Weekly Highlights

Mezzatesta adds to his total:



Roy Mezzatesta rolled 736 (245-213-278 - 62 pins over average) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl, to record the high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition. It was his 15th 700 of the season and his first 700 in six weeks when he last bowled 729 (247-203-279) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League and 709 (236-259-214) in the LCTA Team Tournament. Roy is participating in three league this year. His averages with games in brackets are the BWCL 217 (84), the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League 213 (76) and the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League 215 (72). The "Mezz's" career high scores are 859 (279-290-290 – 33 out of a possible 36 strikes) which he bowled in the Target Trios League at Hi-Way Bowl in the 2019-2020 season and 300 (10).

Baldwin tops her high triple:

Colleen Baldwin fired 628 (211 – 43 pins over average – 186 – 231 – 63 pins over average – 124 pins over average for three games) in the Bar10 Thursday Night Mixed League (B10TNML) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl to establish a new personal sanctioned high triple. Her previous high triple was 625 (184-237-204) which she posted in the B10TNML this season back in February. Colleen's career high single is 237. Colleen is averaging 168 after 30 weeks of bowling this year. Last year in the league she averaged 158 for 90 games.



Breuer wheels new high single:



Nic Breuer wheeled 246 (82 pins over average) in his last game of the night to record a new personal sanctioned high single topping his previous 243. This writer previously reported that Nic's highest game was 248 when it was actually 243. Nic bowled his new high single in the Bar 10 Thursday Night Mixed League (B10TNML) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with a 568 triple. His career high triple is 649 (193-232-224) which he bowled in the Marcin Thursday Night Mixed League in the 2018-2019 season. The 34-year-old, who has "Williams Syndrome" started bowling in the Marcin Community Living Bowling League and for the first four years did not use any of the holes in the bowling ball. Nic is averaging 164 after 30 weeks of bowling in the B10TNML this year.

Best bowls new high single:



Liam Best hurled 177 (62 pins over average) in his second game of the day to establish a new personal high single nipping his previous high game of 176. He was bowling in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl finishing the day with a 405 triple. Liam's career high triple is 477 (147-176-154) which he recorded in the PYL three weeks ago. He is averaging 115 after 29 weeks on the lanes this year. Last year in the league he averaged 86 for 69 games.

Dwyer rolls his top scores:

Olivier Dwyer rolled 319 (108 – 45 pins over average – 107 – 44 pins over average – 104 – 41 pins over average – 130 pins over average for three games) in the Phantom Youth League on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl. This writer is going to put himself on the end of the limb by saying the 309 and 108 are Olivier's career highest scores. This writer also believes that this year is Olivier's first year in organized sanctioned league bowling. He is averaging 63 after 29 weeks of bowling. SUPER bowling Olivier!!



Armstrong having solid year:



John Armstrong tossed 715 (246-210-259) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl to register the second high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was his 11th 700 of the season. He also rolled 698 (246-238) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League this week. The lane conditions have been just right for Armstrong's game the last two weeks, as last week he bowled 748 (246-267-235) and 728 (246-245-237). John is averaging 216 for 81 games in the BWCL this year.

Last year in the league he averaged 208 for 90 games. Armstrong's career high scores are 792 which he posted in the 2008-2009 season and 300 (3).

Slater is second best for the ladies:



Cori Slater fired 600 (245 – 69 pins over average -192 -163) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl to register the ladies second high triple of the week in the LCTA. Cori is averaging 176 for 78 games in the MFFL this year. Last year in the league she averaged 170 for 93 games. Her career high scores are 717 (257-247-213) which she bowled in the St. Joe's Mixed League in the 2011- 2012 season and 279.

Ingles is top youth bowler:



Zachary Ingles rolled 584 (156-225-203) in the Phantom Youth League on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl to post the youth high triple of the week in the LCTA. Zachary bowled his career high scores this season when he tossed 676 (239 -218-219) and 247 both in the PYL. He is averaging 170 after 29 weeks of bowling in the PYL this year. He also spares in the Mulder Financial Fun League and is averaging 181 for 15 games.
