



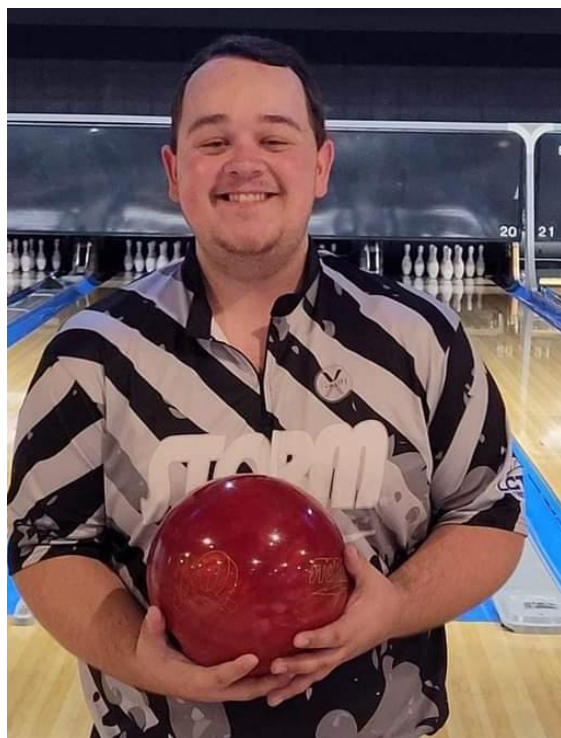

Weekly Highlights

Lapointe wins Turbo Cup Series tournament:



Congratulations goes to Sarnia bowler Ben Lapointe for his victory in the Metro Detroit Men's Turbo Cup Series event held at Spins Bowl in Canton Michigan on Sunday November 12. The tournament is one of several held in the Turbo Cup series in several bowling establishments in Michigan throughout the bowling season. Lapointe put on quite the show bowling 8 games and averaging 237. His scratch games were 246-240-249-198 for 933 which was good for 4th position in the qualifying round. His match play elimination scratch games were 256-247-

191-269. The top qualifier was Canton resident Dylan Jablonski, a college bowler for Concordia University, with 1047 (277-299-267-204). Seventy-three participants took part in the tournament with a generous cut line of 20 bowlers (20 paying spots) and a cut line score of 851. Bowlers from Michigan,

Indiana, Ohio and Ontario (Lapointe, Darren Alexander (Essex) and Kurt Ridgewell (Windsor) made up the field. Alexander tossed 908 (218- 237-205-248) to qualify 8th and Ridgewell did not make the cut. In the first match play elimination round Lapointe defeated Johnathon Dean of Casco Michigan 256-201. In the second match play game, Lapointe eliminated Tom Reynolds from Ypsilanti Michigan 247-230. In the third match play game, Lapointe ousted Darren Alexander 191-143 to advance to the final game. If you read the Lambton County Tenpin Association bowling reports, you will recall Alexander won the Players Tour Tournament held at Marcin Bowl on October 28th. In his final game, Lapointe tossed a ton of strikes defeating Matthew Bederka from Romulus Michigan 269-213 to win the tournament and \$500.00. This writer imagines Lapointe's trip back to Sarnia was very enjoyable.

Lewicki notches first 700 this season:



Steve Lewicki has been off to a slow start this year in the Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) but he finally hit this year's 700 club. The lefty rolled 717 (183 – 267 - 72 pins over average- 267 -72 pins over average) on lanes 13 & 14 in the Best Wiring Classic League on Sunday morning at Marcin Bowl to record the top triple in LCTA bowling competition this past week. He is averaging 200 for 30 games in the
