaxon Hillman-Frank. Last year in the league he averaged 117 for 45 games. Collin started sanctioned league bowling in the 2019-2020 season at age 8 in the Phantom Junior Bowling Program at Hi-Way Bowl finishing the year with a 62 average for 45 games. He originally got interested in bowling at age

6 when his mom used to take him and his sister 5-pin bowling all the time. Two years later he switched to 10-pin and the rest is history.

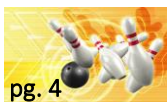
Laframboise posts new high single:
