Weekly Highlights

Ridealgh walks off the lanes with 300:

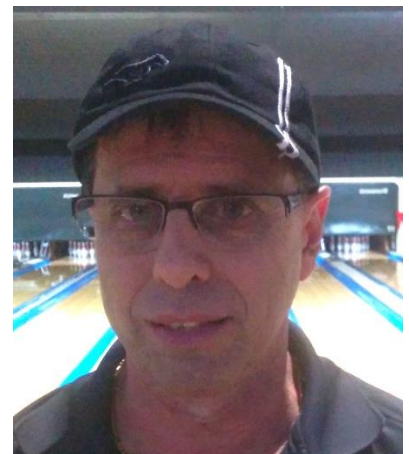


Jamie Ridealgh fired twelve consecutive strikes in his second game of the night to record a perfect game and the high single of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action. He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl ending the night with a 729 (204-300 – 92 pins over average – 225) triple which was good for the 4th high triple of the week. It was his career 2nd 300 game and the 3rd 700 in the LCTA this season, the other two being posted by Jim Lapointe and

Shane Chipman. Ridealgh recorded his first 300 on January 21, 2018. Jamie also entered this year’s 700 club with his first 700 of the season. Last season he tossed 3-700’s. He is averaging 214 for 18 games in the FTBMNML this year. Last year in the league he averaged 213 for 75 games.

Mezzatesta is short one pin:

Paul Mezzatesta hurled 799 (266 – 60 pins over average – 267 – 61 pins over average – 266 – 60 pins over average – 181 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) coming up short by one pin from entering the exclusive 800 club. He was bowling as a spare on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl to record a new



personal high triple and take the honours for the high triple of the week in LCTA bowling competition. Mezzatesta had a powerful night on the lanes playing between the five and ten board with a lot of speed rolling 28 out of a possible 36 strikes to record his first 700 this season. Mezzatesta had 1-700 in the 2022- 2023 season and 1-700 in the 2023-2024 season. His previous high triple was 775 (269-258-248) which he also bowled in the FTBMNML last season. Paul's personal sanctioned high single is 290. Mezzatesta is averaging 212 for 30 games in the FTBMNML this year. He also bowls full time in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League this season and is averaging 204 for 30 games. Paul started bowling at age 10 coming up through the defunct Echo Lanes youth bowling program.

Parkkila tops his high single:



Cam Parkkila wheeled 268 (86 pins over average) in his second game of the night in LCTA bowling play to top his previous high single of 266. He was participating in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with a 614 triple. Parkkila's career high triple is 673. Cameron started bowling 10 pin when he was six years old but the following two years, he wanted to give 5 pin bowling a chance. However, he returned to the 10 pin lanes and has been challenging his twin brother Kole on the score sheet every week. Cameron bowls on the FTBMNML team "Parkkila Plus Bryce" with team members Kole Parkkila, Justin Parkkila and Bryce Watson. Cameron is averaging 184 for 27 games in the FTBMNML this year. Last year he finished with an average of 186 for 90 games in the Mulder Financial Fun League.

Visser posts personal high single:

Paul Visser rolled 255 (96 pins over average) in his third game of the night to establish a new personal high single game. He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl finishing with a 550 triple. Visser wasn't sure of his highest old single but was sure 255 was his best game. He also wasn't sure about his highest triple. Paul did not come up through a sanctioned organized youth league, but started bowling at age 22, on the encouragement of a friend and he has been bowling for 10 years. His first 8 years on the lanes were not in



sanctioned leagues. Last year, Visser, a right-handed bowler, participated in the Mulder Financial Fun League and finished the year with a 151 average for 90 games. This year in the FTBMNML he is averaging 162 for 30 games bowling with team members Zac Visser, Rick Jatel and William Laframboise. Paul's other sporting interest is golf. His hobby is belonging to the Sarnia Street Cruisers with his 1969 Chevelle.

Ingles records new high single:

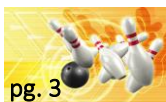


Zachary Ingles tossed 245 (68 pins over average) in his second game of the night to record a new personal high single topping his previous 232. He was bowling as a spare in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling action finishing the night with a 574 triple. Zachary's career high triple is 608 (215-209-184) which he tossed in the Marcin Youth League (MYL) this season. Zachary started bowling at age five, in the 2013 – 2014 season in the Hi-Way Bowl Phantom Youth Bowling Program in the Bumpers Division, ending the year with a 50 average for 75 games. He is in his 12th year of enjoying the great sport of 10-pin bowling. Zachary is averaging 181 for 12 games in the MFFL this season. When this writer highlighted Zachary back in the 2019-2020 season, Zachary was also very interested in playing basketball and enjoyed drawing and painting. Hopefully he has continued to enjoy these great pass times.

Lapointe grabs second position:



Ben Lapointe rolled 755 (256 – 278 – 60 pins over average – 221) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl to record the second highest triple of the week in LCTA bowling competition. It was his 12th 700 of the season and his career 126th 700. Lapointe trails Mike Shephard by 2-700's in the race for the King of the Lanes Crown this season. Ben is averaging 221 for 30 games in the FTBMNML this year. Last year in the league, he averaged 218 for 93 games.



Smith enters 700 club:

Lefty Jay Smith wheeled 752 (238-236-278 – 83 pins over average – 167 pins over average for three games) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling action to record his first 700 of this season. Last season Smith had 2-700's. His triple was good for the 3rd high triple of the week. Jay is averaging 200 for 33 games in the SPBCML this season bowling on the "Britney Spares" team with Chris Murphy, Brad Best and Brandon Gauthier. Last season in the league he averaged 201 for 87 games. Jay also bowls in the Best Wiring Classic League averaging 191 for 30 games with team members Dan Cook and Roy Mezzatesta. His career high scores are 799 and 300 (4).

Raymond is good for fifth place:

Jeff Raymond fired 714 (248-222-244) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl to register the 5th high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. It was his second 700 in the LCTA this year as he previously tossed 709 (217-279-213). Jeff is averaging 226 for 6 games as a spare in the FTBMNML this year. Raymond bowls full time in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) this year and is averaging 209 for 33 games. Last year in the BWCL he averaged 207 for 99 games. Raymond's career high scores are 776 and 300 (3). Two of his 300's have been tossed at Marcin Bowl and his other 300 was recorded in tournament action at Revs Rose Bowl

in Windsor.

Shepherd maintains his lead:

Mike Shephard hurled 711 (228-247-236) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling competition to record the 6th highest triple of the week. It was his 14th 700 of the season and he maintained his lead in the Crown 700 race over Ben Lapointe by two. Mike's other 700's this year were 718



– 804 – 759 – 740 – 709 – 757 – 745 – 710 – 779 – 740 – 728 – 703 and 771. Shephard is averaging 231 for 30 games in the BWCL this year.

Chipman slides into seventh spot:



Shane Chipman bowled 704 (267 – 59 pins over average – 190-247) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling activity to post the 7th high triple of the week. It was his 4th 700 of the year as he previously tossed 722, 729 and 736. Chipman is averaging 212 for 24 games in the FTBMNML this year. Last year in the league he averaged 212 for 36 games.

Watson enters the year’s 700 club:



Brian Watson wheeled 702 (245-222-235) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling play to record his first 700 of the season and the lowest 700 of the week. In the 2022-2023 season, Watson had 2-700’s and last season he had 4-700’s. Brian is averaging 212 for 27 games in the FTBMNML this year. Last year in the league he averaged 199 for 75 games. Watson’s career high scores are 785 and 300 (3).

Friis is ladies top bowler:



Jill Friis wheeled 623 (206-206-211) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl to register the ladies top triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity.
