## Weekly Highlights

### Lapointe Junior catches Shephard in crown race:

Ben Lapointe fired 762 (280 – 53 pins over average – 240-242) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl to register the high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) competition. He also rolled 724 (243-236-245) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Me’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl to record the 3<sup>rd</sup> high triple of the week. They were his 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> 700 this season which ties him with Mike Shephard in the season’s 700 crown race. He now has a career 138 700’s. Lapointe is now averaging 228 for 66 games in the BWCL and 226 for 63 games in the FTBMNML this season.



### Hunter rolls new high triple:

Chad Hunter rolled 636 (213- 40 pins over average – 213 – 40 pins over average – 210 – 37 pins over average – 117 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl to top his previous high 605 triple. His career high single is 257 which he bowled in the FTBMNML in September of this season. Hunter is now averaging 175 for 60 games bowling on the “Fabbri Tile”

## *Meredith tops his career high triple:*



Chris Meredith tossed 580 (215 – 53 pins over average – 181-184) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML), on lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl to post a new high triple beating his previous 565. His career high single is 234. Meredith is now averaging 164 for 63 games in the FTBMNML bowling on the “Mr. Chip” team with teammates Jason Fox, Jamie Barron and Joe Smythe. Last year in the league he averaged 158 for 96 games.

Her previous high triple was 537 (235-125-177) which she bowled in the MFFL last season, and her high single is 235. Bailey started bowling at age 11 in the Phantom Youth League at Hi-Way Bowl under the leadership of Shirley and Mel Matthews and has been enjoying the fun on the lanes for 19 years. She is averaging 150 for 63 games in the MFFL this year. Last year in the league she averaged 150 for 84 games.



Wright tops his high single:



Daniel Wright fired 259 (82 pins over average) in his last game of the night to record a new personal high single. He was bowling in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) as a spare on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with a 618 triple. Wright's previous sanctioned high single was 251 which he bowled in the Joyce Woolgar Memorial Family Twosome Tournament last year at Classic Bowl in Mississauga. His career high triple is 630 (225-211-194) which he bowled in the MFFL this season. Daniel is averaging 179 for 33 games in the MFFL this season.

Ridealgh hurled 722 (245-268 – 59 pins over average – 209) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 29 & 30 and 715 (258 – 52 pins over average – 182 - 275 – 69 pins over average) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 33 & 34 both at Marcin Bowl to record the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> high triples of the week in LCTA bowling action. Jason Lapointe tossed 709 (257-238-214) in the Bar10 Thursday Night Mixed League (B10TNML) on lanes 21 & 22, and 707 (290 – 74 pins over average – 205-212) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) as a spare on lanes 17 & 18 both at Marcin Bowl, to record the two low 700's of the week in the LCTA. They were his 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> 700's of the season as he previously bowled 751,737,715,711,740,715 and 707. 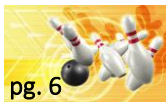
### Shephard grabs ladies top single:
