Weekly Highlights

Creasor is tops:



Jim Creasor rolled 742 (248-226-268) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl, to record the top triple in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition this past week. It was his first time sparing in the BWCL this season. Creasor lives in Port Huron and is bowling in the Cowboys and Indians League (CIL) this year averaging 217 for 51 games. There have been 13-300's in the CIL this year with Creasor having one of them and LCTA bowler John Armstrong also being perfect in the league.

Best rolls first 700 series:



Steve Best fired 709 (236 – 53 pins over average – 247- 64 pins over average – 226 – 43 pins over average – 160 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl, to record his career first 700 and the 4th high triple in the LCTA this past week. His previous high triple was 699 (197-276-226) which he bowled in the FTBMNML last season. His high single is 277 bowled in the FTBMNML in the 2023-2024 season. Best is averaging 186 for 54 games in the FTBMNML this year bowling on the "Napa Auto" team. Last year in the league he averaged 184 for 72 games.



Meredith records first 600 triple:

Chris Meredith tossed 605 (196 – 38 pins over average – 204 – 46 pins over average – 205 – 47 pins over average – 131 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl, to register his career first 600 triple in the LCTA. His previous high triple was 580 (215-181-184) and his high single is 246 both bowled in the FTBMNML last season. Meredith is bowling on the “Mr. Chip” team this year averaging 161 for 51 games. Last year in the league he averaged 160 for 81 games.

Strangway posts new high single:

Anne Strangway rolled 280 in her first game of the night to record a new personal high single in LCTA bowling activity. She was bowling in the Klean and Brite Thursday Night Mixed League (KBTNML) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl, finishing the night with 638 (280 – 114 pins over average – 157-201 – 140 pins over average for three games) which was good for the ladies second highest triple of the week. Anne is eligible to receive a 100 pins over average in a single game award for her great game and she was the highest over average in that category this past week. Her previous high single was 269 and her high triple is 664. Anne also has a 662 (186-218-258) to her credit bowled in the KBTNML last season. Strangway is averaging 166 after 21 weeks of bowling this season. Last season in the league she averaged 175 for 96 games.

Youth bowlers shine on the lanes:

Tayllum Taylor, Emily Peters, Ryder Kelly, Chase Beveridge, Kendall Wynne, Xena Glover and Brayden Moore had personal high scores this past week in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling activity.

Tayllum wheeled 535 (207 – 63 pins over average – 158-170 – 103 pins over for three games) on lanes 19 & 20 to register a new personal high triple. His previous high triple was 505 (196-155-154) and his high single is 212 both bowled in the PYL this season. Tayllum is



averaging 144 after 21 weeks of bowling this season. Last season he averaged 120 for 84 games in the PYL.

Emily rolled 383 (141-109-133) on lanes 13 & 14 to establish a new personal high triple. Her previous high triple was 364 (107-97-160) which she bowled in the PYL this season and her high single game is 160. Emily is averaging 109 after 21 weeks on the lanes this year. Last year in the league she averaged 77 for 87 games.

Ryder fired 351 (98-109-144 – 61 pins over average – 120 pins over average for three games) on lanes 27 & 28 to shine on the lanes this past week. This writer did not have any previous scores on Ryder so I'm guessing these are probably his highest scores. Ryder is averaging 77 after 21 weeks of bowling in the PYL in his first season.

Chase tossed 129 (49 pins over average) in his last game of the day on lanes 25 & 26, to record a new personal high single ending the day with a 273 triple. His previous high single was 113 and his high triple is 296. Chase is averaging 80 after 21 weeks of bowling this season. Last season in the PYL he averaged 66 for 87 games.

Kendall wheeled 270 (86-71-113 – 52 pins over average) on lanes 25 & 26, to post new personal high scores. His previous high scores were 214 and 91. Kendall is averaging 61 after 21 weeks of bowling this season. He is bowling in the PYL in his first season.

Xena bowled 269 (73-85 – 35 pins over average -111 – 61 pins over average - 119 pins over average for three games) on lanes 25 & 26 to have a super day on the lanes. This writer did not have any previous scores on Xena but I'm guessing these are probably her highest scores. She doubled her score in her last game when she bowled 111 carrying a 50 average after 21 weeks of bowling in the PYL in her first season.

Brayden rolled 135 (66 pins over average) in his last game of the day on lanes 27 & 28 finishing the day with a 291 triple. Brayden is averaging 69 after 21 weeks of bowling participating in the PYL in his first season.

Pimentel posts new high single:

Dan Pimental rolled 248 (90 pins over average) in his second game of the night to top his previous high 242. He was bowling in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling action finishing with a 541 triple. His career high triple is 616 (210 201-205) which he recorded in the MFFL in



the 2022-2023 season. Pimentel is averaging 159 for 54 games in the MFFL this season. Last season in the league he finished with a 157 for 90 games.

Ridealgh good for second spot:



Bill Ridealgh tossed 734 (233-267 – 49 pins over average – 234) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl, to post the second high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. It was his 4th 700 of the season as he previously bowled 743 (248-216-279), 747 (221-258-268) and 776 (277-257-242). Bill is averaging 218 for 63 games in the BWCL this season. Ridealgh started bowling at age 6 coming up through the Phantom Youth Bowling Program at Hi-Way Bowl and has been enjoying the friendship with fellow bowlers on the lanes for the last 41 years. He has career sanctioned high scores are 789 and 300(4).

Mezzatesta adds to his total:



Roy Mezzatesta rolled 722 (238-242-242) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl, to post the 3rd high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was his 8th 700 of the season as he previously bowled 745, 703, 753, 705, 711, 754 and 706. Mezzatesta is averaging 214 for 60 games in the FTBMNML this season. Mezzatesta's career high triple is 859 (279-290-290) which he posted in the 2019-2020 season in the Target Trios Mixed League at Hi-Way Bowl. Roy has the following sanctioned scores to his credit: 3-800's, 10-300's, 13-299's (7 in the Canadian Tenpin Federation), 5-298's (1 in Port Huron) and 2-297's.

Chipman notches number eight:

Shane Chipman fired 706 (246-268 – 52 pins over average – 192) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl, to register the 5th high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was his 8th 700 of the season as he previously bowled 700, 749, 724, 747, 803 (256-257-290), 708 and 738. Chipman is averaging 217 for 69 games in the BWCL this season. Shane's career high scores are 803 and 300 (4). He also has 1-299 and 1-298 to his credit.



Friis leads the ladies:



Jill Friis wheeled 676 (206-237-233) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl, to be the top lady kegler this past week in LCTA bowling action. Jill is averaging 197 for 30 games as a spare in the BWCL this season. Friis has been a formidable opponent on the lanes over her bowling years. Two of her numerous outstanding achievements are the following. She established an individual 9 game All Events Canadian tournament record in 2011 when she rolled 2145 for an average of 238 per game. That record held up until 2024 when Kristy MacLelland broke it by recording 2192 for an average of 243 per game. Jill also has been named an amazing 27 times London and District Tenpin Bowling Association ladies Bowler of the year.

Tony Spano Memorial Scholarship Tournament:

The Tony Spano Memorial Youth Scholarship Tournament was held over a two week period (Jan.11-26) with bowlers competing against each other in different leagues. The competition was a handicap tournament with a \$5 entry fee (3.00 to prize fund, \$2.00 to youth scholarship fund) and the bowlers used their scores for that night. Bowlers could enter every league they participated in every week for a two-week period. There was a men’s division and a ladies division. The men’s division had 170 bowlers while the ladies had 40 bowlers.


