Weekly Highlights

Croskery is perfect again:

Jordan Croskery fired the first eleven strikes with a Brooklyn hit in the third frame and the next eight with solid pocket hits in his second game of the day. On his last delivery, he crossed over to the right handers Brooklyn side again and finished the game with another strike to roll another perfect game to take the honours for the high single of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action. It was his 2nd perfect game this season and the 4th in the LCTA this year. He was bowling in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) at Hi-Way Bowl on lanes 7 & 8 finishing with 739 (187-300 - 88 pins over average- 252) which was good for the third high triple of the week. He recorded his other 300 this year in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League. Croskery now has a career



sanctioned 8-300's to his credit. He is averaging 212 for 57 games in the SMCL this year.

Winder is top bowler

Rob Winder Jr. rolled 781 (279 – 80 pins over average – 257-245 – 184 pins over average for three games) on lanes 9 & 10 in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) at Hi-Way Bowl to post the high triple of the week in LCTA bowling competition. Winder walked off the lanes with his career highest triple. Winder is averaging 201 for 66 games this season in the SMCL.

Schofield to be inducted into Hall of Fame:

Kevin Schofield has been selected to become a distinguished member of the World Police and Fire Games (WPFG) Hall of Fame. The WPFG are an Olympic style competition with around 10,000 athletes representing active and



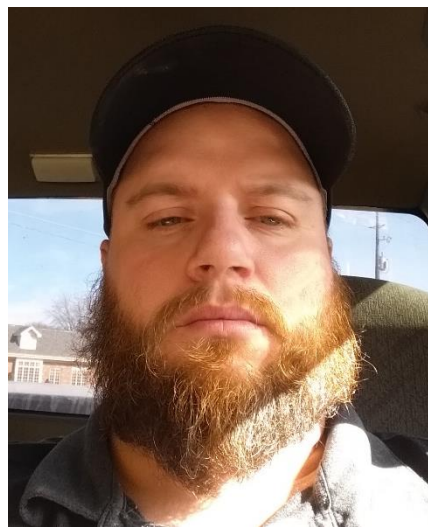
retired law enforcement, firefighters, corrections services and border protection from 70+ countries across the world competing in 60+ sports including 10-pin bowling. Schofield's record of achievement and support of the 10-pin bowling games made the Board's decision a unanimous selection. Kevin has displayed his



bowling skills in these tournaments with an impressive show case of 11 gold, 7 silver and 5 bronze medals. The WPFGB are held every two years in different countries. These games have taken place in Canada (Quebec City/Vancouver), the USA (Indianapolis/Fairfax Virginia/New York City/Los Angeles), Barcelona Spain, Australia, Belfast Ireland, Stockholm Sweden and Chengdu China. This year, the WPFGB are being held in July in Rotterdam, Holland with an induction ceremony at the opening of the games. Schofield said “this is very exciting news for me and I am still trying to process it in my mind”. The LCTA and our members congratulate Kevin on his induction into the WPFGB Hall of Fame and we wish him and his wife a safe vacation and huge success on the lanes in Rotterdam.

Armstrong takes second spot:

John Armstrong tossed 743 (238-226-279 - 76 pins over average -134 pins over average for three games) on lanes 9 & 10 in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) at Hi-Way Bowl to register the second high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. Adamson holds down last spot:

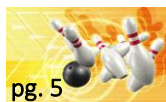

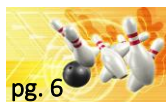
Honourable Mention:
