



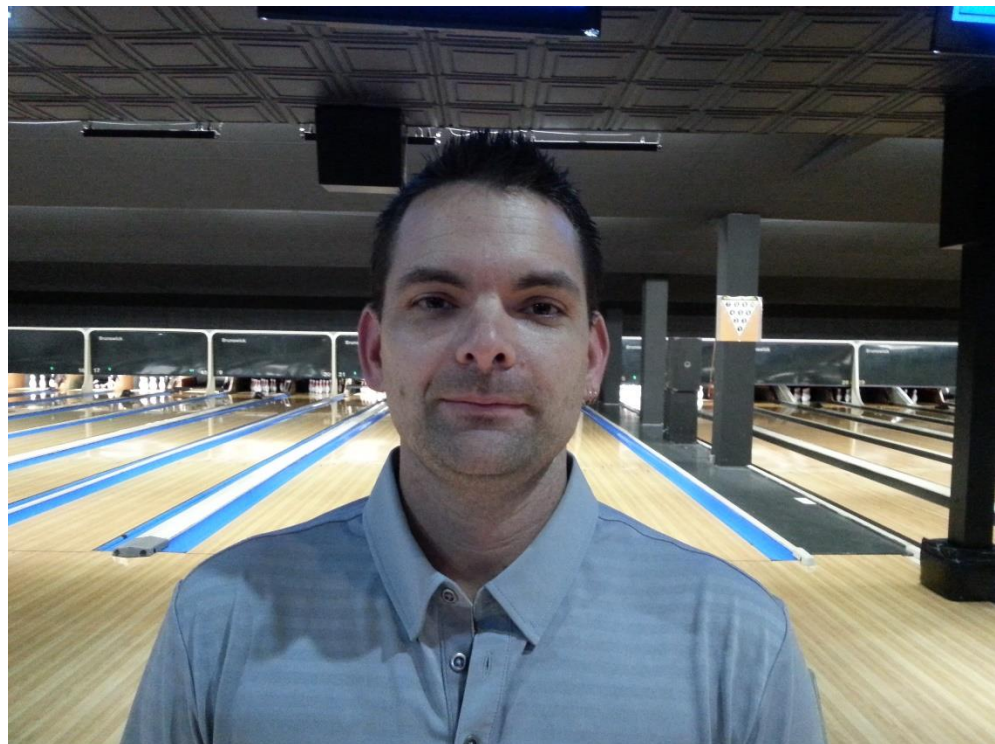

Pinel rolls top scores:

Adam Pinel rolled eleven consecutive strikes only to be beaten by an unrepentful 7-pin in route to a 299 and the high single in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action this past week. He also posted the



high triple in this week's LCTA play with 742 (299 - 114 pins over average - 218- 225 - 187 pins over average for three games). He was participating in the Thursday Night Mixed League (TNML) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl. Adam did not come up through a youth bowling program but in his preteen years he bowled a couple seasons of 5-pin at Northgate Bowl. He joined the TNML in the 1999-2000 season as a spare and has been there ever since. His previous high single was 289 when he left



the 6-pin on his 11th ball. The smooth left handed bowler has a personal high triple of 769.

Mezzatesta hurls personal best triple:

Paul Mezzatesta hurled 738 (219-255-264 – 71 pins over average – 159 pins over average for three games) on lanes 25 & 26 in the Border City Men's League (BCML) at Marcin Bowl to record his career personal best triple and take the honours for the week's second high triple. Paul started bowling at age 10 coming up through the defunct Echo Lanes youth bowling program. His personal



best single is 290. Paul started bowling in the BCML six years ago and has been carrying a consistent average. His averages from last year and the previous years were 206, 203, 205, 200, 201 and 191.

Ladenchuk takes third spot:

Rob Ladenchuk fired 728 (277- 87 pins over average -236 – 158 pins over average for three games) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) at Marcin Bowl to record the third high triple this past week. Rob started bowling at age 9 coming up through the youth bowling program at Marcin Bowl. He has 1-300 to his credit and his highest triple is 781. He has four most memorable moments in bowling: bowling in the TV finals 2 years



ago in the Windsor Rose Bowl Molson Masters Tournament placing 2nd in the final game, bowling a perfect game, bowling his perfect game before Nathan Gonzalez and being part of the Marcin Sunday Morning Men's League champions in the 2016-



2017 season. Rob finished with a 201 average last year in the BMNML but is just sparing this year being on the roster of the True Colours Tattoo team in the BMNML.
