## **Creasor tops 800 again with perfect game:**

Jim Creasor added two more HONOUR scores to his amazing bowling accomplishments. He fired 807 (300 - 74 pins over average - 259-248 - 129 pins over average for three games) on lanes 29 & 30 in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) at Marcin Bowl in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action this past week. He had 28 out of a possible 36 strikes. He took the ownership of the high triple of the week and shared the week's high single with Brandon Gauthier. His two HONOUR scores give him a total of 50 HONOUR scores

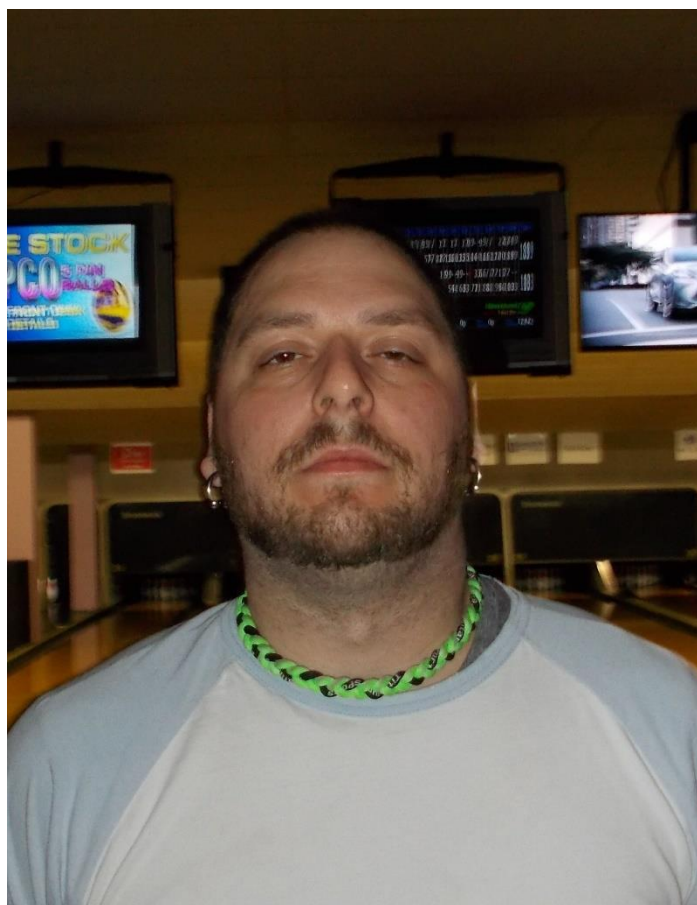


(24-300's and 26-800's – that this writer is aware of - in Canadian/ American league and



tournament action. Sixteen of his 800's have been recorded in the Canadian Tenpin Federation and the other 10 in American Bowling Associations. Three of his most memorable 800's are the 2008 Ontario Tenpin Bowling Association Provincial Tournament in St. Catharines where he fired back to back 300's and 269 to end up with a super 869 triple. The Canadian Tenpin Federation record is held by Bill Kirton (889). He also tied the Port Huron Tenpin Bowling Association triple record (868) in 2017 and established a new LCTA triple record (876) in 2015. Rolling an 800 triple is an extremely difficult achievement even for the best of competitive bowlers. A very small percentage experience the excitement of accomplishing the feat. Jim is currently averaging 229 after 51 games in the BMNML. Closest averages to him in the league are Mike Shephard 222.9 and Stephane Sirois 222.6

### **Gauthier also perfect:**



Brandon Gauthier hurled 736 (300 - 87 pins over average – 253) on lanes 21 & 22 in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) to register his career 6th perfect game and tie Jim Creasor for the week's high single. Brandon started bowling at age 8 coming up through the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program under the watchful eyes of Gil and Carol Jean. He got interested in 10-pin bowling thanks to his uncle. The right handed bowler also has one non sanctioned 300, 1-299 and 1-800 (803) to his credit. Brandon is only bowling in one league this year and spares in other leagues as required. He is averaging 215 after 39 games in the BMNML. Last year in the BMNML he finished with a 211 average for 84

games and a 202 average for 84 games in the Marcin Thursday Night Men's League.

**Bestard is top youth bowler:**

Jacob Bestard fired 672 (236-215-221) in the Intermediate Division in the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program (MBYBP) to post the youth high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. In November 2019, Jacob tossed 700 (201-220-279) in the Youth Doubles Tournament to record his career first 700 series. His personal highest single game is 279. Jacob has come a long way in developing his bowling skills in the MBYBP. He has gone from a 98 average (2010-2011 season) to this year's average of 198 after 48 games.
